### VCU (6-0) vs. PURDUE (3-2)

### THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (3-2) heads to Florida and a matchup with No. 20-ranked VCU in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla. The contest will be televised on CBS Sports Network with **Brad Johansen**, **Steve Lappas** and **Justin Walters** on the call. On the radio, **Rob Blackman** and **Larry Clisby** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 8:30 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com.

• This will be the second meeting between the two teams as VCU defeated Purdue in the second round of the 2011 NCAA Tournament en route to its historic run to the Final Four.

• Purdue owns an 18-4 record since the 2014-15 season during in-season tournaments, but the Boilermakers are looking for their first tournament title since 2016's Cancun Challenge. Purdue finished seventh in the Battle 4 Atlantis in 2017 and runner-up to Virginia Tech in last year's Charleston Classic.

• After playing just one game in a 12-day span from Nov. 17 to Nov. 28, Purdue will now get into the meat of its non-conference schedule with three straight highly-ranked teams on the docket (VCU, Florida State or Tennessee, Virginia).

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Purdue is ranked 7th nationally in turnovers per game. VCU is ranked 7th nationally in turnovers forced per game.

• Against VCU, Purdue will play its fourth straight neutral-site game against a nationally-ranked foe dating to last year (VCU, Virginia, Tennessee, Villanova).

• No matter what happens, Saturday will provide a rematch from the 2018-19 season. Florida State defeated Purdue 73-72 in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge in late November, and Purdue defeated Tennessee 99-94 in the Sweet 16 last year in Louisville.

• Purdue has shown balanced scoring through its first five games this season as four different players have led the team in scoring. In 36 games last season, just four different players led the team in scoring.

• Combined with second-chance points and points off turnovers, Purdue is outscoring its opponents 146 to 73 in "extra possessions". Over the last three games, Purdue has scored 105 points to opponents' 38 points in extra-possession categories.

• Over the last two games, Purdue has recorded 47 assists against just 14 turnovers, a ratio of 3.36. Mostly due to this, Purdue has moved to third in America in assist / turnover ratio at 1.82 (89 / 49).

• Purdue also ranks in the top 25 nationally in assists per game (21st), offensive rebounds per game (18th), scoring defense (21st) and turnovers per game (7th).

• Purdue has held two straight opponents to under 50 points for the first time since Dec. 8 and 10, 2014, vs. Purdue Fort Wayne (63-43) and Arkansas State (87-46).

• Purdue has won consecutive games by 32 or more points for the first time since Dec. 3 and 6, 2016, vs. Morehead State (90-56) and Arizona State (97-64).

• Purdue has won 99 straight games when scoring 90 or more points in a game. Its last loss came on Nov. 24, 1987, vs. Iowa State (104-96).

### THE SERIES WITH VCU

- This will be the second all-time meeting against VCU, with the Rams owning a 1-0 advantage. VCU defeated Purdue in the 2011 NCAA Tournament second round. For more details about that game, please likely check the VCU notes.
- Purdue owns a 19-7 series lead against the Atlantic 10 Conference. Purdue will be facing an A-10 team for the second straight year in a holiday tournament, defeating Davidson 79-58 in last year's Charleston Classic semifinals. **Matt Painter** is 3-2 all-time against current members of the Atlantic 10 Conference.

### DEFENSE RETURNING TO FORM

- Purdue's defense is slowly starting to return to its form from the turn of the decade when it was one of the top defensive teams in America.
- Purdue has held opponents under 50 points in consecutive games for the first time since Dec. 8 and 10, 2014, against Purdue Fort Wayne (W, 63-43) and Arkansas State (W, 87-46).
- Purdue has held its first five opponents of the season to 70 or fewer points for the first time since the 2010-11 season. That team did it in 19 straight games.
- Over the last two games, foes are just 34 of 108 (.315) from the field and 11 of 40 (.275) from long distance.

### OFFENSE FINDING GROOVE TOO

- Meanwhile after struggling in two of the first three games of the season, the Purdue offense has also found its groove some the last two games.

### THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- Purdue has always stressed winning the extra-possession game and it did so in impressive fashion last Saturday against Chicago State.
- The Boilermakers became the first team in America this year to out-rebound their opponent by 25 or more rebounds (48-22) and have nine or more fewer turnovers (8-17) than its opponent.

- It marks the first time since Dec. 10, 1983, vs. Tampa that Purdue has achieved those marks in the same game.

- Purdue is 22-3 when Matt Haarms scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 152-16 under Matt Painter when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.

## HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 324-161 (.668) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 349-166 (.678) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
