– AROUND THE HORN –

• The Boilermakers make their first-ever visit to the state of Maryland this weekend. It's their first true East Coast trip since playing in East Carolina's Keith LeClair Classic, where they played UMD for the first time, in Greenville, N.C., in February 2012.
• Purdue finished its season-long six-game homestand with a 2-4 record, posting back-to-back wins for the first time this season in the process. The victory vs. Michigan State in the series finale snapped a program-long 16-game losing streak.
• The Boilermakers scored eight unanswered runs in their 9-2 win vs. Ball State Tuesday, but gave up 22 unanswered runs in the 22-4 loss to Indiana State on Wednesday. The Sycamores scored 12 times in the eighth inning after Purdue dropped a pair of two-out fly balls.
• Doug Schreiber was involved in his 1,200th game as a part of the program April 17 in the finale of the MSU series. He played in a program-record 226 games from 1983-86 and has been the head coach for 976 games (since 1999).
• Purdue dropped four straight games all in one-run fashion from April 8-12. a first for the program since since May 1956. Purdue lost in one-run fashion seven times during the 16-game skid and is 2-13 overall in games decided by two runs or fewer this year.

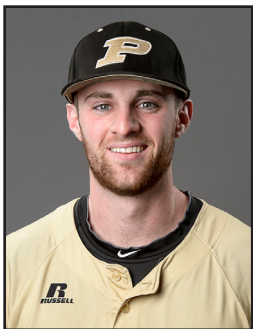

- Active career leader in games started and innings pitched; three-time Academic All-Big Ten and 2015 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honoree.
- Had a strong start at GSU during 2016 opening weekend but moved to bullpen after rough outings at Cal & ETSU; 4.03 ERA in 22 1/3 innings as a reliever.
- Joined the weekend rotation for the first time in March 2014 and has made 20 of his 30 career starts on weekends.
- Started the 2015 season opener at Western Carolina but did not make another weekend start until Maryland series; performed well in midweek starts vs. Louisville, IPFW & Indiana State.
- Led the way in Purdue's 2-1 pitcher's duel win in the middle game at Nebraska last year, inducing 13 ground ball outs over seven innings of one-run ball.
- Put together another strong start vs. NCAA Super Regional qualifier Maryland, taking a 3-1 lead into the ninth inning before the Terps loaded the bases against him & went on to win.
- Worked Purdue's first true complete game since February 2013 in tough-luck loss vs. Ohio State in April 2014, giving up runs in only one inning.
- No. 4 LSU did not score while he was on the mound in first start of 2014.
- True walk-on has been a part of the program since the fall of 2011, but red-shirted in 2012 after not making the official 35-man roster.
- Worked 4 1/3 innings of scoreless two-hit relief in his team debut, a 2013 midweek game vs. Indiana State.
- Helped Carroll High School win back-to-back 4A IHSAA state titles and was the winning pitcher in 2011 title game; all-conference & all-area honoree went 12-1 to tie the CHS wins record as a senior.

- Struck out a career-high seven over five innings of one-run ball last weekend at Indiana, leaving the game with Purdue up 5-1. Fanned 6 vs. Michigan State.
- Pitched at least seven innings of relief against ETSU and Ohio, helping Purdue win both games; closed out shutout win vs. North Dakota with four innings.
- Gave Purdue back-to-back quality starts against Top 25 teams (Illinois & Iowa) last year, but only received 2 runs of support combined.
- Did not give up a legit hit vs. NIU until the 6th inning last year after retiring 13 of the first 14 batters he faced; did not issue a walk over 6 innings.
- Shined vs Bakersfield in 2015, retiring 15 of 16 batters during one stretch en route to 7 shutout innings of 3-hit ball.
- Enjoyed a strong summer of 2014 in Midwest Collegiate League, where he was named an All-Star & pitched 8 innings of 3-hit ball in a playoff win that sent his DuPage County Hounds to league championship series.
- Took the mound in each of the first 6 weekends as a freshman.
- His father Mike played baseball at Illinois State.

- Led the team in innings pitched, strikeouts and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.84) in 2015, starting 4 Big Ten games and 4 midweek contests.
- Led Purdue to both of its shutout victories in 2015, midweek home wins vs. Valparaiso and Ball State.
- Shined at home in 2015, going 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA, .262 batting average against and 32 strikeouts in 33 innings over 6 starts at Alexander Field.

HEAD COACH DOUG SCHREIBER

Since Doug Schreiber was named Purdue's head baseball coach on May 29, 1998, the Boilermakers have become a major force in the Big Ten Conference and have made big strides on a national level.

Currently in his 18th season as the leader of the program, Schreiber is the program's all-time leader in overall wins and Big Ten wins. He eclipsed Dave Alexander's record for games coached (792 over 14 seasons) during the second weekend of the 2013 season. Schreiber played for Alexander at Purdue from 1983-86.

Purdue unveiled its new Alexander Field stadium and facilities during the 2012-13 school year, but the first two seasons at the new ballpark turned out to be rebuilding years for the Boilermakers after losing 15 seniors and three junior MLB draftees from the 2012 Big Ten championship team. As of July 2014, 10 members of the 2012 championship team had signed with MLB organizations at some point in their post-college careers.

In the five seasons between 2008 and 2012, Purdue went 172-110 overall (.610) and 75-51 in Big Ten play (.595). Both records represented the best marks in the league. The Boilermakers were the only conference team to qualify for the Big Ten Tournament each of those five seasons, the longest such streak in program history. Purdue has won at least one game at the Big Ten Tournament in nine of its 10 appearances under Schreiber.

The 2015 Boilermakers won their final five games and six of their last seven, posting their third longest season-ending win streak in program history. Kyle Wood won the team triple crown in 2015, becoming the first hitter to do so since 2007 and the 11th Boilermaker position player since 1970 to accomplish the feat.

After playing six NCAA Regional qualifiers throughout the season, including four opponents that were among the 16 Regional hosts, Purdue's strength of schedule in 2014 ranked among the Top 25 nationally for much of the year. The Boilermakers' eight extra-inning affairs were the most in Schreiber's tenure as well as the most in the Big Ten. Purdue also played in 17 one-run games, but managed just a 5-12 record in those contests.

During its historic 2012 season, Purdue won a program-record 45 games, captured a pair of Big Ten titles, earned the right to host an NCAA Regional and closed out Lambert Field in thrilling fashion. Schreiber was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year after leading the Boilers to the most wins by a Big Ten team since 2008. He won his 400th and program-record 408th career games at Lambert in the spring of 2012. His 408th victory as the leader of the program, April 15 in the finale of a series sweep of Illinois, made him Purdue's all-time wins leader.

The Boilermakers began the 2012 season 14-1, won 10 consecutive games twice, posted their 20th win before April 1 for the first time, reached the 30-win mark at the earliest date (April 20) in program history and won their first Big Ten title since 1909.

Headlined by Kevin Plawecki's selection 35th overall by the New York Mets, Purdue had a program-record seven players picked in the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Juniors Plawecki, Cameron Perkins and Nick Wittgren were each selected in the first 10 rounds to give the Boilers three players drafted in the first 300 picks for the first time. Six times since 2006 multiple Boilers have been selected in the same draft. Highlighted by Big Ten Player and Pitcher of the Year honors for Plawecki and Joe Haase, Purdue had a program-high eight all-conference honorees in 2012.

Schreiber has coached 62 All-Big Ten Conference selections, including 22 who were named to the conference's First Team, and has had players selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft on 32 occasions.

Prior to becoming the head coach at Purdue, Schreiber spent four seasons (1995-98) as the top assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under Pat Murphy at Arizona State University. Schreiber helped guide Arizona State to the College World Series and the national championship game in 1998. All four of Schreiber's recruiting classes at ASU were nationally ranked, including the 1995 class which was ranked No. 1 in the country and the 1996 class, which was tabbed the third best in the nation.

Before going to ASU, Schreiber served as an assistant coach for Murphy at the University of Notre Dame in 1994. That season, the Fighting Irish finished 46-16 and ended the season just two wins shy of Omaha. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Ball State (1991-92) and spent 1993 as an assistant at Butler.

A native of LaPorte, Ind., Schreiber was a four-year starter (1983-86) at second base for the Boilermakers. During his career, Purdue posted a 120-112-2 mark and established a school-record 37 victories his senior season when he was a Second Team All-Big Ten selection. Schreiber still ranks among Purdue's career leaders in a variety of categories, including first all-time in walks (132) and games played (226), sixth in runs scored (159) and tied for eighth in triples (9). He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in communications and has completed some course work towards a master's in education.

THREE HIT SAFELY IN ALL THREE GAMES VERSUS MICHIGAN STATE

• **Brett Carlson** (5-for-12), **Alec Olund** (5-for-10) and **Kyle Johnson** (5-for-10) each hit safely in all three games of the Michigan State series, accounting for 15 of Purdue's 27 hits on the weekend together. Johnson hit safely in every game of a weekend for the fifth time this year.

• Carlson has been among Purdue's hottest hitter as of late, finishing the six-game homestand 11-for-22 with two home runs and six extra-base hits total. Dating back to his three-hit effort in the nightcap of the April 2 doubleheader at Penn State, he's 15-for-39. Olund has six multi-hit efforts in the last 14 games, good for a 18-for-51 showing at the plate during that stretch. He's been making contact consistently as of late too, entering the weekend without a strikeout in his last 31 plate appearances. The sophomore has a .500 on-base percentage during the no-strikeouts streak.

• After racking up 11 walks in game two vs. MSU (the team's most since May 2012) along with **Kyle Wood** and **Harry Shipley** getting hit by a pitch a combined five times in the series, Purdue drew 19 free passes while issuing just six over the course of the weekend. The Boilermakers also struck out two fewer times (21 to 19) than the Spartans. It marked the first this season that Purdue hitters did not have more strikeouts than free passes for a weekend. The Boilermakers drew nine more walks in Tuesday's win vs. Ball State.

CUTTING DOWN RUNNERS AT THE PLATE

• Purdue has thrown out 18 runners at the plate over the last 21 games. Ten of those runners were cut-down while trying to score on hits that reached the outfield. **Nick Dalesandro** had three outfield assists in the Michigan State series and now leads the team with six this season. **Kyle Johnson** and **Cody Strong** have all recorded two outfield assists during that 21-game stretch as well.

LOTS OF QUALITY LONG RELIEF OUTINGS

• Entering the weekend, Purdue relievers have combined to pitch 176 2/3 of the 298 2/3 innings (59 percent). There have been 18 total relief outings in which a Boilermaker gave up one earned run or fewer over at least three innings of relief. **Eddie De LaRiva**, **Matt Frawley**, **Gavin Downs** and **Brian Ghiselli** each have three such outings. **Tanner Andrews** and **Tanner Schumacher** have done it twice. Frawley (twice), Andrews and De LaRiva also have what amounts to a quality start in relief this year, working at least seven innings while giving up one run or fewer.

• Meanwhile, there have been three other outings in which a reliever surrendered just two earned runs over four innings of relief. In those 21 combined outings that could be deemed quality long relief appearances, Purdue pitchers have combined for a 1.35 ERA, 0.98 WHIP and 2.5 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

SHIPLEY ON BASE SAFELY NINE TIMES IN BLOOMINGTON

• **Harry Shipley** reached base safely nine times in 11 plate appearances in the Indiana series (April 8-10). He was walked, hit by a pitch and scored a run at least once in all three games. He also recorded three hits in the series, driving in the game-tying run with two outs in the eighth inning Sunday for his first RBI of the year. The sophomore became the first Boilermaker to reach base safely nine times in a standard three-game weekend since **Kyle Wood** (11 times) in March of last season at Oklahoma. **Kyle Johnson** and **Wood** have both done it twice in their careers, earning Big Ten Player of the Week honors once each in the process.

• Dating back to the start of the 2011 season, on 18 occasions a Boilermaker has reached base safely nine times in a three-game weekend. However, among players with a minimum 10 plate appearances for the weekend, only David Miller and Shipley (.818) were able to post an on-base percentage of .800 or better for the series. Miller reached base safely in eight of his 10 plate appearances in a three-game sweep at Lipscomb in March 2011.

KYLE WOOD'S IMPRESSIVE POWER SURGE

• **Kyle Wood** hit his Big Ten-leading 10th home run of the season in the opener of the Indiana series (April 8). He has become the first Boilermaker to post a double-figure home run total since Dan Black hit 15 in 2009. That also makes Wood the first to do it in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).

• Six of Wood's 10 home runs have been hit to the opposite field (left) plus one additional long ball to straight away center. Wood's nine home runs in March were the most by a Purdue player in a month since Black hit nine in April 2008.

• Wood had an extra-base hit in 10 straight games from March 12 to April 1, matching the longest standard hit streak of his career along the way. He also had an RBI in seven straight games from March 12 to 25, racking up 14 total during that stretch.

• Wood also homered nine times in a 14-game stretch in March, including four games in a row from March 19 to 23. He became the first Boilermaker since at least the beginning of the 2005 season to homer in four straight games. Black hit four homers over the course of four consecutive games on three occasions. The week of March 22 to 27, Wood hit a three-run homer at Ball State, a grand slam vs. No. 7 Louisville and another three-run homer vs. Nebraska. He hit for the cycle over the course of the Nebraska series and finished the week 8-for-19 with six extra-base hits and 14 RBI.

• Wood has become just the 16th player in program history to reach the 20 career homers benchmark. He's currently tied for 10th in the team record book (24 career).
