### GAME 11: The Facts

• Purdue looks for just its seventh 11-0 start or better in 118 seasons of basketball on Saturday when Youngstown State visits West Lafayette for the second meeting all-time between the two schools.

• The contest will be streamed online from Mackey Arena on ESPN3 at 2 p.m. ET, with **Zach Zaidman** and **Rich Zvosec** calling the action courtside.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the 27-station Purdue Sports Network as well as SIRIUS (Ch. 136) and XM (Ch. 196) satellite radio. Coverage begins with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip.

• Live stats will be available via Gametracker on [PurdueSports.com](http://PurdueSports.com). As always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

### Scouting Purdue

• The No. 11-ranked Boilermakers are 10-0 and are one of two teams nationally (Saint Mary's) to have won all of its games by 10 or more points. Saint Mary's is 6-0 entering Saturday's game at California.

• The Boilermakers have won 10 games in a row by double-digits for the first time in school history.

• Purdue has held five straight foes to 59 points or less and rank in the top 10 nationally in field goal percentage defense (2nd), scoring defense (4th) and rebound margin (8th).

• **Isaac Haas** and **A.J. Hammons** have combined to average 23.4 points and 11.4 rebounds per game from the center position.

• A question mark entering the year, the point guard position has turned into a positive. **P.J. Thompson** and **Johnny Hill** average a combined 12.3 points, 5.0 assists and 6.1 rebounds while shooting 35-of-60 (.583).

### Scouting Youngstown State

• Youngstown State spent the last week in finals and hasn't played since a 60-56 home loss to American on Dec. 4.

• The Penguins have four players in double-figures led by forward **Bobby Hain** at 15.2 PPG and **Cameron Morse** at 15.1 PPG off the bench.

• Youngstown State is averaging 75.3 points per game while giving up 74.9 points per contest. The Penguins are shooting 42.9 percent from the field and 34.1 percent from long distance.

• Youngstown State is also getting outrebounded by 2.3 boards per game. Purdue is outrebounding its foes by 13.0 rebounds per game.

• The Penguins had won four games in a row before the loss to American.

### The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 222-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 222 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Jerry Slocum** (King's College, 1975) is in his 12th year at Youngstown State and 41st year as a head coach. Slocum is one of 18 active coaches (all divisions) to have won 700 career games.

### THE BIG NUMBER

Purdue's point guards, **P.J. Thompson** and **Johnny Hill**, have an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.50, dishing out 50 assists against 20 turnovers in 401 minutes this year.

**■ Painter Moving Up the Charts**

- **Matt Painter** has moved into third place on the school's career games coached list, leading his squad into his 348th game in his 11th season on Saturday against Youngstown State.
- Painter owns a 222-125 (.639) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- With the 10-0 start, Painter has moved into fifth place on the school's career winning percentage list with a .639 winning percentage.

**■ Program Stability**

- Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

**■ Reaching Double-Figures**

- During the NCAA Tournament era (since 1938), Purdue has started 10-0 or better just three times including this season. In the previous two years that Purdue started at least 10-0 (1993-94, 2009-10), the Boilermakers set a school record for victories with 29 and own a combined 58-11 record (.841).
- With a win against Youngstown State, Purdue will start 11-0 for just the third time in the last 75 years (1993-94; 2009-10) and just for the seventh time in school history.

**■ Winning Margins**

- Through games played on Thursday, there are 10 remaining undefeated teams. Of those 10 teams, Purdue and Saint Mary's are the only teams to have won all of its games by double-digits.
- This year's team became the first team in school history to win 10 straight games by double-digits following its 38-point win over Howard.

**■ Gameday Adjustments**

- Last year, Purdue went 0-4 when being outscored in the paint. Already twice this year, Purdue has won three games when being outscored in the paint (Vermont, Florida, Pittsburgh).

**■ Boilermakers Hot at Home**

- Purdue enters Saturday's game against Youngstown State having won 13 straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the 13 straight games by a combined 248 points (19.1 PPG).
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is now 21-3 at home and its 13-game winning streak is the 15th-longest streak in the country and the second-longest winning streak in the Big 10 (Maryland - 18).

- **Matt Painter** now owns five double-digit homecourt winning streaks in his 11 years at Purdue, and the current 13-game homecourt winning streak is the eighth-longest streak in Mackey Arena history and third longest of the Painter era.

**■ Purdue Winning Streaks**

- Purdue has won 10 straight games and is nearing the top-10 list for the longest winning streak in school history. The school record for consecutive wins is 16 set twice.

**■ Win When Shooting More**

- Purdue has won 25 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including seven times this year.

**■ The Word According to Ken Pomeroy**

- Purdue is one of seven teams to rank in the top 20 of both offensive and defensive efficiency. The Boilermakers allow 89.4 points / 100 possession on the defensive end and score 113.0 points / 100 possessions on the offensive end.

- Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense of 37.3 percent is second nationally behind Oklahoma (37.1).
- The Boilermakers are 16th nationally in assist rate (assists / FGM) at 66.3 percent.
- Lastly, Purdue is 29th nationally in defensive free throw attempts / field goal attempts at 26.8 percent. That means foes are shooting 26.8 free throws for every 100 field goal attempts, which shows Purdue does an excellent job of not fouling and sending teams to the free throw line.

### ■ Making More Than They Shoot

• The goal of all good teams is to make more free throws than their opponents shoot and through 10 games this year, Purdue is doing that.

• The Boilermakers have made 165 free throws while opponents have shot just 164 free throws.

### ■ Sharing is Caring

• Purdue recorded 28 assists against Howard, the most since having 30 against Alcorn State on Nov. 17, 2010.

• Purdue also recorded an assist:turnover ratio of 4.67 (28:6), the fourth-best ratio in a game in school history. Earlier this year, Purdue had a 4.80 (24:5) ratio against Vermont, the third-best ratio in a game in school history.

• In the win over Howard, 10 different players had assists and six different players had at least two assists.

### ■ Before the Calendar Turns

• Purdue is 76-6 (.927) under **Matt Painter** at Mackey Arena against non-conference foes before the calendar turns to January.

### ■ Defense Lives Here

• Purdue ranks second nationally in field goal percentage and that comes even without the Big Ten's top defensive player in **Rapheal Davis** being in the lineup for a four-game span.

• Purdue leads the country in 2-point percentage defense (.357) and is 19th in the country in 3-point percentage defense (.273). Purdue, Oklahoma, Michigan State, Washington, Gonzaga and Nevada are the only teams in America to rank in the top 40 of both 2-point and 3-point percentage defense.

• Purdue has held four of its 10 opponents under 30.0 percent shooting and seven of its 10 foes to 59 points or less, including five straight.

• When holding foes under 59 points during the Painter era, the Boilermakers are 110-4.

• Purdue is fourth in the country in scoring defense and is the only team in America to rank in the top 20 in field goal percentage defense (2nd), scoring defense (4th), rebound margin (8th) and 3-point percentage defense (19th).

• Purdue leads the country in defensive points per possession at 0.78. West Virginia is second at 0.79 points per possession.

### ■ Efficient Offense

• Purdue ranks 14th nationally in **Ken Pomeroy's** offensive adjusted efficiency rankings and 33rd in effective field goal percentage. When the Boilermakers miss shots, it rebounds 36.5 percent of its misses, good for 39th nationally.

• In the NCAA rankings through games played on Wednesday, Purdue is in the nation's top 60 in several categories. The improvement from last year is staggering.

• Last year marked the first time in the Painter era that Purdue had finished in the top 100 in field goal percentage offense and defense in the same season. The Boilermakers are well on their way to doing that again this year.

### ■ Hot From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

• A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.

• Eight different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Hammons, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan, Thompson). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.

• Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in five games this year. The school record for most games with at least 10 3-pointers in a season was in 2011-12 (10 in 35 games).

• Purdue has outscored its foes by 126 points from beyond the arc.

• However, Purdue has cooled down from deep over the last three games, connecting on 22-of-74 (.297) from long distance.

### ■ Notes From the Lead

• Purdue has trailed in just six of its 10 games (400 minutes) this year and for a grand total of 15 minutes, 36 seconds. When it trailed by 6:37 against New Mexico last Saturday, that was the longest stretch it has trailed in a game this season.

• Over the last nine games (360 minutes), Purdue has trailed for a total of 9 minutes, 55 seconds.

• Purdue's largest deficit of the season has been four points, which came when North Carolina A&T took a 4-0 lead two minutes into the season opener and then in the second half against New Mexico (39-35).

• When the Boilermakers trailed Pittsburgh for 47 seconds in the second half on Dec. 1, it marked the first time all season Purdue trailed in the second half -- seven games into the season.

### ■ Purdue's Bench a Real Advantage

• Purdue has outscored its opponents' bench by a total of 371-140 so far this year, an average of 37.1 to 14.0 per game.

• Purdue's bench has accounted for 45.1 percent of its scoring (371-of-822 points).

• Over the last four games, Purdue's bench has scored 166 of the team's 317 points, or 52.4 percent of the team's scoring.

• In the win over Howard, Purdue's bench played 102 minutes, scored 46 points and had just one turnover among them.

• When you have a preseason All-Big Ten selection coming off the bench (**A.J. Hammons**), you know you have some depth.

• **A.J. Hammons** had a monster game off the bench with 24 points and 12 rebounds in last Tuesday's win over Pittsburgh, then followed it up with a 16-point, 11-rebound showing against New Mexico for his second straight double-double.

• For his efforts, he was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 20.0 points and 11.5 rebounds per game in the two victories. He shot 17-of-25 (.680) from the field.

• In the second half of the last four games against Pittsburgh, New Mexico, IUPUI and Howard, Hammons has scored 44 points with 21 rebounds and six blocks in just 48 minutes of action, while shooting 18-of-23 (.783) from the field.

• Hammons' double-doubles have come against an impressive list of teams, 13 of which have come against Big Ten opposition and 16 against power-conference schools.

• Purdue has already recorded eight double-doubles (Swanigan - 4; Haas - 2; Hammons - 2) in the season's first 10 games by three different players.

• Last year, Purdue had nine double-doubles all season (Hammons - 6; Davis - 3). The year before, Purdue had nine double-doubles by four different players (Hammons - 6; Davis - 1; Scott - 1; Smotherman - 1).

### ■ Haas on Fire

• **Isaac Haas** has turned into an unstoppable force on the offensive end, leading the Boilermakers in scoring (13.6) while shooting 63.9 percent from the field.

• Per 40 minutes, Haas is averaging 30.4 points and 11.6 rebounds per game. In two of his last five games, he has scored more points than minutes played (24 points in 20 minutes vs. Lehigh; 21 points in 21 minutes vs. New Mexico).

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 144-31 (.823) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 80-7 (.920) record against non-conference opponents.
