GAME NOTES

- This is the 40th season in Purdue Women's Basketball history. The Boilermakers are 775-411 all-time, including a 407-126 mark at home.
- Purdue is 189-92 under head coach Sharon Versyp, who is in her ninth season with the Boilermakers. She has a career record of 306-157.
- Purdue is 183-81 in December, including a 94-20 mark on its home court. The Boilermakers are 9-0 all-time on Dec. 20, including a 5-0 mark in Mackey Arena. It is their best record on any day of the calendar year.
- Purdue is 26-14 all-time in the 10th game of the season.
- The Boilermakers are 2-2 all-time against teams from Colorado.
- Purdue is 497-186 when playing in its home state of Indiana.
- Purdue is 16-0 all-time against teams from the Summit League.
- Denver will be the 185th opponent in Purdue's history. The Boilermakers are 132-53 all-time in inaugural meetings.
- The Boilermakers outrebounded Denver, 47-33, converting 15 second-chance points off of 16 offensive rebounds.
- Purdue had its third straight game with less than 15 turnovers, only coughing it up 13 times on Saturday.
- The Boilermakers outscored Denver in the paint, 34-20, and 8-0 on the fast break.
- Purdue made a season-low one three-pointer, going 1-13 from behind the arc.

GAME PERFORMANCES/INDIVIDUAL HIGHS

- Bridget Perry hit career-high numbers of 17 points and nine rebounds.
- Her seven offensive boards are the most by a Boilermaker this season
- Whitney Bays had her fourth double-double of the year and 12th of her Purdue career. She's now tied for ninth all-time at Purdue.
- Bays finished with 12 points, 11 rebounds, a career-high six steals, four assists and two blocks.

- Liza Clemons had her second straight game in double-figures, finishing with 10 points and four rebounds.
- Hayden Hamby tied a career-high with five rebounds.
- Justine Hall made her first career field goal.
