Series History

• Friday's dual will be the 73rd all-time meeting and the Boilermakers' first trip to East Lansing since a 26-10 win on Jan. 4, 2013 ... series dates back to March 7, 1925 ... Spartans lead the series 47-25-1 and are 22-11-1 when facing Purdue in East Lansing ... Boilermakers are seeking their fifth straight victory over Michigan State, a feat that hasn't been accomplished since winning six straight from 1986-89 ... MSU last defeated Purdue 20-13 in East Lansing on Feb. 7, 2010.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOILERMAKERS

• Friday's dual at Michigan State is the first Big Ten Conference road test of the season for the Boilermakers ... they are seeking their first Big Ten win on the road since Jan. 31, 2014, when they won at Indiana 18-16.

• Purdue has won all three of its road duals this season with an average margin of victory of 21.3 points, while scoring an average of 32.6 points.

• The Boilermakers return to Holloway Gymnasium on Sunday for their first of four two-dual weekends this season to take on Maryland.

• Four different lineups have been used in seven duals for a record of 45-25 ... 19 of the wins have resulted in bonus points (7 MD, 2 TF, 10 F, 1 injury default, 1 forfeit) ... Ben Thornton (5-2), Luke Welch (5-2), Danny Sabatello (4-3), Doug Welch (5-2) and Drake Stein (1-6) have started in all seven of the duals.

• Chad Welch leads the team in dual points scored with 24 ... twin D. Welch is right behind him with 22 ... C. Welch and Tyler Kral sport team-best 5-1 marks in dual competition.

More on the Spartans...

• Prior to Sunday's dual at Maryland, Michigan State wrestled at then-No. 8 Rutgers on Jan. 8 ... MSU was shutout for a third time, losing 34-0 ... the Spartans have also been shut out by Eastern Michigan (34-0) and Central Michigan (33-0) this season.

• Of their 80 dual bouts, the Spartans have won a dozen ... the technical fall by Mitch Rogaliner vs. Maryland's Jhared Simmons is the only win resulting in bonus points ... the 11 other wins have been by decision.

• The last time Michigan State won a home dual was a 40-0 blanking of NCAA Division III Olivet on Feb. 14, 2014 ... it has been four years since the Spartans have won a home Big Ten dual, with the last coming on Jan. 15, 2012, sneaking past Indiana 21-20.

More on the Terrapins...

• Maryland also split its duals last weekend, dropping a 26-12 dual at then-No. 23 Minnesota on Jan. 8.

• Of the Terps' three Big Ten dual losses, two have been on the road ... they have only had two true road duals heading into their Friday dual at Indiana.

• Maryland's combined record stands at 48-52 through 10 duals ... half of the weights own winning records, including 8-2 dual marks at 133 and 157 ... the Terps are an even 5-5 at both 149 and 285 ... 13 of their dual victories, not including forfeits, disqualifications or defaults, have earned bonus points (5 MD, 8 F).

• Two of Lou Mascola's three losses have been with bonus points ... Mascola was teched by Illinois' Isaiah Martinez (24-5) and pinned by Chad Walsh of Rider (6:21) at Midlands in December ... he sports a team-best 8-1 dual mark and is off to a 4-0 start in Big Ten action.

• Heavyweight Dawson Peck is second on the team in wins with 13, but has only started in three of the Terps' 10 duals ... his three major decisions and eight falls are tops for Maryland.

• Purdue's Chad Welch has already faced and defeated his probable opponent from Maryland in Brendan Burnham ... C. Welch bypassed the freshman with a 7-3 decision in the second round at Midlands.

• Doug Welch and Mascola split matches at Midlands in 2014 ... first it was D. Welch with a 9-1 major decision, but Mascola avenged the loss the next day with a 6-2 decision in wrestlebacks.

• Danny Sabatello and Doug Welch provided bonus points as the 24th-ranked Purdue wrestling team defeated Michigan State 22-13. The Boilermakers captured four additional weights and MSU won at four weights, including the last three bouts of the dual.

PURDUE RANKINGS NOTES

• Purdue spends a fifth straight week on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, checking in at No. 20 with 73 points ... the Boilermakers had spent the three previous weeks at No. 19.

• The current stretch of four straight weeks among the top 20 is the first since the 2013 season when Purdue was ranked among the top 20 for five straight weeks ... starting Jan. 28 through the final poll of the season, the Boilermakers were ranked Nos. 18, 17 and 16 before spending the last two editions at No. 14.

• The team ranking is the 12th while under the direction of head coach Tony Erstrand.

• Chad Welch continues to be in the top 10 at 165 pounds, moving to No. 6 this week ... it is his fifth straight appearance among the top 10 ... he has now been ranked seven times by InterMat during his career ... he spent two weeks at No. 18 while wrestling at 174 last season.

• The Welch twins have each now spent at least four weeks inside the top 10 during their careers ... Doug closed out the 2015 season with three weeks at No. 9 before finishing at No. 10.

• Four Boilermakers are included on the Gregg Henry's WrestlingReport DI Rankings ... the rankings include 33 individuals at each weight, the same amount of wrestlers selected for the NCAA Championships.

• Of the Boilermakers 11 wins vs. ranked competition, five have come from C. Welch ... his 2:25 fall vs. No. 4 Cooper Moore of Northern Iowa (12/4) stands as the highest ranked opponent a Purdue wrestler has defeated this season ... Danny Sabatello sports a 3-1 mark vs. ranked foes, including a 15-4 major decision over Nebraska's 17th-ranked Anthony Abidin at Midlands.

• When ranked, Purdue wrestlers are 13-9 vs. unranked competition and 6-2 vs. ranked opponents ... one of those wins of ranked vs. ranked has been a Boilermaker upsetting a top-10 opponent.

#ALWAYSAGGRESSIVE

• Chad Welch's 19 wins through the first half of the season are just three short of his career season win best of 22, which he set during his redshirt freshman campaign in 2012-13 ... 13 of the victories have been resulted in bonus points (5 MD, 2 TF, 6 F) ... the six pins and five major decisions are career highs in a season ... he has 30 wins in his career resulting in bonus points (9 MD, 5 TF, 16 F).

• In 22 matches wrestled, C. Welch has only been taken down seven times ... he is second on the team with 30 takedowns ... he's averaging 6.3 points per match and has a team-best 138 total points.

• Purdue wrestlers have a 0.557 winning percentage ... 85 matches have been won via decision, 23 by major decision, registered 12 technical falls and they have pinned 33 opponents.

• Through 20 matches, Ben Thornton has been on the plus-side of riding time 16 times, earning the point a team-best nine times ... Thornton has not surrendered the point to his opponent ... Kyle Ayersman and C. Welch have also claimed the riding time point nine times ... C. Welch has the most accumulated riding time at 37:49.

• Purdue wrestlers score first in half of their matches, resulting in an 81-point advantage ... the Boilermakers close out matches with a +58 edge in the third period.

• In addition to C. Welch, four other wrestlers have surpassed the 100-point total mark: Thornton (129), Danny Sabatello (125), Ayersman (120) and Stein (101).

RECORD MAKERS & CHASERS

Career Falls

• With two pins at Midlands, Chad Welch moved within one of landing on the list (17) ... he has pinned six opponents this season, which is a career best, pushing his career total to 16.

• Drake Stein picked up his fourth fall of the season and 15th of his career at Midlands.

Career Takedowns

• Danny Sabatello sits at No. 16 on Purdue's career takedowns list with 234 ... his next benchmark is 244 to move into 15th ... Sabatello has tallied a team-high 39 takedowns in 19 matches (2.1/match) ... his season high takedown total came in 2013-14 when he had 73, but he only averaged 1.4 per match.

Career Reversals

• After registering a pair of reversals at Midlands, Doug Welch is now five away from getting on the list ... the target number is 29.

Career Back Points

- Sabatello moved into No. 13 on the career back points list with 136 after scoring a two- and four-point nearfall at Midlands ... he can quickly climb the ranks as only a dozen points separate him from cracking the top 10 (148).

- At Midlands C. Welch tallied 24 back points (2 - 2NF; 5 - 4NF), propelling him into No. 19 on the list with 123 ... he entered the tournament with 99 ... he has scored a season record 48 back points through 21 matches.

- Alex Griffin now needs 14 back points to get on the list ... he picked up six at Midlands.

#BOILERNOTES**Penn State**

- Redshirt junior Tyler Kral won his first Big Ten dual match with a 7-4 decision over Jan Johnson for the Boilermakers' only win in the dual ... Danny Sabatello made his 50th career and 38th consecutive dual start.

53rd Ken Kraft Midlands Championships

- Chad Welch became Purdue's second-ever Midlands Championships titlist and the program's first since Dave Gibson in 1963 ... Welch is the third 165-pound Boilermaker to place at Midlands and the first since Luke Manuel's back-to-back eighth-place finishes in 2007 and 2008 ... Welch is the sixth Purdue wrestler to make the Midlands' finals, marking the seventh time a Boilermaker has been in the title match.

- Welch outscored his competition 47-8 in five matches, including points scored in his two pins ... his other wins included one decision, one major decision, one tech and he received one medical forfeit.

- Ben Thornton became Purdue's first 125-pounder to place at Midlands, upsetting 11th-seeded Brandon Jeske of Old Dominion with a 6-4 decision for seventh place ... the seventh-place showing is the sixth overall for the Boilermakers at the tournament ... it's the second tournament placing for Thornton in his redshirt freshman season, he also placed fifth wrestling unattached at the Michigan State Open.

- With two Boilermakers placing, Purdue now has 36 placewinners in the 53-year history of the Ken Kraft Midlands Championships ... it is the first time since 2011 Purdue has had multiple placewinners ... the Boilermakers have now sent at least one wrestler to the podium in each of the last three seasons.

- Purdue totaled 54.5 points to finish 11th in the team standings ... last year the Boilermakers were 16th with 33 points and one medalist.

Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational

- Chad Welch was Purdue's first Cliff Keen Las Vegas Collegiate Wrestling Invitational finalist since Logan Brown at 197 pounds in 2010 ... since 2002, six Boilermakers have advanced to the finals ... C. Welch became the 26th Purdue wrestler to have placed in the tournament ... the last 165-pounder to place for Purdue was Luke Manuel with a fourth-place finish in 2008.

- Ninth-seeded Alex Griffin (149) bounced back from his first loss of the season, a 6-5 decision to the No. 8 seed, Geordan Martinez of Boise State, by shutting out Virginia Tech's third-seeded and 13th-ranked Sal Mastriani with an 8-0 major decision ... it was the second dominating upset of his career ... last year he posted an 8-1 upset of No. 11 Alexander Richardson of Old Dominion in dual action.

- Doug Welch, who was seeded second at 157, advanced to the quarterfinals, but was edged by seventh-seeded Russell Parsons of Army 6-4 ... D. Welch went 2-2 with a fall and a decision.

- Purdue finished the tournament with a combined mark of 20-18 ... nine bouts were won with bonus points and the Boilermakers won two matches by injury default.

- Career Marks / Danny Sabatello picked up career win No. 70 with his 4:12 pin of Jake Velarde from Boise State ... Luke Welch posted his first career major decision with a 12-4 showing against Jordan Gurrola of San Francisco State ... Ben Thornton recorded his first technical fall, a 19-1 match vs. Patrick Kearney of The Citadel that ended at 6:57.

Bloomensburg, Shippensburg, Lock Haven

- The Boilermakers have put 30-or more points on the board in five of their first six duals this season ... the 2006-07 season saw Purdue score 30+ in five duals during the season ... the season with the most duals where the Boilermakers scored 30+ was in 2002-03 with 10.

- The 37-12 win in their first-ever trip to Bloomensburg was the Boilermakers' third straight in the series.

- Purdue won in Lock Haven for the third time in the series ... the last win in Lock Haven came in 1958, which was also the last time the Boilermakers were a true road team in the series ... it had been nearly 23 years since Purdue last met the Bald Eagles ... the 23 years since the last meeting is Purdue's third longest stretch among all-time, active Division I opponents ... the Boilermakers last faced West Virginia in 1954, a span of 61 years, and Virginia Tech in 1965, a span of 50 years.

- Firsts / Redshirt freshman Ben Thornton recorded the first major decision of his career with a 16-4 outing vs. Jon Haas of Bloomensburg ... fellow redshirt freshmen Peter Andreotti (165), Blake Reid (174) and Jacob Aven (285) all won with bonus points in their dual debuts vs. Shippensburg ... it was the first-ever meeting with NCAA Division II Shippensburg ... the Raiders were the 148th all-time opponent in program history.

Eastern Michigan Duals

- Purdue made its first-ever trip to Ypsilanti, Michigan ... the last time the Boilermakers began the season at a dual tournament was in 2010 at the Edinboro Duals.

- Purdue's 30-9 win over Northern Illinois was its 20th in the series (20-8-1) ... Boilermakers extended their winning streak against Eastern Michigan (30-13) to seven straight.

- Of the Boilermakers' 19 wins, four came by fall, two were major decisions, there was one technical fall and one injury default was received ... three of the wins were upsets, two of which came in head-to-head matchups between ranked wrestlers ... the other was an unranked Purdue grappler sticking the nation's 13th-ranked 197-pounder.

- C. Welch posted three-straight bonus point victories (MD, TF, F) ... it's the first time in his career he won three in a row with bonus points ... his 15-0 tech fall marked the third time in four career tech falls he shut his opponent out ... he totaled 14 back points in three matches.

- Career Marks / Drake Stein won his 12th career match by fall ... Ben Thornton and true freshman Jon Morales wrestled their first dual matches at Purdue.

2015-16 SCHEDULE NOTES

- Seventeen duals ... six at home in Holloway Gymnasium, eight on the road and three at a neutral location.

- The last nine NCAA team titles have been won by opponents on the schedule: Ohio State (2015); Penn State (2011, 2012, 2013, 2014); Iowa (2008, 2009, 2010); and Minnesota (2007) ... Penn State (1/8) and Ohio State (1/31) will travel to West Lafayette, while the Boilermakers will hit the road to take on Iowa (1/22) and Minnesota (1/24).

- In addition to Maryland and Rutgers, Minnesota and Iowa return to Purdue's Big Ten slate ... Indiana, Michigan, Michigan State, Ohio State and Penn State carry over from 2014-15 ... coming off of the schedule are Illinois, Nebraska, Northwestern and Wisconsin.

During his 18 years as a Division I wrestling coach, Tony Ersland has played an integral role in developing student-athletes that are accomplished on the mat and nationally recognized. He has had 94 wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships, with 28 earning All-America honors and four finishing at the top of the podium. Two of his pupils, Jordan Burroughs and Jake Herbert, earned the highest honor a collegiate grappler can receive in the Dan Hodge Award. Ersland continued to develop

Burroughs on the international stage as he claimed the 2011 and 2013 World titles at 74 kg. In 2012, Burroughs claimed Olympic gold in London.

In his first season at Purdue, Ersland qualified eight to the 2015 NCAA Championships, the most among 13 Division I coaches that were spending their first season at the helm of their respective program. Five of his wrestlers earned a spot on the podium at the B1G Championships. His squad spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Five of his grapplers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Ersland's Boilermakers win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Ersland came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Nebraska for eight seasons. While on staff, the Huskers tallied a 102-41-2 dual record, recorded seven top-20 team finishes at the NCAA Championships and grapplers earned 17 All-America honors.

Prior to his post at Nebraska, Ersland coached the Cyclone Wrestling Club in Ames, Iowa. Ersland worked with Iowa State NCAA champions Trent Paulson (157) and David Zabriskie (285) among other multiple NCAA qualifiers and All-Americans.

His familiarity with the Big Ten extends beyond his time at Nebraska. From 2000-05, Ersland was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northwestern, and he also served as a coach and board member for the Wildcat Wrestling Club.

He was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northern Illinois in 1999 and 2000 after getting his start as a graduate assistant at Central Michigan from 1997 to 1999.

On the mat, Ersland wrestled for the University of Iowa under legendary coach Dan Gable and was a part of three-straight NCAA team championships (1995-97) and four Big Ten Championships (1994-97). During his senior season in 1997, Ersland finished one match shy of All-America honors at 177 pounds.

The Humboldt, Iowa, native excelled in the classroom as a four-time Academic All-Big Ten selection and Board of Control Athletics Award winner, and was bestowed with Iowa wrestling's J. Donald McPike Award, given to the senior on the team with the highest grade-point average.

Ersland earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from Iowa (1997) and a Master of Arts in athletic administration from Central Michigan (1999).

Ersland and his wife, Carolyn, have twin sons, Mason and Jaxon.

During his first season as an assistant coach, Zach Tanelli coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Tanelli joined the Boilermaker wrestling program after a five-year coaching stint at Hofstra. During his tenure, Tanelli worked his way up the coaching ranks and most recently served as interim head coach. He was the head assistant coach for the two previous seasons after spending his first three years as an assistant coach with the Pride.

The former Badger made an impact throughout Hofstra's lineup, particularly in the lower weights. Tanelli coached four All-Americans in Steve Bonanno (125), Lou Ruggirello (133), Justin Accordini (149) and P.J. Gillespie (165). The Pride won three-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) team titles (2011-13) before moving to the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) in 2013-14, where they placed fourth with two finalists, including the 165-pound champion, Joseph Booth.

While in the CAA, seven Hofstra grapplers claimed tournament crowns under the guidance of Tanelli, including a pair of two-time champs in Bonanno and 184-pounder Ben Clymer. Jamie Franco (133), Luke Vaith (141), Gillespie (165), Ryan Patrovich (174) and Paul Snyder (HWT) were also titlists for Tanelli.

Tanelli wrestled the first three years of his Badger career at 133 pounds and bumped up to 141 for his senior campaign in 2009. He was a two-time NCAA qualifier at 133 and earned a spot on the 141 podium with a fourth-place finish for All-America accolades. During his senior season, Tanelli went on a blaze, owning a 31-6 record, including a spotless 7-0 mark against Big Ten foes. He was ranked No. 1 at his weight for the second half of the 2008-09 season after winning the 141-pound Midlands Championships title and was bestowed with the Champion of Champions Award.

Tanelli was a three-time Big Ten Championships placewinner and improved upon his finish each year. As a sophomore, he placed eighth at 133, followed by a fifth-place finish as a junior. Tanelli then took second at 141 as a senior.

During his career at Wisconsin, Tanelli compiled an 88-31 record with a blistering .967 winning percentage. He won 44 percent of his matches with bonus points, registering 15 major decisions, 13 falls and 11 technical falls.

A native of Millburn, New Jersey, Tanelli earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Wisconsin in 2009 and his master's degree in higher educational leadership and policy studies from Hofstra in 2012.

Tyrel Todd brings a standard of excellence into the Boilermaker wrestling room. The decorated collegiate wrestler with high caliber national and international freestyle experience enters his second season as an assistant coach at Purdue.

During his first season on staff, Todd coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA

Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Todd came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Cal Poly (2010-11) and Arizona State (2013-14). While on staff at Cal Poly, Todd coached four NCAA qualifiers (141, 157, 165, 197), including a runner-up finish from Borislav Novachkov at 141. The following season Ryan DesRoches earned All-America honors at 174.

In July 2013, Todd was named an assistant coach at Arizona State where he worked hands on daily with the upper-weights, including Blake Staffer, who earned All-America honors at 184 pounds with a third-place finish at the 2015 NCAA Championships. Todd's work at ASU focused on recruiting, coordinating practices, developing training schedules and organizing team travel.

From August 2011 – July 2013, Todd trained alongside his former teammates, while also mentoring and aiding in their individual development, at the Cliff Keen Wrestling Club in Ann Arbor, Michigan. His position allowed him to spend extensive time training alongside the top freestyle wrestlers in the country and to tour and compete in Russia, Chechnya and Ukraine.

A three-time All-American and 2009 Big Ten champion at Michigan, Todd made his mark on the Wolverine program wrestling at 184 and 197 pounds. In his first three seasons at 184, Todd posted an 82-24 record while placing fifth, third and second at the Big Ten Championships and earning as many trips to the NCAA Championships. Todd earned a spot on the podium his sophomore and junior campaigns, placing fifth and third, respectively.

Bumping up to 197 pounds in his final season, Todd registered a 25-3 record en route to a Big Ten title and a fourth-place showing at the NCAA Championships. He finished with a career record of 121-30, with his 121 wins ranking 16th all-time at Michigan. In four NCAA appearances, Todd compiled a 16-7 mark, which ranks seventh in program history. He is also tied for third all-time with a 13-4 career record at the Big Ten Championships.

Todd's pursuit of excellence extended beyond the mat and into the classroom. He was an All-Big Ten Academic selection and Athletic Academic Achievement Award winner in 2006, received the Snip Nalan Scholarship for Wrestling in 2008-09 and was named the team's Distinguished Scholar in 2009.

Todd also found success wrestling freestyle at 84 kg. He took fifth at the 2007 ASICS U.S. National Championships, eighth in 2008 and was seventh in 2011. In 2008, Todd placed fourth at the Olympic Trials, narrowly missing a bid for the Olympic Games in Beijing.

Todd is a native of Bozeman, Mont., and hails from a six-generation dairy farming operation. He received his bachelor's degree in secondary education from Michigan in 2009, majoring in history and minoring in psychology. He and his wife, Loni, have a daughter, Jacy Clair.
