• The No. 15-ranked Purdue men's basketball team looks to keep rolling on Monday as Western Illinois visits Mackey Arena for a 6 p.m. tipoff ... the game will be televised on BTN with **Wayne Randazzo** and **Shon Morris** on the call ... on the radio dial, the game will be available on the Purdue Sports Network and [Tuneln.com](http://Tuneln.com) as **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** provide brilliant commentary, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip ... live stats will be available at [StatBroadcast.com](http://StatBroadcast.com).

### #BOILERNOTES

- Purdue is ranked No. 15 in the Associated Press top-25 poll, up three spots from last week ... the Boilermakers have been ranked in the AP Top 25 in each of the last 25 polls, the seventh-longest active streak nationally ... Purdue is ranked 16th in the coaches poll, also up three from last week.
- Purdue is looking for its sixth start of 10-2 or better through 12 games in the 12th year of the **Matt Painter** era ... the Boilermakers started 10-2 or better in 2006-07 (10-2), 2008-09 (10-2), 2009-10 (12-0), 2010-11 (11-1) and 2015-16 (11-1).
- Purdue's two losses have come by teams ranked second (Villanova) and seventh (Louisville on the road) in the latest [KenPom.com](http://KenPom.com) rankings.
- With its victory over Notre Dame in the Crossroads Classic, Purdue won its first game against a non-conference, ranked opponent since a win over No. 24-ranked Saint Mary's in the 2012 NCAA Tournament.
- For just the sixth time since 1965 (1964-65, 1973-74, 1982-83, 1997-98, 2014-15, 2016-17), Purdue has had at least two comeback victories of 13 points or more ... it's the first time since the 1982-83 season that Purdue has had two 13-point, second-half rallies.
- Purdue is averaging 87.5 points per game over the last four games, shooting 52.2 percent from the field with an assist/turnover ratio of 1.88 (90/48).
- Purdue ranks third nationally in assists at 20.1 assists per game and has had 90 assists over its last four games (22.5 APG).
- Purdue has recorded assists on 68.6 percent of its made field goals, ranking fifth nationally in assist rate (A / FGM).
- Purdue has five players averaging in double figures and two more that average at least 7.7 points per game ... already twice this year, Purdue has had six players reach double figures in a game (Auburn, Arizona State).
- Purdue has three players averaging at least 10.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game (Swanigan, Mathias, V. Edwards) ... in Purdue history before this year, just five players have done that in school history.
- Purdue has outrebounded its last three opponents by 12.0 rebounds per game (Arizona State, Cleveland State, Notre Dame).

## LAST TIME OUT

### ► [15] Purdue 86, [21] Notre Dame 81

December 17, 2016 / Indianapolis, Ind. / Bankers Life Fieldhouse (18,684)

- Purdue won its first game in the Crossroads Classic, now owning a 1-5 record ... it was Purdue's first win over Notre Dame since the 1965-66 season ... Purdue is now on a four-game winning streak.
- Purdue's 17-point comeback was its largest rally since an 18-point rally against St. John's on Nov. 27, 1998 ... it was the sixth-largest rally in school history ... it was also the largest rally over a ranked team.
- Purdue's win snapped a six-game losing streak to non-conference ranked foes, dating to an NCAA Tournament win over 24th-ranked Saint Mary's in the 2012 NCAA Tournament.
- Notre Dame scored 1.41 points per possession in the first half, but just 0.78 in the second half after halftime adjustments ... Purdue scored 1.02 in the first half and 1.30 in the second half.
- Purdue tied a season low with just nine turnovers, having one fewer than Notre Dame, which led the country in turnovers per game (8.2) ... Purdue had 15 points off Notre Dame's 10 turnovers.
- Purdue also outrebounded the Irish 40-30, the third straight game that Purdue has had a double-digit rebounding advantage.
- Purdue shot 19-of-23 from the free throw line, compared to Notre Dame's 7-of-8.
- Purdue's bench outscored Notre Dame's 29-14.
- Dakota Mathias held Notre Dame's leading scorer, Steve Vasturia, to three points on 1-of-8 shooting ... he entered the game averaging 16.6 per game.
- Purdue entered the game 21st in the country in fewest fouls per game (15.8) ... the Boilermakers had just 13.
- **Caleb Swanigan** recorded his eighth double-double of the season with 26 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high four blocks ... his 26 points was one shy of a career high (last year vs. Wisconsin) ... it marked his 16th career double-double ... Purdue is 14-2 when he records a double-double ... he surpassed 400 career rebounds in the win, coming in his 45th career game ... he is also now 9-of-14 from 3-point range after going 1-of-2 today.
- **Vincent Edwards** tallied his third career double-double with a season-high 20 points, 10 rebounds and two assists ... Edwards surpassed 800 career points and 400 career rebounds in the victory.
- **Carsen Edwards** recorded his sixth double-figure game of the season with 11 points, three rebounds, three assists and two steals.
- **P.J. Thompson** has now made a 3-pointer in 13 straight games after going 2-of-4 today ... Thompson had six assists against zero turnovers ... over the last five games, Thompson has 22 assists against two turnovers.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Purdue is 5-0 against Western Illinois, winning by an average of 23.6 points per game.
- The last meeting came in the 2013 CBI Tournament, an 81-67 Purdue win ... in that game, Purdue shot 58.5 percent from the field, 63.6 percent from the 3-point line and 92.3 percent from the field, the only time since the 2010-11 season that Purdue has shot 50-60-90 from all three levels ... **A.J. Hammons** scored 15 points with four rebounds in the 2013 win over the Leathernecks.
- This marks just the third meeting between the two schools in the last 75 years.
- Purdue is 15-0 all-time against the Summit League, including 9-0 under Coach Painter.

### BOILERMAKER RECORDS

- Purdue is 277-37 (.882) all-time against non-conference foes in Mackey Arena, including a 272-29 (.904) record vs. unranked, non-conference foes.
- Painter is 87-8 (.916) at Mackey Arena against non-conference foes.
- Purdue is 28-2 in its last 30 games at Mackey Arena with losses to Maryland (Jan. 2015) and Iowa (Jan. 2016).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 35-11 (.761) in all games played, including 21-4 (.840) vs. non-conference foes.
- Purdue needs to win 15 more games this year to have 50 wins in back-to-back seasons for just the eighth time in school history.

### MOST CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN AP RANKINGS

- Purdue has been ranked in 25 consecutive polls, now the seventh-longest active streak in America ... Purdue was 1-of-11 teams nationally to be ranked in all 19 Associated Press polls a year ago.
- The school record for most consecutive weeks ranked is 64 from the 13th poll of the 2007-08 season to the final poll of the 2010-11 campaign.

## THE COMEBACK CREW

- Purdue has recorded a pair of comebacks of 13 points or more already this year, rallying from 13 points down in the second half against Georgia State and rallying from 17 down to beat Notre Dame on Saturday.
- The 17-point comeback was the largest since rallying from 18 points down against St. John's on Nov. 27, 1998 ... it was also the largest rally against a ranked opponent.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 11-9 when trailing at halftime.
- Under Painter, Purdue has had 10 comebacks of 13 points or more.
- Since the 1964-65 season, there have been six seasons that have had two comebacks of 13 points or more -- this year being one of them.

## BENCH PRODUCTION

- Over the last seven games, Purdue's bench is averaging 29.0 points and shooting 45.8 percent from 3-point range (33-of-72) ... in the first four games, the group averaged 15.5 points per game, while shooting 37.5 percent from the field and 19.2 percent from long distance.
- Purdue's bench has scored at least 23 points in each of the last seven games, after doing so once in the first four (30 vs. McNeese State).

## SIZZLING FROM DEEP

- The story of Purdue's offensive resurgence lately has been the Boilermakers' success from beyond the 3-point line. Through Saturday's games, here is where Purdue ranks nationally and in the Big Ten in the major 3-point categories.

- Over the last seven games, Purdue is shooting 93-of-196 (.474) from 3-point range ... prior to the Cancun Challenge (just three games), Purdue was shooting 32.8 percent from long distance.
- Purdue has made a 3-pointer in 975-of-981 games since the 3-point line was introduced before the 1986-87 season, including 123 straight.
- Purdue has made at least two 3-pointers in 950-of-981 games, including 111 straight games.
- Based on a 32-game season, Purdue is on pace for 334 3-pointers ... the current school record is 284 (2011-12 season).
- Over the last eight games, Purdue has posted three of the top six single-game 3-pointers made totals in school history.

Purdue is outscoring opponents by an average of 5.9 points per game from the free throw line ... the last time that Purdue made more free throws than opponents have shot for an entire season came in the 1997-98 campaign (made 657; opponents shot 572).

### THE LEGEND OF BIGGIE

- **Caleb Swanigan** is off to a strong start to his sophomore season and may have been the player of the month of November nationally.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.	
• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
