A CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Purdue will compete in its second straight tournament at the 53rd Ken Kraft Midlands Championships ... the Boilermakers were last in action three weeks ago at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational where they tallied 52 points to place 15th in the team standings while sending Chad Welch to the 165-pound title match.
- Midlands serves as a coming home for Danny Sabatello and Peter Andreotti ... Sabatello's hometown of Long Grove, Illinois, is 22 miles northwest of Evanston, while Andreotti is from Chicago proper.
- Purdue's 14 wrestlers slated to compete at Midlands sport a 69-46 combined record through five tournaments this season ... seven different Boilermakers have placed, totaling 18 podium finishes.
- Doug Welch can become the fifth two-time Midlands placewinner for Purdue ... last year as the No. 8 seed at 157, he went 5-2 on his way to a seventh-place finish.
- It will be the first Midlands experience for four Boilermakers: Ben Thornton, Jacob Morrissey, Cody Pae and Andreotti.
- During his run at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational, C. Welch defeated the second-, thirdand seventh-seeded wrestlers ... he pinned No. 4 Cooper Moore of UNI, decisioned No. 9 Clark Glass of Oklahoma and major decisioned No. 13 Seth Thomas of Oregon State ... C. Welch also advanced to the finals of the Michigan State Open while wrestling unattached.
- Nine of C. Welch's 13 wins have resulted in bonus points ... he has already matched career bests in major decisions (4) and pins (4) ... the nine bonus point wins also match a career high from his rookie season ... in 15 matches wrestled, he has only given up five takedowns.
- Both Pae and Kyle Aversman have placed in two of the three tournaments they have competed in ... Pae was fifth at the Eastern Michigan Open to start the season and followed with a seventh-place showing unattached at the Michigan State Open ... Ayersman was sixth unattached at the Michigan State Open and was the Wisconsin Open runner-up (12/5).
- In eight matches, Alex Griffin has only been taken down three times ... after being taken down 12 seconds into his first match of the season, Griffin went 35:02 without being taken down ... he will be seeking career win No. 40 at Midlands.

SCOUTING THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

- There will be 38 NCAA Division I teams present at Midlands, with invitations extended to select wrestlers from NCAA Division II California Baptist, Division III Messiah College and Grand View from the NAIA.
- Division I teams: Adams State, American, Arizona State, Bloomsburg, Brown, Buffalo, Cal State Bakersfield, Columbia, Eastern Michigan, Franklin & Marshall, George Mason, Grand Canyon, Harvard, Illinois, Iowa, Iowa State, Kent State, Lehigh, Lock Haven, Maryland, NC State, Nebraska, North Dakota State, Northern Illinois, Northern Iowa, Northwestern, Ohio, Oklahoma, Old Dominion, Oregon State, Pittsburgh, Princeton, Rider, Rutgers, SIU Edwardsville, South Dakota State and Wisconsin.
- Thirteen of those teams were also out at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational: American, Arizona State, Brown, CSU Bakersfield, Columbia, Harvard, Iowa State, Kent State, North Dakota State, Northern Iowa, Oklahoma, Oregon State and Wisconsin ... among these teams, Purdue wrestlers saw 16 opponents (American 2; Columbia 2; CSU Bakersfield 1; Harvard 1; Kent State 2; North Dakota State 1; Northern Iowa 2; Oklahoma 2; Oregon State 1; Wisconsin 2) ... teams of four of Chad Welch's five Las Vegas opponents will be at Midlands.
- Four of Purdue's six dual opponents this season, Bloomsburg, Eastern Michigan, Lock Haven and Northern Illinois, add to the mix of familiarity ... in those duals combined, the Boilermakers have won 30 of 40 bouts, with have of those wins resulting in bonus points (3 MD, 1 TF, 10 F, 1 injury default).
- Twenty-nine of the 38 Division I teams have at least one nationally ranked wrestler ... Nebraska is the only squad to boast a ranked wrestler at all 10 weight classes, including two in the top 10 (149, 184) ... lowa and Lehigh will come in with eight ranked grapplers ... all but one of the Hawkeyes are among the top eight of their respective weight class ... Lehigh has a pair among the top 10 (157, 285).
- According to the Dec. 22 edition of InterMat rankings, 102 nationally ranked wrestlers could be in action in Welsh-Ryan Arena, including No. 1s at 157 and 285 ... 133 and 157 have the most ranked wrestlers with a dozen each, including five of the weight's top 10 ... the fewest ranked wrestlers in a weight class is nine (125, 141, 174 and 184).
- The tournament field has the potential to feature five defending Midlands champs (133 Cory Clark, Iowa; 149 Jason Tsirtsis, Northwestern; 157 Isaiah Martinez, Illinois; 184 Jack Dechow, Old Dominion; 197 Nathan Burak, Iowa) and 17 additional wrestlers that placed in 2014, including Purdue's Doug Welch.
- Twenty-two wrestlers that earned All-America honors at the 2015 NCAA Championships could be in the tournament field ... among those 22 wrestlers are a trio of defending national champs Cody Brewer of Oklahoma at 133; Illinois' Isaiah Martinez at 157; and NC State heavyweight Nick Gwiazdowski ... Cory Clark of Iowa (133) and Lehigh's Nathaniel Brown (184) were finalists a year ago.

PURDUE AT THE KEN KRAFT MIDLANDS CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Last year the Boilermakers placed 16th with 33 points ... Doug Welch captured seventh place at 157 pounds as the No. 8 seed ... Danny Sabatello, who was seeded seventh, and Chad Welch, the No. 11 seed, advanced to the quarterfinals at 133 and 174 pounds, respectively.
- Purdue has had 34 placewinners in the tournament's 52-year history ... Dave Gibson is the only Purdue wrestler to have won a title, doing so at 157 pounds in 1963, the first edition of the tournament ... five other Boilermakers have wrestled in the finals ... most recently it was 197-pounder Braden Atwood in 2013.
- The highest point total Purdue has posted at Midlands is 82.5 when they finished seventh in 2008 ... highest team finish was fourth in 1990 with 49.25 points.
- Four Boilermakers placed in 2008, 2006 and 1990 ... the last time Purdue had multiple medalists was 2011 when a trio placed.

#ALWAYSAGGRESSIVE

- Bonus points have been earned in 40 percent of Purdue's 138 victories (17 MD, 9 TF, 27 F) ... after Chad Welch (4 MD, 1 TF, 4 F), Kyle Ayersman and Drake Stein are second on the team with five bonus point victories ... Ayersman has posted a pair of tech falls and stuck three opponents ... Stein has one major and one tech fall with three pins.
- Through 14 matches, Ben Thornton has dominated riding time ... at the final horn, he has been on the plus-side of riding time a dozen times, earning the point seven times ... Ayersman leads the team with eight riding time points, while C. Welch has the most accumulated riding time at 31:07.
- Ten of the 14 wrestlers heading to Midlands have scored first in at least half of their matches ... Tyler Kral and Chad Welch have put up the first points in all but three of their matches ... as a team the Boilermakers score first in 52 percent of the time.
- Purdue holds a scoring advantage in all three periods and overtime matches ... the first period and first points are huge as the Boilermakers own a 106-point advantage ... a trio has scored 40-or more points in the opening period: Ayersman (42), Danny Sabatello (40) and C. Welch (46) ... over half of C. Welch's total points (91) have been registered in the first period.
- Thornton's average of 7.6 points per match is tops on the team as are his 107 total points ... Ayersman ranks second in total points with 103 (5.7/match), followed by Danny Sabatello right at 100 (7.1/match).

RANKINGS NOTES

- The Boilermakers have spent the last three weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Coaches Poll, two of which have been at No. 19 ... the last time Purdue was listed among the top-20 teams was Dec. 3, 2013, at No. 19 ... the Boilermakers returned to the poll at No. 24 on Dec. 8 for the first time since closing out the 2014-15 season at No. 23.
- The team ranking is the 10th time Purdue has been ranked while under the direction of head coach Tony Ersland ... the No. 19 ranking also stands as the highest team ranking an Ersland-coached squad.
- Following his runner-up performance in Las Vegas, Chad Welch went from unranked to one of the nation's top-10 165-pounders ... he made his InterMat season debut at No. 8 on Dec. 8 and has climbed one spot in each of the past two weeks ... it is the fifth time in his career he has been ranked by InterMat ... he spent two weeks at No. 18 while wrestling at 174 last season.
- C. Welch checks in at No. 6 heading in Midlands, which not only marks a career high, but it is the highest ranking for a Purdue wrestler since early January 2012 when Cashé Quirgoa was listed sixth for two weeks at 133.
- Redshirt junior Alex Griffin owns a career-high InterMat ranking of No. 17 this week ... Griffin has been listed in the last four editions after earning his first national ranking Nov. 24, by checking in at No. 20 on the 149-pound list.
- Doug Welch continues to hold a position among InterMat's top 157-pounders ... 18 consecutive editions dating to Jan. 12, 2015 ... his season-high ranking this year is No. 12 ... he owns a 14-10 mark since debuting on the poll.
- The Boilermakers are a combined 8-12 vs. ranked opponents, with three of those wins coming from C. Welch in Las Vegas ... Danny Sabatello also has a pair of wins over ranked foes.
- When ranked, Purdue wrestlers are 8-6 vs. unranked competition and 4-1 vs. ranked opponents ... one of those wins of ranked vs. ranked has been a Boilermaker upsetting a top-10 opponent.

#BOILERNOTES

Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational

- Chad Welch was Purdue's first Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational finalist since Logan Brown at 197 pounds in 2010 ... since 2002, six Boilermakers have advanced to the finals ... C. Welch became the 26th Purdue wrestler to have placed in the tournament ... the last 165-pounder to place for Purdue was Luke Manuel with a fourth-place finish in 2008.
- It was the fifth title match appearance of C. Welch's career and second of the season ... he was the 165-pound runner-up wrestling unattached at the Michigan State Open.
- Ninth-seeded Alex Griffin (149) bounced back from his first loss of the season, a 6-5 decision to the No. 8 seed, Geordan Martinez of Boise State, by shutting out Virginia Tech's third-seeded and 13th-ranked Sal Mastriani with an 8-0 major decision ... it was the second dominating upset of his career ... last year he posted an 8-1 upset of No. 11 Alexander Richardson of Old Dominion in dual action.
- Doug Welch, who was seeded second at 157, advanced to the quarterfinals, but was edged by seventh-seeded Russell Parsons of Army 6-4 ... D. Welch went 2-2 with a fall and a decision.

- Purdue finished the tournament with a combined mark of 20-18 ... nine bouts were won with bonus points and the Boilermakers won two matches by injury default.
- Career Marks / Danny Sabatello picked up career win No. 70 with his 4:12 pin of Jake Velarde from Boise State ... 32 percent of his wins have been with bonus points (8 MD, 7 TF, 7 F).
- Career Marks / Luke Welch posted his first career major decision with a 12-4 showing against Jordan Gurrola of San Francisco State ... Ben Thornton recorded his first technical fall, a 19-1 match vs. Patrick Kearney of The Citadel that ended at 6:57.

Bloomsburg, Shippensburg, Lock Haven

- The Boilermakers have put 30-or more points on the board in five of their first six duals this season ... the 2006-07 season saw Purdue score 30+ in five duals during the season ... the season with the most duals where the Boilermakers scored 30+ was in 2002-03 with 10.
- The 37-12 win in their first-ever trip to Bloomsburg was the Boilermakers' third straight in the series.
- Purdue won in Lock Haven for the third time in the series ... the last win in Lock Haven came in 1958, which was also the last time the Boilermakers were a true road team in the series ... it had been nearly 23 years since Purdue last met the Bald Eagles ... the 23 years since the last meeting is Purdue's third longest stretch among all-time, active Division I opponents ... the Boilermakers last faced West Virginia in 1954, a span of 61 years, and Virginia Tech in 1965, a span of 50 years.
- Firsts / Redshirt freshman Ben Thornton recorded the first major decision of his career with a 16-4 outing vs. Jon Haas of Bloomsburg ... fellow redshirt freshmen Peter Andreotti (165), Blake Reid (174) and Jacob Aven (285) all won with bonus points in their dual debuts vs. Shippensburg ... it was the first-ever meeting with NCAA Division II Shippensburg ... the Raiders were the 148th all-time opponent in program history.
- Career Marks / Chad Welch / 4:44 pin of Bloomsburg's Mathew Carr was the 13th of his career, which is tops on the team ... he is 5-0 in duals, with four of the wins resulting in bonus points (2 F, 1 TF, 1 MD) ... the 6-2 decision of Lock Haven's Cody Cordes was his 60th career victory.
- Career Marks / Doug Welch / The 9-0 major decision vs. Adam Martz of Shippensburg was the eighth major of his career ... 6:16 stick of Aaron McKinney of Lock Haven was career fall No. 8 and career win No. 50.
- Career Marks / Jacob Morrissey / Redshirt sophomore posted back-to-back falls for career Nos. 8 and 9 ... now has three pins on the season ... of his 23 career wins, nearly 40 percent have been by fall and 52 percent have been with bonus points (2 MD, 1 TF, 9 F).
- Career Marks / Alex Griffin / Picked up the eighth major decision of his career in a 10-1 match vs. Cody Wheeler of Lock Haven ... 54 percent of his 35 career victories have been with bonus points (8 MD, 7 TF, 4 F) ... currently on a career best seven-straight winning streak dating to Nov. 29, 2014.

Eastern Michigan Duals

- Purdue made its first-ever trip to Ypsilanti, Michigan ... the last time the Boilermakers began the season at a dual tournament was in 2010 at the Edinboro Duals.
- Purdue's 30-9 win over Northern Illinois was its 20th in the series (20-8-1) ... Boilermakers extended their winning streak against Eastern Michigan (30-13) to seven straight.
- Of the Boilermakers' 19 wins, four came by fall, two were major decisions, there was one technical fall and one injury default was received ... three of the wins were upsets, two of which came in head-to-head matchups between ranked wrestlers ... the other was an unranked Purdue grappler sticking the nation's 13th-ranked 197-pounder.
- C. Welch posted three-straight bonus point victories (MD, TF, F) ... it's the first time in his career he won three in a row with bonus points ... the pin was the 11th of his career and the tech fall was the fourth ... his 15-0 tech fall marked the third time in four career tech falls he shut his opponent out ... he totaled 14 back points in three matches.
- Career Marks / redshirt senior Drake Stein won his 12th career match by fall ... redshirt freshman Ben Thornton (125) and true freshman Jon Morales (184) wrestled their first dual matches at Purdue ... Thornton won his first career match with a 4-1 decision.

RECORD MAKERS & CHASERS

Career Falls

• Both Drake Stein and Chad Welch are three pins shy of landing on the list (17) ... they each have 14 pins in their careers ... Stein has pinned three opponents this year, while C. Welch has stuck four ... four is a career-best for C. Welch, which he also accomplished in each of his first two seasons.

Career Takedowns

• Danny Sabatello is 17th on the list with 225 takedowns to his credit ... his next benchmark is 230 ... Sabatello has tallied 30 takedowns in 14 matches (2.1/match) ... season high takedowns is 2013-14 when he had 73, but he only averaged 1.4 per match.

Career Reversals

• Doug Welch has 22 career reversals ... the target number is 29.

Career Back Points

- Sabatello checks in at No. 17 with 130 ... he can quickly climb the ranks as only 18 points separate him from cracking the top 10 (148).
- C. Welch is 18 points out of earning a spot on the list (117) with 99 in his career ... has 24 through 15 matches.
- Alex Griffin needs 19 ... he has a dozen back points in eight matches and currently has 98 to his credit.

2015-16 SCHEDULE NOTES

- Seventeen duals ... six at home in Holloway Gymnasium, eight on the road and three at a neutral location.
- The last nine NCAA team titles have been won by opponents on the schedule: Ohio State (2015); Penn State (2011, 2012, 2013, 2014); Iowa (2008, 2009, 2010); and Minnesota (2007) ... During his 18 years as a Division I wrestling coach, Tony Ersland has played an integral role in developing student-athletes that are accomplished on the mat and nationally recognized. He has had 94 wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships, with 28 earning All-America honors and four finishing at the top of the podium. Two of his pupils, Jordan Burroughs and Jake Herbert, earned the highest honor a collegiate grappler can receive in the Dan Hodge Award. Ersland continued to develop

Burroughs on the international stage as he claimed the 2011 and 2013 World titles at 74 kg. In 2012, Burroughs claimed Olympic gold in London.

In his first season at Purdue, Ersland qualified eight to the 2015 NCAA Championships, the most among 13 Division I coaches that were spending their first season at the helm of their respective program. Five of his wrestlers earned a spot on the podium at the B1G Championships. His squad spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Five of his grapplers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Ersland's Boilermakers win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Ersland came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Nebraska for eight seasons. While on staff, the Huskers tallied a 102-41-2 dual record, recorded seven top-20 team finishes at the NCAA Championships and grapplers earned 17 All-America honors.

Prior to his post at Nebraska, Ersland coached the Cyclone Wrestling Club in Ames, Iowa. Ersland worked with Iowa State NCAA champions Trent Paulson (157) and David Zabriskie (285) among other multiple NCAA qualifiers and All-Americans.

His familiarity with the Big Ten extends beyond his time at Nebraska. From 2000-05, Ersland was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northwestern, and he also served as a coach and board member for the Wildcat Wrestling Club.

He was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northern Illinois in 1999 and 2000 after getting his start as a graduate assistant at Central Michigan from 1997 to 1999.

On the mat, Ersland wrestled for the University of Iowa under legendary coach Dan Gable and was a part of three-straight NCAA team championships (1995-97) and four Big Ten Championships (1994-97). During his senior season in 1997, Ersland finished one match shy of All-America honors at 177 pounds.

The Humboldt, Iowa, native excelled in the classroom as a four-time Academic All-Big Ten selection and Board of Control Athletics Award winner, and was bestowed with lowa wrestling's J. Donald McPike Award, given to the senior on the team with the highest grade-point average.

Ersland earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from Iowa (1997) and a Master of Arts in athletic administration from Central Michigan (1999).

Ersland and his wife, Carolyn, have twin sons, Mason and Jaxon.

During his first season as an assistant coach, Zach Tanelli coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Tanelli joined the Boilermaker wrestling program after a five-year coaching stint at Hofstra. During his tenure, Tanelli worked his way up the coaching ranks and most recently served as interim head coach. He was the head assistant coach for the two previous seasons after spending his first three years as an assistant coach with the Pride.

The former Badger made an impact throughout Hofstra's lineup, particularly in the lower weights. Tanelli coached four All-Americans in Steve Bonanno (125), Lou Ruggirello (133), Justin Accordino (149) and P.J. Gillespie (165). The Pride won threestraight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) team titles (2011-13) before moving to the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) in 2013-14, where they placed fourth with two finalists, including the 165-pound champion, Joseph Booth.

While in the CAA, seven Hofstra grapplers claimed tournament crowns under the guidance of Tanelli, including a pair of two-time champs in Bonanno and 184-pounder Ben Clymer. Jamie Franco (133), Luke Vaith (141), Gillespie (165), Ryan Patrovich (174) and Paul Snyder (HWT) were also titlists for Tanelli.

Tanelli wrestled the first three years of his Badger career at 133 pounds and bumped up to 141 for his senior campaign in 2009. He was a two-time NCAA qualifier at 133 and earned a spot on the 141 podium with a fourth-place finish for All-America accolades. During his senior season, Tanelli went on a blaze, owning a 31-6 record. including a spotless 7-0 mark against Big Ten foes. He was ranked No. 1 at his weight for the second half of the 2008-09 season after winning the 141-pound Midlands Championships title and was bestowed with the Champion of Champions Award.

Tanelli was a three-time Big Ten Championships placewinner and improved upon his finish each year. As a sophomore, he placed eighth at 133, followed by a fifth-place finish as a junior. Tanelli then took second at 141 as a senior.

During his career at Wisconsin, Tanelli compiled an 88-31 record with a blistering .967 winning percentage. He won 44 percent of his matches with bonus points, registering 15 major decisions, 13 falls and 11 technical falls.

A native of Millburn, New Jersey, Tanelli earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Wisconsin in 2009 and his master's degree in higher educational leadership and policy studies from Hofstra in 2012.

Tyrel Todd brings a standard of excellence into the Boilermaker wrestling room. The decorated collegiate wrestler with high caliber national and international freestyle experience enters his second season as an assistant coach at Purdue.

During his first season on staff, Todd coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA

Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Todd came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Cal Poly (2010-11) and Arizona State (2013-14). While on staff at Cal Poly, Todd coached four NCAA qualifiers (141, 157, 165, 197), including a runner-up finish from Borislav Novachkov at 141. The following season Ryan DesRoches earned All-America honors at 174.

In July 2013, Todd was named an assistant coach at Arizona State where he worked hands on daily with the upper-weights, including Blake Staffer, who earned All-America honors at 184 pounds with a third-place finish at the 2015 NCAA Championships. Todd's work at ASU focused on recruiting, coordinating practices, developing training schedules and organizing team travel.

From August 2011 - July 2013, Todd trained alongside his former teammates, while also mentoring and aiding in their individual development, at the Cliff Keen Wrestling Club in Ann Arbor, Michigan. His position allowed him to spend extensive time training alongside the top freestyle wrestlers in the country and to tour and compete in Russia, Chechnya and Ukraine.

A three-time All-American and 2009 Big Ten champion at Michigan, Todd made his mark on the Wolverine program wrestling at 184 and 197 pounds. In his first three seasons at 184, Todd posted an 82-24 record while placing fifth, third and second at the Big Ten Championships and earning as many trips to the NCAA Championships. Todd earned a spot on the podium his sophomore and junior campaigns, placing fifth and third, respectively.

Bumping up to 197 pounds in his final season, Todd registered a 25-3 record en route to a Big Ten title and a fourth-place showing at the NCAA Championships. He finished with a career record of 121-30, with his 121 wins ranking 16th all-time at Michigan. In four NCAA appearances, Todd compiled a 16-7 mark, which ranks seventh in program history. He is also tied for third all-time with a 13-4 career record at the Big Ten Championships.

Todd's pursuit of excellence extended beyond the mat and into the classroom. He was an All-Big Ten Academic selection and Athletic Academic Achievement Award winner in 2006, received the Snip Nalan Scholarship for Wrestling in 2008-09 and was named the team's Distinguished Scholar in 2009.

Todd also found success wrestling freestyle at 84 kg. He took fifth at the 2007 ASICS U.S. National Championships, eighth in 2008 and was seventh in 2011. In 2008, Todd placed fourth at the Olympic Trials, narrowly missing a bid for the Olympic Games in Beijing.

Todd is a native of Bozeman, Mont., and hails from a six-generation dairy farming operation. He received his bachelor's degree in secondary education from Michigan in 2009, majoring in history and minoring in psychology. He and his wife, Loni, have a daughter, Jacy Clair.
