#### - AROUND THE HORN -

• Purdue has numerous ups and downs this season. The Boilermakers opened the year 8-1 then lost 9 of 10 from March 4-23. A six-game win streak followed but then Purdue lost five straight before winning Tuesday at Indiana State.

• The Boilermakers started Big Ten play 4-0 for the first time since 1985, but are now 4-4. Their next two weekend series against Maryland (3-5 B1G) and Rutgers (4-5) could prove to be very crucial in the Big Ten Tournament chase. All three teams plus Michigan State (3-5) have already had their open weekends in the league schedule and are likely going to be battling for the final two berths in the conference tournament.

• While Purdue will have played three of its first four Big Ten weekends on the road, Maryland has had the opposite schedule. The Terps played their first two Big Ten series at home and three of their first four. Around the conference, only Indiana (19) has played more home games than UMD (18). Purdue's seven home dates remain the fewest in the league. But a season-long nine-game homestand at Alexander Field opens Tuesday.

• Tuesday at Indiana State, the Boilermakers won a true road game in extra innings for the first time since April 2014 at Michigan State. Purdue's April 6 win at No. 10 Indiana was its first vs. top-10 team since March 2006 at No. 2/3 North Carolina.

## **BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- Feb. 20, 2017
- March 6, 2017

- Joined all-time strikeouts leader Matt Bischoff (2008-10) as the only Purdue pitchers this century to start three straight season openers.
- Lost a 1-0 pitchers duel at Tulane to open the spring break trip, keeping the home team off the scoreboard until a two-out single in the eighth inning.
- Went on to lose 3 consecutive starts for the first time since 2016, giving up 3 home runs at Saint Louis after a dropped fly ball extended the second inning; struggled with his command early in the home opener vs. Lipscomb, giving up to 2 first-inning runs.
- Has worked a combined 13 2/3 innings of one-run ball in the last two season-opening wins, surrendering just seven hits while registering 18 strikeouts vs. one walk.
- Helped lead Purdue to a 10-5 record on Fridays as a junior.
- Recorded seven official quality starts in 2017, including three of his last four outings after a tough stretch in April; had four outings in which he did not allow a run.
- Struck out a career-high 10 over 7 2/3 shutout innings at Santa Clara in 2017, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since March 2012.
- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SEMO.
- Struck out nine over seven innings while retiring 21 of 24 batters faced at Texas State while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- In 2017, became Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends; Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA and .168 batting average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings pitched.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

## **BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- April 24, 2017

- Has struggled with his command at times in 2018 due in part to a cracked finger nail on the index finger of his pitching hand; Purdue has still won 6 of his 9 starts.
- Almost didn't get out of the first inning at PSU, but went on to put together a quality start.
- Third Team All-Big Ten in 2017, Purdue's first all-conference pitcher since 2012.
- Limited Minnesota to 6 singles over 7 innings in the win that clinched Purdue's 2017 Big Ten Tournament berth.
- Was Purdue's top pitcher after start of Big Ten play last year, working a team-high 63 innings with a 2.43 ERA and .224 average against from March 25 to May 19.
- Threw a complete game 2-hitter vs. Illinois in 2017, retiring 27 of 29 batters faced to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Delivered a much-needed quality start in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working 7 2/3 innings of one-run ball.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball; played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- Became Purdue's first freshman to make a start during the conference-opening weekend since Mike Kornacker in March 2015.
- The only hit he allowed in 5 innings at Penn State came on a wind-aided fly ball in the fifth inning that dropped in front of the center fielder.
- Made his first collegiate start at Southeastern Louisiana on the spring break trip and moved into the rotation that weekend for the Saint Louis series; was scheduled to start the series finale vs. Lipscomb but it was canceled.
- Continues to be stretched out after starting the year in the bullpen, but walks and wild pitches have been an issue at times.
- Pitched in relief in the season-opening win vs. Western Michigan.
- Two-time first team all-state as an upperclassman at Crawfordsville High School.
- Recorded 127 strikeouts as a junior and 124 Ks as a senior while helping lead CHS to consecutive conference titles.
- Also a four-year letterwinner in football and basketball.
- First team all-conference in all three sports as a senior as well as in football and baseball as a junior.
- High honor roll student and National Honor Society.

## HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks in 2017 and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 120 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 29 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

## LEARNARD EVEN BETTER THIS YEAR?

• **Ross Learnard** has been charged with a run in just four of his 40 career appearances as a Boilermaker. After earning second team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association in 2017 for posting a program-record 0.58 ERA over 46 1/3 innings, he has excelled again this season despite a higher profile role as the team's closer. The only runs he has given up this season came on a two-run homer Feb. 24 vs. Notre Dame. Additionally, he's allowed only one of nine inherited runners to score in 2018.

• Dating back to the March 28 win vs. Valparaiso, Learnard has recorded 10 of his 12 outs via strikeouts in the final inning of the last four Purdue victories he has closed out. He has two wins and two saves during that stretch.

• Learnard has a 0.70 ERA in 64 career innings. He needs to pitch 11 more innings to be eligible for Purdue's career ERA leaderboard (minimum 75 innings). He eclipsed Steve Krull's minimum 30 innings ERA record (0.60) last year that had stood since 1965. Krull (1.46) also owns the program's all-time ERA records for 75 and 125 innings.

• Learnard has pitched 15 consecutive scoreless innings since giving up the home run on Feb. 24. A year ago he had a streak of 35 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings from March 11 through May 14.

• **2017 Streak:** 21 hits (4 XBH), 8 BB, 28 K, allowed 5 of 23 inherited runners to score

• **2018 Streak:** 7 hits (2 XBH), 2 BB, 15 K, allowed 1 of 8 inherited runners to score

## McGOWAN TAKING HIS WALKS

• Since hitting a two-run homer, his ninth of the year, in the April 6 series-opening win at No. 10 Indiana, **Jacson McGowan** has been walked 10 times in 34 plate appearances. The opposition's reluctance to pitch to Purdue's top power hitter has helped limited him to one extra-base hit and six RBI in the last seven games. However, he has a .441 on-base percentage despite being just 5-for-22 overall (.227).

• This week against Indiana State, McGowan still accounted for two of Purdue's three RBI despite being walked five times. Both RBI came with the bases loaded. He delivered an infield single in the first inning Tuesday in Terre Haute and drew a two-out walk in the eighth inning Wednesday at Alexander Field. Purdue is 15-6 when he has an RBI this season and 1-10 when he does not.

• McGowan leads the Boilermakers with a .427 on-base percentage and has now walked (24) more than he has struck out (23).

## NISLE HOMERS TWICE IN OPENER WITH MINNESOTA

• **Ben Nisle** homered twice in the April 13 series opener with Minnesota, posting the first multi-homer game by a Boilermaker in over two years (March 2016). It was only the third multi-homer game by a Purdue player at Alexander Field. He joined **Alec Olund** as the team's only freshmen to post multi-homer games in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present) and became the first freshman since 2010 to go deep twice in a Big Ten game.

## TEAM ERA ON THE RISE DURING APRIL SKID

• Purdue was outscored 63-21 during its five-game losing streak from April 7-14, surrendering at least 14 runs in three of the five defeats. The 40 runs Minnesota scored at Alexander Field this past weekend were the most the Boilermakers had conceded in consecutive games since giving up 41 to Ball State (lost 23-7) and Indiana (lost 18-4) in April 1999. The pitching staff responded by surrendering only three runs in the midweek series split with Indiana State.

• Purdue entered the Indiana series (April 6-8) ranked second in the Big Ten with a 3.50 team ERA. It dropped to 3.44 after the Boilermakers won the series opener in Bloomington 4-2. But with 56 of the 63 runs allowed during the five-game skid being earned, the team ERA jumped rapidly to 4.73 and Purdue dropped to ninth in the Big Ten.

• The team's batting average against jumped from .244 the morning of April 7 to .266 at the end of the five-game losing streak. Even more surprisingly, the Boilermakers surrendered 11 home runs during the skid, which coincidentally equaled the combined number of doubles and triples they conceded, after giving up only 11 homers over the first 25 games.

• Minnesota had a ridiculous .429 batting average on balls in play in the two games this past weekend at Alexander Field. The mean for BABIP is traditionally .300.

## UNABLE TO EXTEND HOT STARTS

- Purdue started the season 5-0 for the first time since 1991. The Boilermakers' 8-1 mark through nine games matched the 2012 team for the program's best one-loss start in the modern era of college baseball. But Purdue dropped nine of its next 10 games to fall to 9-10 after game 1 of the March 23 home-opening doubleheader.
- The Boilermakers swept a series at Penn State to begin Big Ten play and then won their series opener at Indiana to move to 4-0 in the conference. The 1985 season marked the last time Purdue swept a conference-opening series and was 4-0 in Big Ten play. But now the Boilermakers are looking to end a four-game skid in conference play.

## McGOWAN FINDS HIS GROOVE AGAIN

- **Jacson McGowan** was mired in a 3-for-28 slump when he delivered a two-out RBI single in the sixth inning of the March 18 series finale at Saint Louis. That came on the heels of a red-hot start in which he batted .472 (17-for-36) with six homers and 17 RBI over the first nine games. Not surprisingly, Purdue went 8-1 in the first nine games and 1-8 from March 4 to 18. But McGowan found his way out of the slump. That two-out single at Saint Louis helped ignite a 13-for-36 (.361) stretch, during which he recorded three home runs, seven walks and 16 RBI.
- The Boilermakers are 9-0 when McGowan has homered this season. The Feb. 23 win vs. Saint Louis in San Antonio is the only game Purdue has won this year when he didn't record an RBI.
- McGowan had an RBI in all six games of Purdue's recent win streak (March 23-April 6). It was the program's longest RBI streak since **Nick Dalesandro** posted a similar six-game RBI run in March 2017.
- McGowan is already the first Boilermaker since Cameron Perkins in 2011 with at least three four-RBI games in a season.
- Dalesandro (No. 12 catcher) and McGowan (No. 24 first baseman) were both ranked among the top 25 in D1Baseball.com's updated national position rankings through the first six weeks of the season (released March 28). Dalesandro is the Big Ten's top-ranked catcher and McGowan is the No. 2 first baseman in the conference. Dalesandro is also on the Johnny Bench Award watch list again.

## SHIPLEY SHINES IN LEADOFF SPOT

- **Harry Shipley** has reached base safely a team-high 33 times over the last 16 games (22-for-62, .355 Avg, .452 OBP). He was on base safely at least twice in 13 times in a stretch of 14 games during that hot stretch, including a streak of eight straight games (March 31-April 14). It was also an eight-game hit streak for Shipley. He enters the Maryland series riding a 10-game reached base safely streak.
- **Skyler Hunter** is the only other Boilermaker to reach base safely twice in at least five consecutive games this year (Feb. 24-March 4). Shipley has done it twice.
- Shipley has now been plunked 68 times in his career, extending the all-time program record he established last year.
- Purdue is 15-11 with Shipley batting in the top two spots in the lineup. He has reached base safely 58 percent (23 of 40) of the time when leading off any inning. That's easily the best percentage for any Boilermaker.
- Shipley has played in 99 consecutive games and 195 of 196 since the start of 2015. Among active players, only **Nick Dalesandro** has played in more consecutive games (142) than Shipley. **Jacson McGowan** has played in 89 straight.

## HUNTER RECORDS 30 HITS IN 20 GAMES

- **Skyler Hunter** joined Kyle Johnson (2016), Kevin Plawecki (2012, 2011), Eric Charles (2012), Cameron Perkins (2012), Barrett Serrato (2012) and Tyler Spillner (2010) as Boilermakers in the last decade to record 30 hits in the team's first 20 games. He had multiple hits in 10 of those 20 games while hitting safely in 18 of the 20.
- Hunter led Purdue in hits (65) and batting average (.325) as a freshman last season, becoming the first Boilermaker since Plawecki in 2010 to accomplish the feat.

## EXCELLENT WEEK FOR PURDUE PITCHING

- The Boilermakers surrendered only six runs (five earned) on 21 hits over 36 innings the final week of March. The pitchers recorded 15 more strikeouts (35) than hits allowed. For the week, opposing hitters were just 6-for-43 (.140) with runners on base and 3-for-26 (.115) with runners in scoring position. Purdue pitchers allowed the first batter of an inning to reach safely in only six of the 36 innings. The defense backed up the staff, committing just two errors in 134 defensive chances – good for a .985 fielding percentage.
- The five runs allowed at Penn State were the fewest surrendered in a three-game weekend series since last year's sweep of Illinois (four) at Alexander Field. A sweep at Northwestern in April 2012 marked the last time Purdue limited the home team to five runs or fewer in a Big Ten road series.
- **Ryan Beard** set the tone with six hitless innings in the Valparaiso win. The first hit he surrendered came with two outs in the seventh inning and was recorded by the 24th batter Beard faced.
- **Trent Johnson** followed Beard's lead and did not give up a hit until his final inning. In game three of the series, the freshman retired the first seven Penn State batters in order and did not surrender a hit until a wind-aided fly ball dropped in center field in the bottom of the fifth. That ball was hit by the 18th batter Johnson faced.
- In the series opener, **Tanner Andrews** surrendered a single to the PSU leadoff man, but did not give up another hit to the next 13 batters he faced. Three of the six hits he allowed came in the seventh inning. **Gareth Stroh** also gave up a game-opening single in the following game. He did not give up another hit to the next 12 batters he faced on his way to a quality start.
- The Boilermakers retired 18 consecutive Penn State hitters from the sixth inning of game one through the third inning of game two of the doubleheader. **Dalton Parker** and Johnson each worked a pair of 1-2-3 innings during that stretch. Twenty-eight consecutive PSU batters came to the plate without recording a hit from the sixth inning of game one through the fifth inning of game two.
