The Scene Setter

- The No. 14-ranked Purdue men's basketball team closes out non-conference play Saturday as Atlantic Sun Conference favorite Lipscomb visits Mackey Arena for an 8 p.m. ET, tip on the Big Ten Network.
- The game will be televised by the Big Ten Network with **Chris Vosters** and **Robbie Hummel** on the call. **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the radio broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network and live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com. Fans can receive in-game updates on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its ninth straight victory overall and its 16th straight home win. The Boilermakers are looking to remain undefeated in December for the second straight season.
- The Boilermakers then return to Big Ten play for the remainder of the season, hosting an improved Rutgers team Jan. 3, and a surging Nebraska squad on Jan. 6.

LOOKING BACK

- Wrapping up the pre-Holiday portion of its schedule, Purdue cruised past Tennessee State 97-48 on Dec. 21. Purdue's 49-point victory was the 12th-largest victory margin in school history, while the 32-point (48-16) halftime lead was also the 12th largest halftime lead in school history.
- The win was Purdue's 15th straight at Mackey Arena, 13 of which have come by double figures (Louisville, Northwestern).
- Purdue improved to 12-1 under Painter in the team's final game before the Holiday break.
- Purdue made 15 3-pointers against the Tigers, tied for the fifth most in a game in school history.
- Purdue shot 58.6 percent from the field and over the last three games are now shooting 92-of-166 (.554) from the field.
- **Carson Edwards** scored 26 points, one off his career high, with four assists and three rebounds. He surpassed 600 career points (in his 49th career game) in the victory.

• Purdue leads the all-time series with Lipscomb by a 1-0 margin, defeating the Bisons 66-62 on Nov. 20, 2007. **Robbie Hummel** had 13 points, eight rebounds and three assists, but the Boilermakers shot just 32.4 percent from the field in the victory.
 • This marks the second straight contest against a team from the state of Tennessee. Purdue defeated Tennessee State 97-48 on Dec. 21.
 • Purdue's 13-19 record (.406) on Dec. 30, is the second-worst record on a calendar day behind just Jan. 26 (5-13; .278).

▶ Making Our Statement

• The Dec. 16 game with Butler marked the final contest of a three-game set against in-state, non-conference opponents (Valpo, IUPUI, Butler).
 • With the win over Butler, the Boilermakers have won six straight games against in-state foes and haven't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (670 days).
 • Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has defeated six different in-state teams (Butler, IUPUI, Fort Wayne, Notre Dame, Indiana, Valparaiso) and is 11-3 against in-state teams.
 • Since the start of last year, Purdue is 20-4 against teams from the state of Indiana and bordering states, including 7-1 this year. The four losses are to Louisville, Western Kentucky and Michigan (twice).
 • Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 30-9 against Indiana and bordering states.
 • Just one Indiana school, Evansville (one game; last game in 2005), now holds a winning streak against the Boilermakers.

▶ Surpassing a Legend

• With Purdue's win over Valparaiso on Dec. 7, head coach **Matt Painter** moved into fourth place on the school's career win percentage list, passing **Gene Keady** in the process.
 • Painter coached in his 450th career game in the Dec. 16 win over Butler. He now owns a 302-149 career record.

▶ 2-0 Big Ten Starts are Hard to Come By

• Following its win over Northwestern, Purdue is now 2-0 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 2014-15 season, and for the fifth time under Coach Painter (2017-18, 2014-15, 2010-11, 2009-10).
 • Purdue had lost its second game of the conference season at home during the previous two seasons, suffering their only home conference loss of those respective seasons. Purdue lost to Iowa (70-63) in 2015-16 and to Minnesota in overtime (91-82) in 2016-17. Purdue also lost its third home game of the conference season in 2014-15 (Maryland, 69-60).
 • The Boilermakers' best league start during the Painter era came in 2010-11 when the Boilermakers started 4-0.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more than once since its inception in 1974.
