THE OPENING TIP

- The highly-anticipated 124th season of Purdue Basketball gets underway Tuesday, as Division I upstart Bellarmine visits Mackey Arena for the season opener. This will be the 55th season at Mackey Arena, where Purdue has a 48-6 record in home openers.
- The Boilermakers are 102-21 (.830) all-time in season openers, including 15-1 under head coach **Matt Painter**. Purdue has won eight straight season openers by an average of 28.1 points per game.
- The contest will be streamed online by B1G+ with **David Weiderhaft** and **Meghan McKeown** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside (**Wes Scott** producing) on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue begins the season in search of its 25th Big Ten Championship, having won two of the last five regular-season titles (2017, 2019). The Boilermakers are the all-time leader in Big Ten regular-season championships, two ahead of rival Indiana (22).
- 2) The Boilermakers return all five starters, and almost 95 percent of their scoring from a year ago. Purdue returns 90.9 minutes played from a year ago, the second-highest total in major-conference basketball (behind Butler). The Boilermakers return 218 career starts.
- 3) Purdue will have 10 players on its roster that have yet to play a game in front of crowds, either at home or on the road.
- 4) Purdue's preseason AP ranking of No. 7 matches the highest preseason rank of the Painter era (2009-10; 7th).
- 5) Purdue returnees have scored a combined 3.526 points at Purdue, appearing in 489 career games among them.
- 6) Trevion Williams and Jaden Ivey have been named preseason All-Americans by almost every publication. Purdue has had an All-American in five of the last six years (A.J. Hammons HM in 2016; Caleb Swanigan 1st team in 2017; Carsen Edwards 2nd team in 2018; Edwards 2nd team in 2019; Williams HM in 2021).
- 7) Purdue has finished in the top four of the Big Ten standings in 10 of the last 14 seasons under Coach Painter.
- 8) Matt Painter needs two wins in Big Ten play to tie Jud Heathcote for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (182).
- 9) Purdue has won 991 Big Ten games in school history, needing nine league wins to become the first school with 1,000 Big Ten victories.
- 101 Purdue enters the season with 24 consecutive sellouts, not including the exhibition games. It has announced 10 sellouts already this year.

SEASON OPENER NOTES

- The Boilermakers open their 124th season of competition Tuesday when Division I upstart Bellarmine visits Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers own a 102-21 (.830) record in season openers, including a 15-1 (.938) record under Matt Painter.
- Purdue has won eight openers in a row by a combined 225 points (28.1 PPG). Purdue has allowed more than 60 points in a season opener just seven times under Painter.
- Purdue is 10-2 all-time against members of the Atlantic Sun Conference, including 5-1 under Painter at Purdue.
- This marks the second straight season that Purdue has opened against an Atlantic Sun opponent after topping Liberty 77-64 in last year's opener at the SpaceCoast Challenge.

- Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 20 of the last 41 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 10 times (in 16 seasons) under head coach Matt Painter, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

RECAPPING THE UINDY EXHIBITION WIN

- Purdue defeated UIndy 86-64 in its lone exhibition game in front of a sell-out crowd of 14,804 in Mackey Arena. It marked the first game in front of fans for 10 players on the roster.
- Purdue won its 32nd straight exhibition game, including a 27-0 mark under **Matt Painter**.
- In years that Purdue won its exhibition opener by at least 19 points in the Painter era, Purdue eventually reached the NCAA Tournament.
- Purdue's six turnovers were its fewest in an exhibition game during the Painter era.
- Purdue started the game 3-of-11 from the free throw line, but finished the game by making 11 of its last 12 attempts (14-of-23 overall).
- **Zach Edey** scored 20 points in 20 minutes of action. He scored 12 straight Purdue points during the second half.
- Purdue's sophomore class scored 45 of Purdue's 86 points and went 16-of-27 (.593) from the field and 6-of-12 from long range. Jaden Ivey went 3-of-4 from long distance.
- Caleb Furst became the first true freshman to start an exhibition game since Caleb Swanigan on Nov. 8, 2015.

RETURNING STARTS EQUALS SUCCESS

- Purdue will return 135 starts (of a possible 140), the fewest starts the program is losing from the previous season in the Painter era.

- ▶ Record at Purdue: 355-184 (.659) / 17th year | Career Record: 380-189 (.668) / 18th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments the seventh-longest active streak in COACHING EXPERIENCE America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.

- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady 7: Bobby Knight 5: Bo Ryan 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
