LAURA GLITZ

Head Coach // Eighth Season

Laura Glitz enters her eighth year at Purdue and has reached unprecedented success. Glitz led the Boilermakers to their first Big Ten Tournament title in program history in 2012 following the best conference conclusion since 1998 with a third place Big Ten finish in 2011. She also has led the team to back-to-back 18 win seasons in 2012 and 2013, the most wins in a single season in program history.

During her seven years at the helm, Glitz has guided the Boilermakers to the three winningest season in Purdue history, 2011 (17), 2012 (18) and 2013 (18) and averages 13 wins per season. She owns a 91-68 (.572) overall record with the Old Gold and Black. Four of her squads have been ranked for the entire season by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) and at the conclusion of the 2014 season, has a streak of 76 consecutive poll appearances dating back to March 2, 2010.

Four of Glitz's players have combined to earn All-Big Ten honors five times and five players have earned Big Ten Athlete of the Week honors on six occasions. In the classroom, she has had 14 ITA Scholar-Athletes and 25 Academic All-Big selections.

In 2014, Glitz coached Purdue past seven nationally ranked opponents en route to a 12-win season that saw the Boilermakers advance to the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament and punch their third-straight ticket to the NCAA Championships. The team was ranked as high as No. 27. Also appearing in the rankings were singles player Mara Schmidt and the doubles teams of Schmit and Krisztina Kapitany and Schmidt and Andjela Djokovic. Daniela Vidal was named the Ohio Valley Region ITA/Arthur Ashe Jr. Collegiate Award for Leadership & Sportsmanship Award winner.

ANTHONY NGUYEN

Assistant Coach // First Season

Anthony Nguyen was named Purdue's women's tennis assistant coach on Oct. 27, 2014. Nguyen joins the Boilermakers after spending the past six seasons as the men's tennis head coach, while concurrently serving as the women's head coach the last four seasons.

Nguyen inherited a women's program that didn't field a team for the 2010-11 season and within two seasons, he led it to a first-place tie in the conference with a record of 6-1 and a share of the regular season Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) title. That same season, 2012-13, his women's squad registered the program's most wins (14) since the 2004-05 season.

On the men's side, all six of his squads advanced to the MAAC Tournament and he had numerous players named to All-MAAC teams. Four Purple Eagles were tabbed as the MAAC Rookie of the Year during Nguyen's tenure, three on the women's side (2012-14) and one men's player (2010). The three consecutive women's awards were a first in MAAC history.

Nguyen established another MAAC first during the 2012-13 campaign as he became the first coach in MAAC history to earn both the Men's and Women's Tennis Coach of the Year awards.

Nguyen's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom. The men's team received the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) All-Academic team honor in 2012, 2013 and 2014. Ten of his players, a program-best seven men's players and a trio from the women's team, were MAAC All-Academic selections in 2014. Each season multiple men's and women's players landed on the ITA's Scholar-Athlete award list.
