THE OPENING TIP

- The highly-anticipated 124th season of Purdue Basketball gets unofficially underway tonight, as UIndy visits Mackey Arena for an exhibition contest, the final tuneup for the Boilermakers. Purdue opens the regular season next Tuesday by hosting Bellarmine.
- Purdue is 26-0 under Matt Painter in exhibition games, having won the 26 games by an average of 25.8 points per game. Purdue has won nine straight exhibition games by at least 19 points.
- The contest will be streamed online by BIG+ with David Weiderhaft and Meghan McKeown on the call. On the radio waves, Rob Blackman and Bobby Riddell will be courtside (Wes Scott producing) on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network as well as online on the Varsity Sports Network. Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Purdue begins the season in search of its 25th Big Ten Championship, having won two of the last five regular-season titles (2017, 2019). The Boilermakers are the all-time leader in Big Ten regular-season championships, two ahead of rival Indiana (22).
- The Boilermakers return all five starters, and almost 95 percent of their scoring from a year ago. Purdue returns 90.9 minutes played from a year ago, the second-highest total in major-conference basketball (behind Butler). The Boilermakers return 218 career starts.
- Purdue will have 10 players on its roster that have yet to play a game in front of crowds, either at home or on the road.
- Purdue's preseason AP ranking of No. 7 matches the highest preseason rank of the Painter era (2009-10; 7th).
- Purdue returnees have scored a combined 3,526 points at Purdue, appearing in 489 career games among them.
- Trevion Williams and Jaden Ivey have been named preseason All-Americans by almost every publication. Purdue has had an All-American in five of the last six years (A.J. Hammons - HM in 2016; Caleb Swanigan - 1st team in 2017; Carsen Edwards - 2nd team in 2018; Edwards - 2nd team in 2019; Williams - HM in 2021).
- Purdue has finished in the top four of the Big Ten standings in 10 of the last 14 seasons under Coach Painter.
- Matt Painter needs two wins in Big Ten play to tie Jud Heathcote for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (182).
- Purdue has won 991 Big Ten games in school history, needing nine league wins to become the first school with 1,000 Big Ten victories.
- Purdue enters the season with 24 consecutive sellouts, not including the exhibition games. It has announced 10 sellouts already this year.

- The Boilermakers own a 66-7 (.904) all-time record in exhibition games, having won 31 straight contests.
- Since 1991-92, Purdue is 52-3 (.945) in exhibition games.
- Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue is 26-0 in exhibition games, winning by an average of 25.8 points per game (670 points in 26 games). Purdue has won nine straight exhibition games by at least 18 points.
- In years that Purdue won its exhibition opener by at least 19 points in the Painter era, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

- With all five starters back and 135 of a possible 140 starts returning from a year ago, Purdue returns almost all of its production from last year.

RETURNING STARTS EQUALS SUCCESS

- Purdue will return 135 starts (of a possible 140), the fewest starts the program is losing from the previous season in the Painter era.
- In four previous years that Purdue returned at least 130 starts, Purdue has posted a 112-32 record with four NCAA Tournament appearances, three Sweet 16 trips and a school-record 30 wins in 2017-18.

IT STAYS THE SAME

- Purdue will return all five starters from last season and over 90.0 percent of minutes played. It marks the first time since the 2009-10 season that all five starters return. That team went 29-6 and reached as high as No. 3 in the national polls in February.

- Purdue has been ranked in the preseason poll in 6 of last 7 years.
- Purdue has been ranked in four straight weeks, dating to last year.

FRESHMAN CLASS RETURNS AFTER BIG YEAR

- This year's seven-member sophomore class had an outstanding campaign a year ago, ranking fifth among all Purdue freshman classes in points scored (885) and fourth in points per game (31.6).
- The class was even more impressive in league play, averaging 31.2 points and accounting for 45.2 percent of Purdue's scoring in Big Ten action.
- Purdue's rookie class scored the fifth-most points (885) of any rookie class in the country, while accounting for the fourth-highest percentage of points scored (.445) among freshman classes.

DEFENSE LIVES HERE

- While the Boilermakers have turned into more of an offensive-minded team lately, it still boasts an outstanding defense.
- Purdue is one of nine teams to rank in the top 80 of the NCAA's scoring defense in each of the last six years (Purdue, Loyola Chicago, Maryland, New Mexico State, San Diego State, Texas State, UC Irvine, Virginia, Wisconsin).
- The Boilermakers are one of five teams to rank in the top 80 of field goal percentage defense for seven straight years (Purdue, Maryland, San Diego State, UC Irvine, Wichita State).
- When you add rebound margin to the fold, Purdue and New Mexico State are the only programs to rank in the top-90 of scoring defense, field goal percentage defense and rebound margin in each of the last six years.

MARGINS MATTER

- Purdue has won by at least 25 points in 11 of **Matt Painter's** 14 season-opening victories.
- In each of those 11 seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- Going even further back, in the last 16 occurrences dating to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

QUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY

- Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 20 of the last 41 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 10 times (in 16 seasons) under head coach **Matt Painter**, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 355-184 (.659) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 380-189 (.668) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
