THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE BADGERS

- The Purdue men's basketball team continues its grueling start on the road, traveling to the Kohl Center to face a Wisconsin squad that ranks No. 19 in the NCAA's NET rankings. Tip is scheduled for 9 p.m. ET / 8 p.m. CT from the Kohl Center.
- The contest will be televised on FS1 with **Brian Anderson** and **Len Elmore** calling the action courtside, while on the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com with **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 8 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue is looking for its first road win of the season, with the four road losses to No. 15 Florida State, No. 3 Michigan, Texas and No. 6 Michigan State.
- 2) Purdue has played the fourth-most difficult schedule in America, according to KenPom. Wisconsin will be the eighth top-40 foe of the season.
- 3) Purdue is looking to start 3-2 in Big Ten play for the ninth straight year. Coincidentally, the last time Purdue started 2-3 in the Big Ten came during the 2009-10 season, in which Purdue finished 29-6 and won a Big Ten regular-season championship.
- 4) Purdue and Marquette have both won four games in the Kohl Center since 2005-06 (the **Matt Painter** era), the most for a visiting team.
- 5) Purdue continues to excel on the offensive end, ranking seventh nationally in offensive efficiency. Purdue, Duke and North Carolina are the only three teams to rank in the top 10 in offensive efficiency in 2017-18 and 2018-19. Purdue finished last year second behind Villanova.
- 6) Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has been one of the best offensive teams in America. The Boilermakers have ranked in the nation's top 25 in offensive efficiency in six of the last nine seasons (lone years not in top 25: 2014-15, 2013-14, 2012-13).
- 7) Purdue is averaging just 9.4 turnovers per game over the last eight games. In the first seven games, Purdue averaged 13.1 turnovers per game. Over the last eight games, Purdue boasts a 1.49 assist / turnover ratio (112 / 75).
- 8) A statistical oddity: Purdue is 1-4 this year when recording single-digit turnovers, but is 8-2 when having at least 10 turnovers.
- 9) **Carsen Edwards** ranks sixth nationally in scoring (24.5 PPG). Since the 1992-93 season, just two other Big Ten players (Purdue's **Glenn Robinson** 2x, Michigan State's **Shawn Respert** 2x) have averaged at least 24.0 points per game in a season.
- 10) **Trevion Williams** recorded a double-double vs. Michigan (13 pts, 12 rebs) -- the first double-double for a Purdue freshman since **Caleb Swanigan** against Illinois on March 11, 2016. The great thing about it -- Williams wears No. 50 to model his game after Swanigan.

THE SERIES

- Purdue and Wisconsin will meet for the 180th time Friday night with the Boilermakers owning a 108-71 advantage.
- Purdue's 108 wins are the third most for the Boilermakers against a single opponent (Northwestern - 128; Indiana - 118).
- Purdue is looking for its fifth win in a six-game stretch against the Badgers for the first time since the first six games of the Matt Painter era (Feb. 4, 2006 to Jan. 27, 2009).
- Purdue has never scored 75 points in the Kohl Center and hasn't scored 75 in Madison since Feb. 7, 1996 (17 games).

SOME SUCCESS AT THE KOHL CENTER

- Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has had SOME success in the Kohl Center, which is one of the toughest places to play in America.
- Since the 2005-06 season, Purdue has four wins in the facility, the most of any visiting team.
- Painter owns a 4-6 record at the Kohl Center, owning wins over a pair of ranked Badger squads (2008, 2013).
- Despite the success in the Kohl Center, Purdue has scored more than 70 points just once during the Painter era (72; Feb. 9, 2008).

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and through the end of the month, could rise to the top of the list among the nation's toughest schedules.
- According to KenPom, Purdue's schedule currently ranks as the fourth-most difficult nationally (Oklahoma, Eastern Michigan, Kansas).
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games (at Michigan, Maryland, Iowa, at Michigan State, at Wisconsin, Rutgers, Indiana, at Ohio State, Michigan State).
- Purdue's first four Big Ten road games will be Michigan (currently No. 2), Michigan State (currently No. 6), Wisconsin (as high as 12) and Ohio State (as high as 13). Purdue's non-conference games were at Florida State (as high as 9) and Texas (as high as 17).
- Purdue has played 11 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, matching Illinois and Oklahoma for the most top-100 foes in the country.
- Through Christmas, Purdue was one of five power-conference schools to have at least 7 away / neutral games (OU, Nova, Okie St., Stanford).
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 25 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team is Saint Mary's (10-7; 64th).
- While eight of Purdue's first nine league games come against teams that were ranked nationally at the time of the game or in the Dec. 31, poll, just two of the last 11 games come against teams currently ranked in the AP Top 25 poll.
- During the Painter era, the highest that a schedule has ever been ranked (KenPom) is eighth in 2012; the lowest in 2008 (62nd).

TRACKING THE RANKED TEAMS

- Purdue has already faced six ranked teams, with more ranked teams on the horizon, and even more that are receiving votes (in AP top 32).
- The school record for most games against ranked teams is 12.

BOILERS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Purdue has taken care of the ball this year, averaging just 11.1 turnovers per game, which would rank as the sixth-lowest average in school history.
- However, over the last six games, Purdue is averaging just 8.3 turnovers per game, while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.78.
- Purdue is 32nd nationally in turnover percentage (16.3 percent) and 26th nationally in turnovers per game (11.1).

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 140-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting, including 4-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (50.8 percent). It was Purdue's first loss when shooting 48-plus percent from the field since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, a streak of 27 straight victories.

NO SUCH THING AS PURE MICHIGAN

- The two Michigan schools have not been kind to Purdue this season and even further back. The Boilermakers have lost four straight games to Michigan and Michigan State.
- Since Feb. 1, 2018, Purdue is 0-4 against the Michigan schools, but 17-7 against all other schools.
- It should be noted that none of the four games vs. the Michigan schools were played in Mackey Arena (three on road; one neutral).

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 107-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 24-4 when that happens, having won 24 of its last 25 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 60-57 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).

► **Record at Purdue:** 304-155 (.662) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 329-160 (.673) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
