• Purdue wraps up its season-opening, three-game homestand by hosting Incarnate Word on Wednesday night. Tip is slated for 7 p.m. ET from Mackey Arena (14,846) in West Lafayette.

• The contest will be streamed online on ESPN3.com with **Bob Picozzi** and **Doris Burke** calling the action courtside.

• On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** will handle the call courtside at Mohegan Sun Arena. Due to contractual obligations to carry the Purdue vs. Iowa football game, the radio broadcast will only be streamed online as part of the Purdue All-Access platform (free).

• Live stats will be available via Gametracker on PurdueSports.com, and as always, Twitter updates will be provided on the official Purdue basketball account, @BoilerBall.

Scouting Purdue

• The No. 21-ranked Boilermakers continue their hot start, remaining unbeaten following a 96-61 win over Incarnate Word on Wednesday night in Mackey Arena.

• Purdue jumped out to a 53-24 halftime lead after shooting 72.4 percent from the field in the opening 20 minutes, including a scalding 17-of-19 (.895) from inside the 3-point line.

• Purdue also dominated on the glass, outrebounding the Cardinals by a plus-37 (56-19) margin, the largest margin in a game in school history.

• As a team, Purdue is shooting 53.7 percent from the field, 44.3 percent from 3-point range and 70.4 percent from the free throw line.

• **Isaac Haas** leads five players in double figures by averaging 15.0 PPG, 8.0 RPG and 3.0 BPG. **Rapheal Davis** (13.3), **Vince Edwards** (12.7) and **Kendall Stephens** (12.3) all average at least 12.0 PPG. **Caleb Swanigan** leads the Big Ten in rebounding at 10.0 RPG.

Scouting Old Dominion

• Old Dominion enters the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic with a 3-0 record in impressive fashion, winning its first three games by at least 17 points.

• The Monarchs are shooting 47.6 percent from the field and holding foes to just 32.5 percent from the field, including 22.9 percent from 3-point range.

• Standout senior guard **Trey Freeman** paces the Monarchs' attack at 17.7 PPG, 5.0 RPG and 2.7 APG while shooting almost 45 percent from the field. Backcourt mate **Aaron Bacote** averages 17.0 PPG and has made 15-of-16 free throw attempts this year.

• Old Dominion won 27 games last year and reached the NIT Final Four.

The Coaches

• **Matt Painter** (Purdue, 1994) is in his 11th year at Purdue, owning a 215-125 record. Painter is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to win three Big Ten Coach of the Year awards and his 215 wins are the third most by a Purdue coach in school history.

• **Jeff Jones** (Virginia, 1981) is in his third year at Old Dominion after a stellar coaching career at American. He led the Monarchs to 27 wins and a spot in the NIT Final Four a year ago.

■ Inside the Series

- A newcomer to NCAA Division I status, Incarnate Word will travel to Mackey Arena for the first meeting between the two teams.
- Purdue is 8-0 all-time against teams from the Southland Conference, winning by an average margin of 17.9 points per game. Two of the games (both vs. New Orleans) were decided by single-digits.
- Head coach **Matt Painter** is 3-0 against Southland Conference teams, defeating Lamar (Dec. 4, 2012), New Orleans (Dec. 17, 2005) and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 22, 2006).
- Purdue owns a 3-0 mark all-time on November 18.
- Incarnate Word marks the 16th Division I school from the state of Texas that Purdue will have played – the most of any state in America (California is next at 15).
- The Boilermakers own a 27-7 all-time record against the state, while head coach **Matt Painter** is 5-0, featuring two wins over Texas teams in the NCAA Tournament (Baylor in 2008; Texas A&M in 2010).

■ Painter Moving Up the Charts

- **Matt Painter** will coach in his 341st game at Purdue on Saturday against Old Dominion, moving him into third place on the games coached list with the Boilermakers.
- Painter owns a 215-125 (.632) record, the third-most wins for a head coach in school history.
- Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years, and over the last 99 years of the Purdue basketball program, there have been just eight head coaches.

■ Lots of Points

- Purdue's 107 points against Vermont were the most since scoring 109 against Central Connecticut State on Nov. 13, 2013.
- Purdue's 107 points are the third most in a November game in school history (119 vs. LIU Brooklyn on Nov. 14, 1997; above game vs. CCSU).
- The Boilermakers scored 60 points in a half for the first time since March 2, 2002 against Penn State, when it tallied 60 points in the opening half vs. Vermont.
- Purdue reached 60 points in the first half for the first time since Nov. 20, 1997, when the Boilermakers scored 61 against Louisiana-Monroe.
- Purdue then tallied 96 points in a 96-61 win over Incarnate Word on Wednesday. It marked the first time since Dec. 30, 1993 to Jan. 2, 1994, that Purdue had scored 95 or more points in consecutive games.
- The 203 points in back-to-back games are the most since scoring 204 points in consecutive games against Xavier (86) and Florida A&M (118) on Dec. 20-22, 1997.
- Purdue's 284 points (94.7 PPG) in the first three games of the season are the most since the 1997-98 season (299 points).
- The most points scored in the first four games of the season also came back in 1997-98 (391 points).

■ Fantastic First Halves

- Purdue has outscored its opponents 157-85 in the first half, leading by an average of 24.0 points at halftime.
- Purdue is shooting 57.5 percent from the field in the first half, 44.9 percent from 3-point range and 83.3 percent from the free throw line in the opening 20 minutes.
- In addition, Purdue has assisted on 36-of-50 made field goals in the first half and boasted an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.00 (36:18).
- Over the last two games, Purdue has been especially strong in the first half, shooting 63.3 percent from the field and 48.3 percent from 3-point range.
- From inside the 3-point line, Purdue has made 24-of-31 (.774) field goals in the first half of the last two games.

■ Sizzling From 20 Feet, 9 Inches

- A year after shooting just 32.7 percent from 3-point range and with many questions entering the season about perimeter play, Purdue has quieted those discussions at least for now.
- The Boilermakers connected on a school-record 18 3-pointers in the win over Vermont last Sunday, one game after making 12 in the season opener against North Carolina A&T.
- Purdue then made 9-of-21 (.429) 3-point attempts in the win over Incarnate Word, after missing its first four attempts of the contests.
- In all three games this year, Purdue has had at least six players make at least one 3-pointer.
- Through three games, Purdue is shooting 39-of-88 (.443) from long distance and is outscoring foes from deep 117-51, an average of 22.0 points per game.
- Almost 50 percent (47.9 to be exact) of Purdue's scoring has been from behind the arc this year, a number that ranks XXXth nationally.
- Six different players have made at least two 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Davis, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens, Swanigan). Four different players (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens) have made at least four trifectas in a game this year.

- Purdue's 18 3-pointers against Vermont are the most nationally in a game this season.
- Through Wednesday's games, Purdue ranks fourth in the country in 3-pointers made per game.

■ Sharing Is Caring

- A year after ranking 21st in assist rate (.611), Purdue is looking to improve on that number. If the first two games are any indication, it's on its way.
- The Boilermakers have assisted on 68-of-94 made field goals for an assist rate of 72.3 percent, which ranks XXth through Wednesday's games.
- In the season opener against North Carolina A&T, Purdue had 21 assists on 24 made field goals for an assist rate of 87.5 percent. It marked the 10th best assist rate in a single game in school history and the second-best rate of the **Matt Painter** era.
- Then in Sunday's win over Vermont, Purdue had 24 assists against five turnovers for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 4.80, the third-best mark in a game in school history.
- After dishing out 23 assists against Incarnate Word, Purdue has had at least 20 assists in three straight games for the first time since Nov. 14-23, 2010 (four times).

■ Points Per Possession

- Purdue's 1.41 points per possession against Vermont was the second-best total in school history and ranks fifth by a team nationally so far this year.
- Purdue is scoring at an impressive clip, averaging 1.27 points per possession, a number that ranks 19th nationally. Among teams that have played at least three games, Purdue ranks second in pts / possession.

■ November Reign

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 36-1 (.973) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65). The average margin of victory in those games is 25.5 points (918 points).
- Going back further, Purdue is 71-7 (.910) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 48-13 overall record during the month of November.

■ Three Games, Two School Records

- Purdue has already broken two single-game school records just three games into the 2015-16 season.
- In last Sunday's win over Vermont, Purdue hit 18 3-pointers to surpass the previous record of 16 set against Ohio State (Feb. 7, 1998).
- In Wednesday's win over Incarnate Word, Purdue set a rebound margin record, outrebounding the Cardinals by 37 rebounds (56-19), surpassing the previous record of 36 against Hawai'i (69-33) on Dec. 29, 1968.

Big Margins in Season Openers

- Purdue has won by at least 25 points in eight of **Matt Painter's** 11 season openers, including a modern-day school-record 62-point margin over Northern Illinois to tip off the 2011-12 season.
- In each of those previous seven seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- Going even further back, in the last 11 occurrences dating back to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

- Since 1977, there have been just 11 double-doubles recorded in season openers. However, the list of Purdue players to accomplish the feat is a whos-who of Boilermaker basketball.
- Swanigan and **Isaac Haas** both became the first players since **Ja-Juan Johnson** in 2010 to record a double-double in a season opener.
- The duo became the first Purdue pair to record a double-double in the same game since Jan. 15, 2013 vs. Penn State. (**Donnie Hale; A.J. Hammons**).

Dominating the Paint

- Purdue has outscored opponents 90-64 so far in the paint this year and hold a 37-14 points advantage in second-chance scoring.
- Purdue's three primary post players of **Isaac Haas, A.J. Hammons** and **Caleb Swanigan** have combined for 88 points (29.3 PPG), 60 rebounds (20.0 RPG) and 13 blocks (4.3 BPG) while shooting 28-of-47 (.596) from the field.

Large Margins

- The 28-point halftime lead (44-16) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 17th-largest margin in school history.
- The 29-point halftime lead (53-24) against Incarnate Word tied for the 15th-largest halftime margin in school history.
- The 41-point victory (81-40) against North Carolina A&T was tied for the 15th-largest margin of victory in Mackey Arena history.
- Purdue has won its first three games by 25 points or more for the first time since the 2008-09 season and for just the second time in school history (2015-16, 2008-09).
- Purdue has never won its first four games by 25 points or more.

Win When Shooting More Free Throws

- Purdue has won 21 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including all three of its games this year.

Glass Dominance

- Purdue outrebounded Incarnate Word by a school-record 37 rebounds on Wednesday night, surpassing the previous record of 36 set against Hawai'i on Dec. 29, 1968.
- Purdue's 56 rebounds against the Cardinals were the most since having 57 against Towson on Dec. 30, 1986.
- Purdue's 44 defensive rebounds were the most in documented school history (since 1986-87 when defensive rebounds became a category).
- Through three games, Purdue is outrebounding its opponents by 17.7 boards per game, a number that ranks 15th nationally, but first among teams that have played at least three games.

Biggie in Rare Air

- With **Caleb Swanigan** recording back-to-back double-doubles to start his career, he is now one of four freshmen in school history to record back-to-back double-doubles.

Biggie Earns Big Honor

- Highly-regarded freshman **Caleb Swanigan** made his debut on Friday night and he did not disappoint, becoming the first freshman to record a double-double in a season opener with 11 points and 11 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T.

- He then added his second straight double-double to start his career with 14 points and 13 rebounds in the win over Vermont.
- He became the third freshman nationally since the start of the 2010-11 season to have a double-double with at least two assists in his first two career games joining Ohio State's **Jared Sullinger** and Bryant's **Alex Francis** to accomplish the feat.
- For his efforts, Swanigan was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week, marking the second straight year that a Purdue player has won the Big Ten's initial FOW award (**Vince Edwards** last year).

3-Point Snipers

- Purdue is shooting at a high percentage from the 3-point line and it has been a total team effort in doing so.
- Six different players have made at least four 3-pointers this year.
- Five players have made at least four 3-pointers in a game this year (Cline, Edwards, Mathias, Stephens).
- **Kendall Stephens** has made 147 career 3-pointers, and has made at least three trifectas in all three games this year. He has 26 games (out of 69) of three or more 3-pointers.

Running the Show

- Purdue's three primary point guards (**Johnny Hill, P.J. Thompson** and **Dakota Mathias**) have been impressive at the start of the season.
- The trio has combined for 47 points (15.7 PPG) and have dished out 27 assists (9.0 APG) against just six turnovers.

Don't Turn it Over

- **P.J. Thompson** has played 58 minutes and has yet to record a turnover yet this season. He has dished out six assists.
- **Ryan Cline** has played 51 minutes with seven assists and one turnover.
- **Dakota Mathias** has played 56 minutes and has 10 assists against two turnovers.

Youth Movement

- Purdue's freshmen and sophomores have combined for 185 points (61.7 PPG) and 93 rebounds (31.0), accounting for 65.1 percent of the scoring and 72.7 percent of the rebounds.

Living in the Hall of Fame

- The Purdue basketball team made a quick stop in the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Massachusetts, where it was discovered a current player has his name located in the facility.
- Freshman **Ryan Cline** won the National Elks "Hoop Shoot" Championships in 2010 after making 23-of-25 free throws in the 12-13-year old division. The display is located in the second floor and lists the winners of every year.

Quick Starts Are the Key

- Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 18 of the last 37 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Sixteen of those previous 17, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 14 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.

■ Few Teams Have Purdue's Size

- The Boilermakers' average height is 6-6 1/5 and boast five players 6-8 or taller.
- Purdue's 15 players have an average shoe size of 14.922, led by Isaac Haas' size-22 boots.
- Nine schools nationally have two or more seven-footers on their rosters as Purdue joins Florida State (3), Vanderbilt (3), Arizona, California, Duke, LSU, Nicholls and Virginia Tech with at least two seven-footers on their roster.

■ Boilermakers Hot at Home

- Purdue will enter its game against Lehigh on Nov. 28 having won nine straight games at Mackey Arena. Purdue has won the nine straight games by a combined 150 points (16.7 PPG).

■ Close Encounters

- Seventeen of Purdue's last 21 games last year were decided by single digits, including 11 of the last 13 games (7-4 record). All nine of its Big Ten road games were decided by single-digits (4-5 record).
- For the season, Purdue went 12-11 in games decided by 1-9 points.

■ Blocked Shot University

- In six of the last seven years, Purdue has had the Big Ten's top shot-blocker as **A.J. Hammons** led the league in blocked shots for the third straight season (2.78 BPG) a year ago.
- Hammons' 2.78 blocks per game were the most for a Big Ten player since Ohio State's **Greg Oden** averaged 3.44 BPG in the 2006-07 season. It's the second-best average since the 2001-02 season (behind Oden).
- Hammons became the third player in Big Ten history to lead the league in blocked shots at least three times (2013-15). Penn State's **Calvin Booth** led the league in blocks four times from 1996-99, while Purdue's **JaJuan Johnson** led the league from 2009-11.
- Prior to 2009, no Purdue player had ever led the league in blocked shots.
- Purdue's 177 blocks were the most in a season in school history and the 5.21 blocked shots per game were the second-highest average in school history behind last year's average of 5.25 blocks per game.

■ Painter Joins Big Ten's 100-Win Club

- With Purdue's 92-85 win over Rutgers on Feb. 26, **Matt Painter** became the 20th coach in Big Ten history to win 100 Big Ten games. Painter is averaging over 10 wins a year in league play.
- **Matt Painter** coached his 337th game in his 10th season at Purdue and his 367th career game in his 11th season. Painter ranks third on the career wins list at Purdue (212) and is one of six coaches in Big Ten history to have won three or more Big Ten Coach of the Year accolades.
- Painter's winning percentage of .629 ranks sixth among all Purdue coaches with a minimum of 40 games coached. **Fred Schaus** (1973-78) is fifth with a .634 winning percentage.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 140-31 (.819) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 75-7 (.915) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
