THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue (7-4) looks to end its pre-Holiday slate on a high note as it faces No. 17-ranked Butler (10-1) in the annual Crossroads Classic at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis on Saturday. The contest will tip at 2:30 p.m. ET, on BTN with Kevin Kugler and Robbie Hummel on the call. On the radio, Rob Blackman, Larry Clisby and Ralph Taylor will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1:30 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com.
- Purdue owns a 39-19 record against Butler, having won two straight games against the Bulldogs. However, Purdue is just 1-3 against Butler in the Crossroads Classic.
- SOMETHING TO WATCH: Two of the nation's best defensive teams will go at it Saturday at Bankers Life Fieldhouse.

- A win would give Purdue eight wins before Christmas for the 12th time in Matt Painter's 15 years at Purdue. The lone years Purdue did not win eight games came in 2018-19 (6-5), 2012-13 (5-6) and 2005-06 (5-4).
- The Boilermakers are 83-42 all time against the Big East Conference, but lost earlier this year to Marquette in the Gavitt Games (65-55).
- Purdue has scuffled on the offensive end the last three games, averaging just 61.0 points per game while shooting 38.1 percent from the field and just 24.0 percent (18 of 75) from 3-point range.
- Purdue has outrebounded every team it has played this year, ranking 25th nationally in rebound margin.
- Purdue's two centers (Trevion Williams, Matt Haarms) are shooting a combined 82 of 131 (.626) from the field. The rest of the roster is shooting a combined 195 of 524 (.372) from the field.
- Purdue has held its first 11 opponents to 70 or fewer points, the longest streak since the 2010-11 squad held its first 19 opponents to 70 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 7-0 this year when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. The Boilermakers are 0-4 when allowing 60-plus.
- Purdue is 6-0 this year and 26-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.
- Purdue is 6-0 this year and has won 17 straight games when attempting more free throws than its opponent.
- Purdue is 5-4 this year against unranked teams. Over the two previous years, the Boilermakers were 47-7 (.870) vs. unranked teams. Purdue went 20-4 a year and 27-3 in the 2017-18 season.
- Over the last two games, Trevion Williams has 32 points, 20 rebounds and six assists in 43 minutes played.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Butler by a 39-19 margin, having won two straight games with the Bulldogs. The streak was preceded by a five-game winning streak by Butler from 2001 to 2015.
- Butler leads the series in the Crossroads Classic by a 3-1 advantage.
 Butler's three wins have come by 2, 6 and 6 points. The Boilermakers have actually outscored the Bulldogs by one point in the Crossroads Classic (285-284).
- The last meeting between the two teams came in the 2018 NCAA
 Tournament's second round. Dakota Mathias hit a 3-pointer with
 14 seconds left in the game to give Purdue a 76-71 lead in Detroit.
 The Boilermakers would advance to the Sweet 16 with a 76-73 win.
- Butler hasn't scored 80 points against Purdue since 1990, and has done so just twice in 58 all-time meetings.
- Purdue is ranked 9th in the latest KenPom rankings, while Butler is 10th. KenPom predicts a mere 60 possessions in the game. For comparison purposes, there were 58 possessions in the Virginia-Purdue contest. Purdue ranks 342nd nationally in tempo, while Butler ranks 341st, making it possibly one of the slowest-tempoed games in the country this season.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Purdue's defense ranks fifth nationally in KenPom's adjusted defensive efficiency ratings behind Virginia, Louisville, Duke and Ohio State allowing just 86.0 points per 100 possessions.
- Through Wednesday's games, Purdue ranks sixth in scoring defense, 25th in rebound margin, 27th in 3-point percentage defense, 36th in field goal percentage defense and 61th in turnover margin.
- Purdue has held its first 11 opponents of the season to 70 or fewer points for the first time since the 2010-11 season. That team did it in 19 straight games.
- Purdue has forced at least 16 turnovers in six of 11 games this year.

- Purdue has held opponents to just 84 offensive rebounds (7.6 per game) for a total of 79 second-chance points (7.2 per game).
- Opponents have shot over 39.0 percent just three this year (Texas, VCU, Nebraska). Foes have shot under 30.0 percent from deep in seven games.
- Just three opponents have averaged 1.00 points / possession (Texas, Marquette and Nebraska) and none above 1.10.
- Purdue has outrebounded every opponent it has played this year.

KEEP THEM OFF THE LINE

- Through the first seven games of the year, opponents were 87 of 128 (.680) from the free throw line, averaging 18.3 attempts per game.
- Over the last four games, opponents are just 18 of 29 (.621), averaging just 7.3 attempts per game.
- Purdue is averaging just 13.5 fouls per game in the last four games.

OFFENSE CLICKS IN CHALLENGE

- Purdue had one of its best offensive games of the season in the win over Virginia. The Boilermakers shot 45.3 percent from the field, made a Purdue-challenge record 13 (of 25) 3-point attempts and had a Purdue-challenge low seven turnovers.
- Since the start of the 2017-18 season (a span of 83 games), Virginia has allowed 1.19 points per possession just four times. Purdue has done it twice.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- Purdue has always stressed winning the extra-possession game and it typically means success when it wins the rebounding and turnover battles.
- Purdue is 6-2 this year 122-13 under Coach Painter when winning both the rebound and turnover battles.

- Purdue is 2-0 this year against nationally-ranked teams, defeating VCU (59-56) and Virginia (69-40) in the process.
- The Boilermakers are 5-4 against unranked teams this year.

- · With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady 7; Bobby Knight 5; Bo Ryan 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
