GAME 01: The Facts

- Purdue opens the 2015-16 season on Friday, Nov. 13, when North Carolina A&T comes to town as part of the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic. Tip is slated for 7 p.m. ET from Mackey Arena (14,846) in West Lafayette.
- The contest will be streamed online on BTN2Go.com with **Tommy Barrett** and **Connor Hoke** calling the action courtside.
- On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.
- Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com, and StatBroadcast will provide media stats (password protected) at bit.ly/PurdueLiveStats. As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

- The 23rd-ranked Boilermakers are coming off a 92-43 win over Northwestern Ohio in their lone exhibition game of the year on Sunday. Purdue suffocated the Racers in the second half, holding them to 3-of-30 shooting and 10 points after leading 51-33 at halftime.
- Sophomores **Vince Edwards** and **Isaac Haas** had 18 points each and freshman **Caleb Swanigan** added 12 points, 11 rebounds and four assists. The trio combined for 48 points, 21 rebound and eight assists.
- Purdue freshmen and sophomores combined for 67 points, 39 rebounds and 26 assists in the win over the Racers.
- As a team, the Boilermakers shot 33-of-68 (.485) from the field and 9-of-29 (.310) from three-point range. Purdue was 17-of-20 (.850) from the free throw line, making its first 11 free throws of the game.
- Purdue also had just nine turnovers with five of them coming in the last 33-plus minutes of the contest. Purdue outrebounded the Racers, 45-34.

Scouting North Carolina A&T

- North Carolina A&T went 9-23 last year but returns all five starters. However, in its exhibition game against Pfeiffer last Thursday, the Aggies started four newcomers all via transfer.
- Senior **Bruce Beckford** is a preseason All-MEAC performer after averaging 15.2 points and 7.3 rebounds per game last year. He recorded a double-double (13 points, 12 rebounds) in the Aggies' exhibition loss to Pfeiffer College last Thursday (65-62, overtime).
- Sophomore **Sam Hunt**, a transfer from Jacksonville University, had 21 points against Pfeiffer, but went just 6-of-18 from the field. As a team, the Aggies were 21-of-81 (.259) from the field in the loss.

The Coaches

- Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 212-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 212 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.
- Cy Alexander** (Catawba, 1975) is in his fourth year as the head coach at North Carolina A&T, owning a 38-63 record at the school. He is in his 27th year as a collegiate head coach owning a 381-369 career record.

THE BIG NUMBER

Purdue is 9-1 under head coach Matt Painter in season openers. Seven of the nine wins have been by 25 or more points, including last year's 80-40 win over Samford.

■ **Inside the Series**

- This marks the first meeting against the Aggies. The game is part of the Naismith Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic.
- Purdue is 8-0 all-time against teams from the MEAC, winning by an average margin of 27.8 points per game. Every win over the MEAC has come by at least 20 points.
- Purdue will also play MEAC member Howard on Dec. 9.
- Purdue owns a 96-21 (.821) in 117 previous season openers.
- The Boilermakers are 9-1 under **Matt Painter** in season openers (loss: 2012).
- Purdue owns a 4-0 mark all-time on November 13.
- North Carolina A&T marks the 13th Division I school from the state of North Carolina that Purdue will have played. The Boilermakers own a 21-17 all-time record against the state.
- **Jacquil Taylor's** brother, Maurice, played for the Aggies during the 2013-14 season before transferring to Niagara.

■ **Painter In Season Openers**

- Purdue head coach **Matt Painter** is 10-1 in his 11 previous season openers, including a 9-1 mark at Purdue.
- Under Painter, Purdue has reached seven NCAA Tournaments in his 10 previous years. During the years that Purdue lost or won its season opener by single digits, the Boilermakers failed to reach the NCAA Tournament.

- Overall, Purdue owns a 96-21 record (.821) in season openers.
- Purdue has won 32 of its last 38 openers, dating back to 1977-78.
- Purdue is averaging 80.3 points per game in Matt Painter season openers, while allowing 54.7 points per game.
- Just three times in 10 season openers has Painter allowed foes to score 70 points (2005-06, 2012-13, 2013-14).
- In fact, Purdue has held more teams (5) to 50 points or less in season openers than times it has allowed 60 points (4).

■ **Exhibition Dominance**

- Following Sunday's 92-43 win over Northwestern Ohio, the Boilermakers own a 61-7 (.897) record all-time against exhibition foes, having won 26 straight games.
- Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue is 21-0 in exhibition games, winning by an average of 26.2 points per game (551 points in 21 games).
- In eight of the 10 previous seasons that Purdue won its exhibition opener by 30 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament at the end of the season, including last year.

■ **Big Men Domination**

- Expecting to exploit the inside and play inside-out for most of the season, Purdue took full advantage of the mismatches in Sunday's exhibition win over Northwestern Ohio.
- The Boilermakers' starting three frontline players (**Vince Edwards**, **Isaac Haas** and **Caleb Swanigan**) accounted for 48 points, 21 rebounds and eight assists (against five turnovers) while shooting 17-of-27 (.630) from the field.

■ **Youth Is Served**

- In Purdue's 92-43 win over Northwestern Ohio on Sunday evening, freshmen and sophomores accounted for 67 points, 39 rebounds (all but three rebounds) and 26 assists against just eight turnovers.

- The group shot a combined 23-of-47 (.489) from the field and 16-of-18 (.889) from the free throw line.

■ **Sharing is Caring**

- Purdue made 33 field goals in the win over Northwestern Ohio, handing out assists on 31 of them.
- Five different players had at least three assists and every player that played at least five minutes recorded an assist.

■ **Allow Me to Introduce Myself**

- Three true freshmen could make their Division I regular-season debut on Friday night against North Carolina A&T.

■ **Big Margins in Season Openers**

- Purdue has won by at least 25 points in seven of **Matt Painter's** 10 season openers, including a modern-day school-record 62-point margin over Northern Illinois to tip off the 2011-12 season.
- In each of those seven seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- Going even further back, in the last 11 occurrences dating back to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

■ Boilers Hot at Home

• Purdue will enter the 2015-16 season having won six straight games at Mackey Arena, which includes three games against ranked opponents. Purdue won the six straight games by a combined 46 points (7.7 PPG).

• With nine non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would tie for the sixth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

■ Boilermakers Racking Up Preseason Honors

• Several Boilermakers have been named among preseason all-Big Ten and watch lists.

• **A.J. Hammons** was named one of the top 20 big men by Sports Illustrated and was selected the third-best post man by Athlon Magazine. He was a unanimous first-team selection the Big Ten Conference, Sporting News and Athlon.

• **Caleb Swanigan** was named one of 10 "impact freshmen" nationally and a third-team all-Big Ten honoree by Athlon. Sporting News named him the top newcomer in the Big Ten.

• Lastly, **Vince Edwards** was named one of the 20 best wings in America by Sports Illustrated.

■ November Reign

• Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 33-1 (.971) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65). The average margin of victory in those games is 24.0 points (815 points).

• Going back further, Purdue is 68-7 (.907) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.

■ Blocked Shot University

• In six of the last seven years, Purdue has had the Big Ten's top shot-blocker as **A.J. Hammons** led the league in blocked shots for the third straight season (2.78 BPG) a year ago.

• Hammons' 2.78 blocks per game were the most for a Big Ten player since Ohio State's **Greg Oden** averaged 3.44 BPG in the 2006-07 season. It's the second-best average since the 2001-02 season (behind Oden).

• Hammons became the third player in Big Ten history to lead the league in blocked shots at least three times (2013-15). Penn State's **Calvin Booth** led the league in blocks four times from 1996-99, while Purdue's **JaJuan Johnson** led the league from 2009-11.

• Prior to 2009, no Purdue player had ever led the league in blocked shots.

• Purdue's 177 blocks were the most in a season in school history and the 5.21 blocked shots per game were the second-highest average in school history behind last year's average of 5.25 blocks per game.

■ Close Encounters

• Seventeen of Purdue's last 21 games were decided by single digits, including 11 of the last 13 games (7-4 record). All nine of its Big Ten road games were decided by single-digits (4-5 record).

• For the season, Purdue went 12-11 in games decided by 1-9 points.

■ Miscellaneous Notes

• Purdue trailed at halftime in nine of its 20 games against Big Ten opponents a year ago, posting a 7-2 record in those games.

• Eight different players led the team in scoring last year. Six of those players return this year.

• Purdue forced 19 shot clock violations last year.

• When **Rapheal Davis** and **A.J. Hammons** each reached double-figures last year, Purdue went 11-2 (losses to Gardner-Webb, Ohio State).

■ Paint Patrol

• Purdue allowed just four opponents (Kansas State, Notre Dame, Minnesota, Wisconsin -- all losses) to outscore it in the paint last year. Of the 2,373 points that Purdue has scored this year, 46.2 percent of the scoring came in the paint (1,096 points).

• Purdue's two centers, **A.J. Hammons** and **Isaac Haas**, averaged a combined 19.5 PPG and 10.7 RPG while shooting 248-of-461 (.538) from the field.

• The duo combined for 25 points and 16 rebounds in the loss to Cincinnati, while going 11-of-18 from the field.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 137-31 (.815) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 73-7 (.913) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
