ALL-TIME RECORDS

- This is the 40th season in Purdue Women's Basketball history. The Boilermakers are 774-411 all-time, including a 406-126 mark at home.
- Purdue is 188-92 under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is in her ninth season with the Boilermakers. She has a career record of 305-157.
- Purdue is 182-81 in December, including a 93-20 mark on its home court. The Boilermakers are 8-0 all-time on Dec. 20, including a 4-0 mark in Mackey Arena.
- Purdue is 25-14 all-time in the 10th game of the season.
- The Boilermakers are 1-2 all-time against teams from Colorado.
- Purdue is 496-186 when playing in its home state of Indiana.
- Purdue is 15-0 all-time against teams from the Summit League.
- Denver will be the 185th opponent in Purdue's history. The Boilermakers are 131-53 all-time in inaugural meetings.

GAME NOTES

- This weekend is the first time Purdue has played three games and three days since the 2012-13 season, when the Boilermakers played at the Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- The tournament is Purdue's first three consecutive-game homestand since hosting the BTI Classic in 2009, against Seattle, Dayton and Georgetown.
- UC Irvine was the Boilermakers' first opponent with a losing record this season. Purdue has played the No. 2 strength of schedule in the NCAA so far on the year.
- After last night's win, Purdue is now 137-3 all-time when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Purdue leads the Big Ten with 17.4 free throws made per game. The charity stripe accounts for 26.5 percent of the Boilermakers' offense.
- The Boilermakers are forcing 20.4 turnovers per game and turning them into 20.4 points per game (31% of their total points).
- Purdue is assisting on 67.8 percent of its made field goals, good for 11th in the nation.

MORE NOTES

- The Boilermakers are currently ranked 37th in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), and are the seventh-highest ranked team in the Big Ten. Purdue has played four opponents ranked in the top-50, and have another six on the remainder of its 2014-15 schedule.
- Bays is averaging 8.4 rebounds per game in her Boilermaker career, and is 10 games from earning the top spot on Purdue's career record list. Cathy Tyree currently holds the career record, averaging 7.4 boards per game from 1984-to-1987.
- Clemons has converted 52.4% of her field goal attempts in her career, and is tied for sixth in Purdue history with current assistant coach Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton.
- With 238 career assists, Wilson ranks 22nd in school history. She needs 248 to catch the next player on the list: Brittany Rayburn.
- Wilson also ranks third in school history with a 1.56:1 assist/turnover ratio. The school record is shared by Jennifer Jacoby (92-95) and Katie Gearlds (04-07) at 1.64:1.
- The Boilermakers feature one of their biggest teams in recent history featuring seven players of at least six-feet tall and an average of 71.9 inches in height per player. This figure makes the Boilermakers the third-tallest team in the Big Ten, following Penn State at 72.8 inches per player and Wisconsin at 72.5 inches per player.
- In addition to their height the Boilermakers feature an expansive wing-span on this year's team, averaging six feet, one and a half inches per player. Some of the longest Boilermakers include Torrie Thornton (6'0" tall/6'5.5" wingspan), Andreona Keys (5'10" tall/6'2" wingspan) and Justine Hall (5'10" tall/6'1" wingspan).
- Purdue has won more Big Ten Tournament Championships than any other conference team, taking home nine titles. Four of those have come under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is tied with former Ohio State coach Jim Foster for the most in conference history.
- Mackey Arena crowds have been ranked in the top-10 in the nation in 19 consecutive seasons, including the No. 6 ranked figure in 2013-14 at 7,388 fans per contest.
- The Boilermakers have three former Miss Basketball honorees on their bench, including head coach Sharon Versyp who was the first Indiana Miss Basketball to play at Purdue. Hayden Hamby was named Miss Basketball in Alabama as a junior and Ashley Morrisette earned Ohio's Miss Basketball crown as a senior in 2013.
- Versyp is the only coach in the Big Ten to lead her alma mater from the sidelines, and makes the Boilermakers the only school in the nation to feature both its men's and women's head basketball coaches as alumni.
- With 186 victories during her tenure at Purdue, Versyp remains just 20 wins shy of the Boilermakers' career record of 206, currently held by Lin Dunn, who went 206-68 from 1988-96.
- Purdue signed four players to national letters of intent on Wednesday, Nov. 12, welcoming Lamina Cooper, Nora Kiesler, Dominique McBryde and Tiara Murphy to the Boilermaker family. The class is ranked No. 8 by ESPNW HoopGurlz.

HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP

- NINTH YEAR AT PURDUE -
SCHOOL RECORD: 188-92 (88-46 BIG TEN)
CAREER RECORD: 305-157 (97-53)

Just as she did as a player, head coach Sharon Versyp has put her stamp on the Purdue women's basketball program. The former Boilermaker point guard has led Purdue to four Big Ten Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearances in her eight seasons as the head coach at her alma mater. She is the second-winningest coach in Purdue history, earning her 180th victory on the Boilermaker sidelines Feb. 20, 2014, and earned career victory No. 300 with an NCAA First Round victory March 22, 2014. She has compiled a 183-88 record with the Boilermakers, an average of 23 wins per season, a 300-153 record in 14 seasons as a Division I head coach, and her current contract has secured her presence on the Boilermaker sidelines through at least the 2019-20 season.

Versyp's impact on basketball in the Hoosier state was recognized on April 24, 2010, when she was inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in her first year of eligibility, an honor that includes Larry Bird and John Wooden. On June 22, 2013, Versyp was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame for her stint as the head coach at Maine and her ensuing success. In addition to being named the America East Conference Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2005, Versyp was named the 2007 WBCA Region VI Coach of the Year and most recently was honored as the 2014 ESPNW Big Ten Coach of the Year.

Versyp has guided 25 players to All-Big Ten accolades at Purdue, including four first-team selections, and three Boilermakers have been recognized with All-America honors. Katie Gearlds was a Third Team All-America pick in 2007, while Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton received honorable mention recognition the same year and Drey Mingo was also honorable mention All-America in 2013. Purdue has also seen four members of the conference All-Freshman Team, six Big Ten All-Defensive Team members and a pair of Big Ten Sixth Players of the Year under Versyp, in addition to four Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Players and 14 all-tournament team members. Three Boilermakers have been selected in the WNBA draft during Versyp's tenure as Gearlds was picked seventh by the Seattle Storm in 2007, Wisdom-Hylton was selected 13th by the Los Angeles Sparks and Danielle Campbell was picked 32nd by the Indiana Fever in 2009.

The Boilermakers have secured an NCAA Tournament bid in seven of eight seasons under Versyp, advancing to the Elite Eight twice and to the second round on the five other occasions. In 2007, the Boilermakers earned the No. 2 seed in the Dallas Region, dispatching No. 15 seed Oral Roberts, seventh-seeded Georgia Tech and No. 3 seed Georgia before falling in the national quarterfinals. The 2009 NCAA Tournament run came as a No. 6 seed in the Oklahoma City Region, as Purdue topped 11th-

seeded Charlotte, upset No. 3 seed North Carolina and moved past seventh-seeded Rutgers before suffering a six-point loss in the regional final. In addition to their Elite Eight seedings, the Boilermakers have been a No. 9 seed twice and a No. 4 seed three times in their five other appearances.

Purdue's four Big Ten Tournament titles under Versyp have come in impressive and dramatic fashion, garnering a 15-4 record at the event in eight appearances. Never once entering the tournament as the top seed, the Boilermakers earned the 2007 and 2008 tournament titles, followed up with the 2012 and 2013 titles, and are one of just three teams in the conference to ever win consecutive tournament championships. The Boilermakers' nine Big Ten Tournament titles are a conference-best and the four championships under Versyp equal the total of the next-best team in the tournament's 20-year history.

Versyp returned to her alma mater as Purdue's eighth head coach on April 10, 2006, to build upon the excellence of Purdue women's basketball. Her first year with the Boilermakers was one for the record books as she set a Boilermaker coaching record with a mark of 31-6, shattering the previous win record for a Purdue first-year head coach. The 31 victories matched the second-highest win total in school history, and their .838 win percentage is the fifth-best for a season in the Boilermaker archives. It is one of just three 30+ win seasons in 39 years of Purdue women's basketball, matching their 2001 Final Four appearance and three shy of the 34-win, 1999 NCAA Championship season.
