THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Coming off its first setback in a month, the No. 11-ranked Purdue men's basketball team closes out a busy stretch by welcoming No. 21 Michigan to Mackey Arena for a Friday night showdown. It marks the second ranked opponent of the season to visit Mackey Arena and the second nationally-ranked opponent the Boilermakers will face in the last seven days (Oregon on Jan. 18).
- Friday is Purdue's annual Hammer Down Cancer game, with the team wearing special warmup shirts and jerseys that will be auctioned off. Over the last three years, the game has raised almost \$200,000 in funds for the Purdue Institute for Cancer Research.
- Purdue will be playing its sixth game in 16 days when the Wolverines visit Mackey Arena, with games spanning both coasts (Rutgers on Jan. 9; Washington and Oregon on Jan. 15 and 18). The contest will be the midway point of the Big Ten season with five games having been played on the road (4-1) and five at home (3-1).
- Friday's game marks the 500th Big Ten Conference game played in Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers are 388-111 (.778) against Big Ten teams at Mackey Arena. **Matt Painter** has accounted for a 142-36 (.798) record against Big Ten teams in Mackey Arena.
- Purdue owns a 9-5 combined record in quad-one and quad-two games, while posting a 6-0 record in quads 3 and 4. Purdue's nine wins in the first two quadrants rank as the fifth most nationally behind Alabama, Auburn, Texas A&M and Memphis.
- Purdue's strength of schedule ranks third nationally (behind Alabama and Auburn), one year after ranking second nationally (behind Alabama).
- In the last four years, Purdue has defeated teams ranked No. 1 (Arizona), No. 2 (Alabama), No. 4 (Marquette), No. 5 (Villanova), No. 6 (Wisconsin, Tennessee, Gonzaga), No. 7 (Tennessee), No. 8 (Duke), No. 9 (Illinois), No. 12 (Illinois), No. 13 (Oregon, Illinois), No. 16 (Ohio State), No. 17 (Illinois), No. 18 (North Carolina, Gonzaga) and No. 20 (Utah State). Only three of the 18 wins listed above have come in Mackey Arena.
- Since the turn of the calendar to January, Purdue ranks No. 6 nationally in efficiency behind Houston, Duke, Auburn, Illinois and Iowa State via BartTorvik.com. The Boilermakers are 14th in offensive efficiency and 13th in defensive efficiency in that span. Through December 31, Purdue ranked 29th overall in efficiency while placing 15th in offensive efficiency and 77th in defensive efficiency.
- Since the 2015-16 season (10 years), Purdue owns a 132-50 (.725) record in Big Ten regular-season play. The 72.5 winning percentage is the best by a Big Ten program over a 10-season span since Indiana went 132-48 (.733) from 1975 to 1984.
- Braden Smith** (5th) and **Trey Kaufman-Renn** (7th) are the only teammates nationally to rank in the top 10 for the KenPom National Player of the Year race. Since the 2016-17 season, Purdue has had eight players ranked in the KenPom top 10 (including this year).
- Braden Smith** is the only player in America with 275 points, 150 assists and 75 rebounds. Smith is on pace to become the first player since Loyola Marymount's **Terrell Lowery** (1990-91) to average 15.0 points, 9.0 assists, 4.0 rebounds and shoot over 40.0 percent from 3-point range.
- Braden Smith** leads the Big Ten in both assists (8.9) and steals per game (2.3). **Mike Conley Jr.** (OSU; 2007) is the only Big Ten player to do that.
- The backcourt tandem of **Fletcher Loyer** and **Braden Smith** have started all 94 games together (100th game will come against Wisconsin on Feb. 15), posting a record of 78-16 as starters. The duo has combined to score 2,168 career points with 813 assists and 651 rebounds. They have combined for 301 made 3-pointers.
- Braden Smith** needs just 34 rebounds to become the second player ever with 1,000 points, 600 assists and 500 rebounds in his first three years.
- Trey Kaufman-Renn** is the only player nationally to average 18.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and shoot at least 58 percent from the field. In Big Ten history, only **Chris Webber**, **Evan Eschmeyer**, and **Tracey Jackson-Davis** have done that.

►►► A CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOX SCORE

- Looking at the box score of the Ohio State setback, only one stat determined the outcome of the game – 3-point shooting.
- Ohio State made 11-of-23 (.476) from long range, including 8-of-12 in the second half to rally for the win. Purdue went just 3-of-9 from deep.
- Purdue won the points off turnovers category by a 30-6 margin. The last time Purdue was plus-15 in points off turnovers and lost came on March 25, 2013, against Santa Clara (25-9 advantage).
- Purdue won the battle in the paint by a 32-16 advantage.
- Purdue won the second-chance points category by a 7-4 margin, meaning Purdue held a 37-10 advantage in "extra" opportunities.
- Purdue forced 18 turnovers, losing for the second straight game when forcing 18 or more turnovers (Texas A&M). Prior to that, Purdue had not lost when forcing 18 or more turnovers since the before-mentioned Santa Clara game (March 25, 2013).
- Purdue was minus-8 (10-18) in turnover margin against the Buckeyes, losing for the first time when being at least minus-6 since Jan. 21, 2020, against Illinois (6-14).

►►► TEAM NOTES

- Purdue fell to Ohio State on Tuesday night, 73-70, in Mackey Arena, snapping a seven-game winning streak, which had been the nation's 10th-longest winning streak.
- The loss snapped a 26-game home winning streak, which had been the nation's third-longest homecourt winning streak and tied for the second longest in Mackey Arena history.
- The loss snapped a 14-game home winning streak against Big Ten opponents, the third longest in program history.
- Purdue saw a 12-game winning streak in the month of January end against the Buckyes. It had been the second-longest winning streak nationally in the month of January.
- Purdue lost for the first time since Feb. 16, 2023 vs. Maryland when having fewer turnovers than its opponent – a span of 23 games.
- Purdue saw a 36-game winning streak end when leading at halftime in the loss to Ohio State. Purdue last lost a halftime lead on Dec. 1, 2023, against Northwestern (lost 92-88 in overtime).
- Ohio State became the first team in the last eight games to reach 70 points (last: Auburn; Dec. 21, 2024).

- Trey Kaufman-Renn** was named the Naismith Trophy National Player of the Week and Big Ten Player of the Week for his role in two Purdue wins over Washington and Oregon.
- Kaufman-Renn has scored in double-figures in all 20 games, while averaging 19.3 points, 8.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists in six games against ranked teams (44-of-84 FGs).
- Braden Smith** has been named a mid-season All-American by multiple outlets, ranking third nationally in assists (8.9) and 23rd nationally in steals (2.3). He is attempting to become the first Big Ten player to lead the league in assists and steals since Ohio State's **Mike Conley Jr.**, in 2006-07.
- Purdue's leader in blocked shots is **Caleb Furst** with seven. Purdue hasn't blocked a shot in either of the last two games. Freshman **Daniel Jacobsen**, considered Purdue's best rim protector, who is out for the year with a fractured tibia suffered in first minute of the second game, is just four blocks off the team lead (3).
- Braden Smith** has led the team in assists in all 20 games played this season. He has led the team in assists in 80 of his 94 career games.
- Braden Smith needs 23 assists to become the seventh player in Big Ten history with two seasons of 200 or more assists (**Zavier Simpson**, **Cassius Winston**, **Demetri McCamey**, **Mateen Cleaves**, **Eric Snow**, **Magic Johnson**).
- C.J. Cox** and **Gicarri Harris** are a combined 17-of-41 (.415) from 3-point range in Big Ten play. They are a combined 14-of-30 (.467) since the calendar flipped to 2025.
- Purdue is the only team in the Big Ten, and one of five teams nationally, to have three players score 275 points this season.
- Purdue's freshman through junior classes have scored a combined 1,441 points, accounting for 93.8 percent of Purdue's scoring. Purdue is set to return all but one player next season (**Caleb Furst**).

On Dec. 28 before the Toledo game, Purdue ranked 73rd nationally in defensive efficiency and 27th overall via KenPom. Prior to the Michigan game, Purdue has risen to 26th in defensive efficiency and 10th overall.

Purdue will be playing its sixth game in the last 16 days, starting with a trip to the Atlantic Ocean to face Rutgers and ending Friday against Michigan. Purdue also traveled to the Pacific Northwest to face Washington and Oregon last week. The Boilermakers traveled almost 6,500 miles during this stretch.

Purdue will be playing its 500th game in Mackey Arena against Big Ten Conference opponents on Friday night. The Boilermakers are 388-111 (.778) against Big Ten foes in Mackey Arena.

With 66 league wins over the last five years (including this season), Purdue needs just five more wins to tie the league record for most wins in a five-year span (71 by Indiana; 1974-78).

Since the 2021-22 season, Purdue is 55-6 when forcing 10 or more turnovers in a game. When Purdue has single-digit turnovers, Purdue owns a 38-2 record in that span. Purdue has won 40 straight games when forcing between 10 and 15 turnovers in a game.

Coincidentally, Purdue is 10-2 this year when forcing 15 or fewer turnovers in a game this year. When forcing 16 or more turnovers, Purdue is just 5-3 this season.

Purdue ranks ninth nationally in assist rate (A / FGM) at 63.5 percent. Utah leads the country at 69.8 percent.

When Purdue holds opponents to 69 or fewer points, the Boilermakers are 10-0. When foes score 70 or more points, Purdue is just 5-5.

A win over Michigan will give Purdue an 8-2 start in Big Ten play for the sixth time under **Matt Painter** (2008, 2018, 2019, 2023, 2024). In years that Purdue has started 8-2 or better, the Boilermakers have won league titles over the last three occurrences (2019, 2023, 2024).

Purdue has won 64 straight games when shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 70.0 percent from the free throw line, last losing to on March 3, 2004.

Painter preaches extra possessions and the results show that. Purdue is 6-0 this year when winning both the rebound and turnover battles, having won 27 straight games (Rutgers; Dec. 9, 2021).

Purdue is 160-15 under Painter when winning both the rebound and turnover battles. On the flipside, Purdue is 6-51 when losing both the rebound and turnover battles.

Over the last three games, Purdue is just 8-of-34 (.235) from 3-point range, while opponents are 27-of-74 (.365). Purdue has made four or fewer 3-pointers in four of the last five games. The one game it made more than four 3-pointers, Purdue made 19 against Nebraska.

Purdue attempted just nine 3-pointers against Ohio State.

Purdue has gone 13,577 days since losing when scoring 90 or more points, having won 124 straight games (62-0 under **Matt Painter**). Purdue's last loss when scoring 90 or more points was on Nov. 26, 1987 to Iowa State (L, 104-96).

Purdue is 187-13 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 101-3 since the start of the 2017-18 season.

Purdue is 74-6 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10, 3-pointers in a game.

Michigan will be Purdue's seventh ranked opponent of the season, and 18th-ranked opponent since the start of last season (13-4 record), the second-most nationally (Alabama - 19). The 13 victories are tied with Connecticut for the most nationally.

• With 16 NCAA Tournament berths, seven Sweet 16 appearances, five Big Ten regular-season championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, two Elite Eight appearances, a trip to the Final Four, an appearance in a National Championship game and an international gold medal on his résumé, 20th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter was named the 2019 and 2024 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to nine straight NCAA Tournaments – the fourth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in five of the last seven tournaments.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.

• Painter will enter the 2024-25 season second on the school's all-time wins list (447) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward “Piggy” Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

• Has averaged over 23 wins a season in his 19 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.3 wins per year over the last 18 seasons.

• Has won at least 25 games in 12 of his 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

• Painter has averaged 11.9 wins per year in conference play, the third-best average in Big Ten Conference history.

• He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.

• Coach Painter's 16 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2024 – Painter is 53 years old).

• Purdue has finished first, second or third in Big Ten play in 11 of the last 17 years, including in eight of the last 10 years.
