### The Scene Setter

- No. 5-ranked Purdue looks to cap off a successful week on the road as it travels to "The Barn" for an important league contest against Minnesota on Saturday at noon.
- The game will be televised by ESPN with **Jason Benetti** and **Dan Dakich** on the call. **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will handle the radio broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network. Fans can receive in-game updates on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking to match its best 19-game start in school history (1987-88) and for a 6-0 Big Ten start for just the fourth time ever.
- Purdue is 4-5 at Williams Arena during the **Matt Painter** era, but won 68-64 in its last trip to the facility (Jan. 27, 2016).
- It marks the fifth time in Painter's nine visits to "The Barn" that Purdue has been ranked, boasting a 3-1 record in previous games.
- Purdue returns home Tuesday, Jan. 16, for a 7 p.m. ET, tip against Wisconsin. It will be Purdue's first home game with students since Dec. 10.

### LOOKING BACK

- Purdue improved to 16-2 with a 70-69 win over Michigan on Tuesday. It was Purdue's first win in the Crisler Center since Feb. 25, 2012. Purdue's highly-regarded Senior class has now won in all Big Ten arenas but two (Carver-Hawkeye Arena and the State Farm Center).
- Purdue is now 5-2 away from Mackey Arena. All five of its wins (Marquette, Arizona, Maryland, Butler, Michigan) came against teams that made the 2017 NCAA Tournament.
- Purdue held its ninth straight opponent under 70 points. Purdue is 13-0 this year when holding foes under 70 points.
- Purdue has now won seven straight Big Ten regular-season games dating to last year.
- **Carsen Edwards** led Purdue with 19 points. In two career games at the Crisler Center, Edwards is 14-of-28 from the field and 8-of-12 from 3-point range for 37 points in 54 minutes.
- **Isaac Haas** scored 17 points, surpassing 1,300 career points in the process.

- Following Tuesday's win at Michigan, Purdue is now 5-0 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 1989-90 season.
- A win over Minnesota would give Purdue its fourth 6-0 Big Ten start in school history (1989-90, 1987-88, 1968-69). The three previous teams to reach 6-0 combined for a 42-8 Big Ten record and two Big Ten titles.

- Purdue has jumped eight spots in the AP Top 25 poll to No. 5. It's Purdue's highest ranking since being ranked No. 3 on Feb. 22, 2010.
- Purdue's eight-position jump is the second-largest jump in school history behind an 11-spot jump (24 to 13) during the 1989-90 season.
- Purdue has been ranked in the top five for 34 weeks in poll history.

### ► The Nation's Top-Ranked Team

- Through Wednesday's games, Purdue is ranked No. 2 in at least one respected computer poll -- the Sagarin ratings. The top five is Villanova, Purdue, Michigan State, Kansas and Virginia.
- According to Sagarin, Purdue's six top-50 wins are the most nationally.

► **Doing it on Both Ends**

- Purdue has won 12 straight games, including five games against KenPom top-40 teams, using a winning recipe during that span.
- During the streak, Purdue has held foes to 61.6 points per game and has allowed just one foe to score 70 points (Maryland - 75). Opponents are shooting just 38.2 percent from the field.
- Meanwhile on the offensive end, Purdue is averaging 81.5 points per game and shooting 49.5 percent from the field and 40.9 percent from 3-point range in that span.

► **Making Our Statement**

- With Purdue's win over Butler in the Crossroads Classic, the Boilermakers have won six straight games against in-state foes and haven't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (691 days).
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has defeated six different in-state teams (Butler, IUPUI, Fort Wayne, Notre Dame, Indiana, Valparaiso) and is 11-3 against in-state teams.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is 21-4 against teams from the state of Indiana and bordering states, including 8-1 this year.
- Just one Indiana school, Evansville (one game; last game in 2005), now holds a winning streak against the Boilermakers.

► **Shooting Wins**

- Purdue has shot at least 44.3 percent from the field in each of the last 10 games, shooting over 50.0 percent from the field in five of the games.
- Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in five of the games during Purdue's 12-game winning streak.

► **Big Wins**

- Since the start of last year, Purdue has won 21 games by 20 or more points, the second-highest total nationally.

- The Boilermakers were 17-1 in 2016-17 at home, recording the most home wins in a season in school history.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
