#### THE OPENING TIP

- After a postponement of Tuesday's home game vs. Nebraska, Purdue will now play its third straight road game against a nationally-ranked team when it heads to No. 23-ranked Michigan State for a Friday night tussle on FS1.
- The Boilermakers are coming off consecutive road losses to top-15 opponents Rutgers and Illinois in games that Purdue had chances in the second half to win. Purdue held leads of at least five points in the second half of both contests, before falling on the road. Now, it heads to a venue that Purdue hasn't won in since the 2016-17 season as the Boilermakers look for the upset.

#### THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue leads the all-time series with Michigan State by a 70-55 margin and has won four of the last six meetings with the Spartans.
- 2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 324th in experience (1.08 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.33). Among Power-6 schools, only North Carolina, Kansas State, LSU, Duke, Kentucky, Louisville and Auburn are less experienced.
- 3) **Matt Painter** is coaching in his 524th game at Purdue, passing **Ward "Piggy" Lambert** for second place on the Purdue games coached list. Purdue has had two head coaches in the last 41 years. Only Duke and Syracuse (1) have had fewer head coaches in the last 40 years.
- 4) Tonight's coaches, **Matt Painter** and **Tom Izzo**, have combined for 1,005 career wins in 43 seasons, an average of 23.4 wins per season. The duo rank second and eighth on the Big Ten's all-time wins list. The last game between two of the top-10 winningest coaches in Big Ten history came on March 15, 2015 (Michigan State vs. Wisconsin; **Bo Ryan**).
- 5) In its seven wins, Purdue is shooting 49.5 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.52 (134 / 88). In its five losses, Purdue is shooting just 41.6 percent from the field, has attempted 50 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.89 (64 / 72).
- 6) Two different freshmen (**Zach Edey**, **Mason Gillis**) have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week in the season's first six weeks.
- 7) In three Big Ten road games, **Trevion Williams** is shooting 60.0 percent from the field. The rest of the team is shooting 37.6 percent.
- 8) Purdue has four of the top 14 freshmen scorers in the Big Ten this season (Newman - 2nd; Edey - 4th; Ivey - 11th; Gillis - 14th).
- 9) Purdue will play four straight Big Ten road games for the first time since Feb. 6 to Feb. 20, 1960 (5 straight road games).
- 10) Purdue averaged 15.4 turnovers per game during the first seven games. In the last five games, Purdue has averaged just 10.4 turnovers.
- 11) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Michigan State by a 70-55 margin, having won four of the last six meetings and five of the last eight contests.
- Prior to Purdue's current stretch, the Boilermakers had lost seven straight games to the Spartans (March 9, 2011 to March 4, 2015).
- Purdue is playing its fifth straight game against the Spartans where Michigan State is a nationally-ranked squad. During the Painter era, at least one team has been ranked in 24 of the 27 meetings (including Friday). Purdue is 7-11 against nationally-ranked Michigan State teams during the Painter era.

### THE LAST SIX GAMES

• Purdue is 4-2 against Michigan State in the last six games, one of nine Big Ten teams that Purdue owns a 4-2 or better record against during the last six games.

## ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Purdue is 2-3 in the Big Ten and 7-5 overall after falling to Illinois last Saturday night in Champaign. The Boilermakers used a 19-0 run to take a 39-33 lead early in the second half, but couldn't hold on to fall to the Illini 66-58.
- The Boilermakers five losses this year have come to teams ranked No. 15 (Clemson), 138 (Miami), 8 (Iowa), 24 (Rutgers) and 5 (Illinois).
- Purdue has a balanced attack as seven players average between 5.6 and 14.1 points per game.

- With the win over Ohio State on Dec. 16, head coach **Matt Painter** has now won 50 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 50-85 (.370) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 20-21 in such games.
- Purdue is ninth nationally with 20 ranked wins over the last five years.

## CONTROLLING THE GLASS

- Purdue has outrebounded 10 of 12 opponents this year and ranks third in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+6.8).
- Purdue has allowed just 85 offensive rebounds (7.1 per game) to turn in 76 second-chance points (6.3 per game).
- Purdue ranks 23rd nationally in defensive rebound percentage (.789), ranking second in the Big Ten behind Illinois.

## GETTING THE BEST OUT OF THE WAY

• Purdue will have played just six Big Ten games through Friday's contest, but you could make the point it will have already played the league's best teams and players. We know things change and teams come and go, but according to preseason selections, Purdue faced the league's best teams and players on the road early.

## A UNIQUE STRETCH COMING

- With Tuesday's cancellation against Nebraska, Purdue will face one of its most unique and difficult stretches in school history.
- The Boilermakers will play four straight Big Ten games on the road for the first time since the 1959-60 season.
- Purdue will also play four straight ranked opponents on the road for the first time since the 1988-89 season (five straight ranked teams).

## THE TREVION WILLIAMS FILE

- **Trevion Williams** has scored in double figures in seven straight games and has become a strong force on the inside.
- In the win over Indiana State on Dec. 12, Williams came off the bench to score 30 points, grab 11 rebounds and dish out two assists on 13-of-18 shooting from the field. He is just one of six players nationally to reach those marks this season.

- Williams' 30 points off the bench were the most off the bench in school history. He became the eighth player in school history with a pair of 30-10 games in Purdue history (**Terry Dischinger - 24; Dave Schellhase - 19; Glenn Robinson - 12; Joe Barry Carroll - 5; Bob Ford - 3; Russell Cross - 2; Wilson Eison - 2**).
- Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since **Brad Miller** (23, 10 & 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game.
- Williams is one of nine players nationally to average 14.0 PPG, 9.0 RPG and 2.5 APG this season, and one of two Power-6 players to reach those marks.

## COULD BECOME AN EXCLUSIVE GROUP

- The Purdue freshmen are on pace to have four players score at least 150 points this season, marking the second time in school history that four rookies would reach that mark, joining the "Baby Boilers" Class of 2008.

## DONES'T HAPPEN OFTEN

- Against Rutgers, Purdue lost for the just the second time since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48.0 percent from the field. The Boilermakers are now 45-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting over 48 percent from the field. The two losses are to Rutgers (Dec. 29, 2020) and against Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight game.

## BOILER NOTES

- With the win over Notre Dame, Purdue is now 16-2 (losses to Notre Dame & Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Purdue has shot at least 55.0 percent from the field in three games already this year; last season, it shot 55.0 percent just twice all season.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has had 22 games of 14 or more 3-pointers, second among all power-6 schools (Villanova - 34). Among Big Ten teams, Michigan is next with 14.
- Purdue is 114-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 156-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season. One of the losses came to Miami last Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. Conversely, the Boilermakers are 12-55 when scoring 59 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 37-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game. Under Painter, Purdue is 81-17 overall, having won six straight games.
- Purdue has won 102 straight games and is 40-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- **Record at Purdue:** 344-179 (.658) / 16th year | **Career Record:** 369-184 (.667) / 17th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
  - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
  - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
  - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
  - Painter enters the 2020-21 season third on the school's all-time wins list (337) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
  - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 15 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 14 seasons.
  - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 16 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
  - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
  - Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
  - Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
  - Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
  - Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 12 years are the ninth most nationally.
  - Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2021 – Painter is 50 years old).
  - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 13 years.
  - Has had 63 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 15 previous years at Purdue.
  - Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
