▶ HEAD COACH JEFF BROHM

- Is now 49-32 in his seventh year as a head coach overall.
- Is now 19-22 in his fourth year as Purdue's head coach.
- Is now 14-16 in Big Ten Conference play.
- Is now 11-11 in games played at Ross-Ade Stadium.
- Is now 8-8 in Big Ten games played at Ross-Ade Stadium.
- Is now 1-3 against Northwestern.

▶ PURDUE RECORDS

- · Is now 620-576-48 in its 133rd season all-time.
- Is now 337-406-32 in Big Ten Conference play all-time.
- Is now 382-239-25 in home games all-time.
- Is now 52-42-4 all-time in Homecoming games.
- ... The Boilermakers are 10-5 against Northwestern on Homecoming.
- Is now 51-33-1 all-time against Northwestern.
- Is now 37-157-2 all-time when unranked against a ranked opponent.
- ... The Boilermakers are 3-4-1 all-time against No. 23-ranked foes.

▶ SERIES HISTORY VS. NORTHWESTERN

- Purdue leads the all-time series, 51-33-1.
- · Purdue is 22-14-0 in games played in West Lafayette.

▶ PURDUE TEAM NOTES

- Six of Purdue's last seven games have been decided by seven points or less, and the Boilermakers are 4-2 in those six one-score contests.
- The loss snapped a three-game home win streak against AP top-25 teams.
- ... Purdue went 3-0 against AP top-25 teams in 2018, all at home, with a win over No. 19 Iowa on Nov. 3 the last time a ranked foe came to Ross-Ade Stadium.
- ... Purdue played three AP top-25 teams in 2019, all on the road.
- J.D. Dellinger's third-quarter field goal were the first points allowed by Northwestern in the second half in four games played this season.
- Prior to the Boilermakers' fourth-quarter touchdown, Northwestern hadn't allowed a second-half touchdown in in four consecutive games, since Nov. 23, 2019.
- Purdue has had a 200-yard passer (Aidan O'Connell) and a 100-yard receiver (Zander Horvath) in six consecutive games, while a three-game string with a 200-yard passer, 100-yard receiver and 100-yard rusher was snapped.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

OFFENSE

▶ David Bell

- School-record streak of five consecutive games with 100-plus receiving yards was snapped.
- ... Has had at least 100 receiving yards in eight of 15 career games.
- · Had nine catches for 78 yards.

> Zander Horvath

- · Had nine receptions for 100 yards, both career-best totals.
- · Added 10 rushes for 21 yards.
- Snapped a streak of three consecutive games with 100 or more rushing yards.

▶ Garrett Miller

- Scored a touchdown on his first career catch, a 40-yard reception in the second quarter.
- ... Is the first Boilermaker with a touchdown on his first career reception since David Bell in the 2019 season opener at Nevada.

▶ Aidan O'Connell

- Was 28-for-51 for 263 yards with two touchdowns and no interceptions.
- · Had a career-best 51 pass attempts.
- · Has had at least 250 passing yards in all six career starts.
- · Made his sixth career start, all consecutive.

▶ Milton Wright

 Had a touchdown reception for the second consecutive game, his second touchdown of the season and third of his career.

DEFENSE

▶ Cam Allen

- · Had an interception for a second consecutive game.
 - ... Has two of Purdue's three interceptions this season and has three career picks.
- · Added 1.0 tackle for loss.

▶ Derrick Barnes

- Led the team with a career-best 14 tackles and a season-high eight solo tackles.
- · Had a season-best 2.5 tackles for loss.

▶ Jalen Grahan

 Recorded a season-high 5.0 tackles, three solo, with 1.0 tackle for loss.

▶ Marvin Grant

- Had a forced fumble in the second quarter, the second of his career and second in as many games.
- Also had a career-best four solo tackles with 1.0 tackle for loss, the second of his career, coming in back-to-back games.

▶ DaMarcus Mitchell

- · Forced his first career fumble in the second quarter.
- · Had a career-best 3.0 tackles for loss.
- · Finished second on the team with 7.0 tackles, five solo.
- ... Has had five solo tackles in all three games as a Boilermaker.

SPECIAL TEAMS

J.D. Dellinger

- Moved into fourth place in school history for career field goals, with 37, with two tonight.
 - ... His first-quarter field goal tied him with Jonathan Briggs, who had 36 in his career from 1985-87, while his third-quarter field goal put him alone in fourth place, with 37. No. 3 on Purdue's all-time list is Ben Jones, with 43 makes from 2003-05.
- Continues to rank No. 2 in Purdue history in career field goal percentage, at 75.5 % (37 of 49).
 - ... No. 1 in Purdue history is Spencer Evans, at 76.5 % (26 of 34) from 2017-18.
- · Was a perfect two-for-two on PAT attempts.
