

#### THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball team returns home for the first time in 11 days when it hosts Nebraska on Tuesday night in Mackey Arena. It will mark Purdue's lone home game between Christmas Day and Jan. 17, as the Boilermakers are in a four-road-game in five-game stretch.
- The Boilermakers are coming off consecutive road losses to top-15 opponents Rutgers and Illinois in games that Purdue had chances in the second half to win. Purdue held leads of at least five points in the second half of both contests, before falling on the road. Purdue is hoping that a return to Mackey Arena gets the Boilermakers back on track.

#### THE KEY TALKING Points

- 1) Purdue leads the all-time series with Nebraska 16-6 and is 7-0 all-time at Mackey Arena with an average margin of victory of 14.9 points.
  2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 322nd in experience (1.08 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.32).

  Among Power-6 schools, only North Carolina, Kansas State, LSU, Duke, Kentucky, Louisville and Auburn are less experienced.
- 3) In its seven wins, Purdue is shooting 49.5 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.52 (134 / 88). In its five losses, Purdue is shooting just 41.6 percent from the field, has attempted 50 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.89 (64 / 72).
- 4) Over the last five games, opponents have made 56-of-144 (.389) of its 3-point attempts, but just 70-of-139 (.504) of its 2-point tries.
- 5) Two different freshmen (Zach Edev. Mason Gillis) have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week in the season's first six weeks.
- 6) In two Big Ten home games, Eric Hunter Jr. and Brandon Newman have combined to average 29.0 PPG while shooting 23-43 (.535) field goals.
- 7) Purdue has four of the top 13 freshmen scorers in the Big Ten this season (Newman 2nd; Edey 4th; Ivey 11th; Gillis 14th).
- 8) Purdue is 50-8 at Mackey Arena against Big Ten teams since the start of the 2014-15 season. Michigan State has next best record (46-11).
- 9) Matt Painter is coaching in his 524th game at Purdue, passing Ward "Piggy" Lambert for second place on the Purdue games coached list. Purdue has had two head coaches in the last 41 years. Only Duke and Syracuse (1) have had fewer head coaches in the last 40 years.

  10) Purdue is 14-5 in his career when Sasha Stefanovic scores at least 10 points. Purdue is 12-5 when Eric Hunter Jr., leads in assists.
- 11) Purdue is 130-13 under **Matt Painter** when winning both the turnover and rebound battle, having won nine straight games.
- 11) Purdue is 150-15 under **watt Fainter** when winning both the turnover and rebound battle, having won nine straight games.

  12) Purdue averaged 15.4 turnovers per game during the first seven games. In the last five games, Purdue has averaged just 10.4 turnovers.
- 13) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

#### THE NEBRASKA MATCHUP

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Nebraska by a 16-6 margin, including a 10-4 margin in the Big Ten era, since Nebraska joined the league prior to the 2011-12 season.
- Purdue is looking to avoid its second straight loss to Nebraska. The Huskers have never won two in a row against Purdue and have never won in Mackey Arena.
- Seven of Purdue's 10 wins in the Big Ten era have come by at least 12 points and five have been by at least 15 points.

#### **ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS**

- Purdue is 2-3 in the Big Ten and 7-5 overall after falling to Illinois on Saturday night in Champaign. The Boilermakers used a 19-0 run to take a 39-33 lead early in the second half, but couldn't hold on to fall to the Illini 66-58.
- The Boilermakers five losses this year have come to teams ranked No. 15 (Clemson), 133 (Miami), 7 (Iowa), 17 (Rutgers) and 4 (Illinois).
- $\cdot$  Purdue has a balanced attack as seven players average between 5.6 and 14.1 points per game.
- Purdue will put a five-game homecourt winning streak on the line when Nebraska visits Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers are 50-8 against Big Ten foes at Mackey Arena since the start of the 2014-15 season.

#### **VANOUISHING RANKED FOES**

- With the win over Ohio State on Dec. 16, head coach Matt Painter has now won 50 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 50-85 (.370) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 20-21 in such games.
- Purdue is ninth nationally with 20 ranked wins over the last five years.

#### **CONTROLLING THE GLASS**

- Purdue has outrebounded 10 of 12 opponents this year and ranks third in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+6.8).
- Purdue has allowed just 85 offensive rebounds (7.1 per game) to turn into 76 second-chance points (6.3 per game).
- Purdue ranks 23rd nationally in defensive rebound percentage (.789), ranking second in the Big Ten behind Illinois.

#### BETTER FROM DEEP

• Purdue shot just 33.0 percent from long distance a year ago in 31 games. So far this year, Purdue is shooting 37.9 percent from long range.

#### GETTING THE BEST OUT OF THE WAY

- Purdue will have played just five Big Ten games through Saturday's contest, but you could make the point it will have already played the league's best teams and players. We know things change and teams come and go, but according to preseason selections, Purdue's opening stretch is filled with opportunity.
- Purdue will not see preseason favorites Iowa, Rutgers and Illinois after Saturday and will only have Wisconsin left out of that preseason group.
- In terms of top players, Purdue will be "done" with five of nine players on the preseason All-Big Ten team (Kofi Cockburn, Ayo Dosunmu, Luka Garza, Joe Weiskamp, Geo Baker).

#### FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

• Through 12 games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 337 (28.1 PPG) of the team's 859 points (39.2 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in four of Purdue's 12 games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami, Maryland).

- Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since  $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{Brad\,Miller}}$  (23, 10 § 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game.
