


THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 3-ranked Boilermakers return home to begin a three-game homestand as Omaha visits Mackey Arena for a 2 p.m. Black Friday tipoff. The Boilermakers are coming off a Hall of Fame Tipoff Tournament title and begin a homestand that features contests against Omaha, Florida State in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge and Iowa in the Big Ten opener.
- The Boilermakers are 5-0 for the first time since the 2015-16 season, while Omaha enters the contest with a 1-4 record.
- The contest will be televised on BIG+ (final time this season) with **Matt Menzl** and **Jay Wilson** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Purdue is 5-0 for the sixth time under head coach **Matt Painter**. A win over Omaha would give Purdue just its third 6-0 start under Painter, joining the 2009-10 team (14-0) and 2015-16 squad (11-0).
- The Boilermakers will play its first game before Christmas as a top-3 ranked team since the 1987-88 season. All other seasons that Purdue reached the top 3, it did so after the holidays.
- Purdue has won 10 straight non-conference home games by a combined 300 points (30.0 PPG). Just two games decided by less than 25 points.
- Purdue ranks No. 2 nationally in offensive efficiency behind Gonzaga. In addition, Purdue ranks in the top 10 in scoring offense (4th), field goal percentage (8th) and rebound margin (8th).
- Purdue and Gonzaga each have two players ranked in the top 10 of the KenPom POY standings. **Zach Edey** ranks sixth, while **Trevion Williams** is 9th, owning two of the five Big Ten players ranked (Ohio State's **E.J. Liddell**, Iowa's **Keegan Murray**, Michigan's **Hunter Dickinson**).
- Sasha Stefanovic** (157) needs four 3-pointers to tie **P.J. Thompson** (161) for 15th on Purdue's career 3-pointers made list.
- Purdue is one-of-four teams nationally to shoot at least 52.0 percent from the field, 42.0 percent from 3-point range and 74.0 percent from the free throw line (Santa Clara, Lipscomb, Colorado State).
- Matt Painter** (360) needs four wins to tie **Branch McCracken** for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (364). Since 1980, just two Purdue coaches have won 872 games (**Gene Keady** - 512; **Matt Painter** - 360).

UP TO 3 WITH A BULLET

- Following the tournament win in Connecticut, Purdue moved up to No. 3 in the AP Top 25 rankings. It's Purdue's highest ranking since the 2017-18 season, when it was ranked No. 3, for four straight weeks.
- This is the 20th week all-time that Purdue has been ranked top three, and the fifth week under Painter.
- Purdue is 16-7 all-time when ranked No. 3, including 7-3 under Painter.

RECAPPING THE VILLANOVA WIN

- Purdue improved to 5-0 with an 80-74 win over Villanova in the championship game of the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic.
- Purdue is the first repeat winner of the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic, also winning the event in 2015.
- Purdue's **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** were named to the All-Tournament Team. Ivey averaged 16.0 PPG, 8.5 RPG and 6.5 APG. Edey averaged 15.0 PPG and 4.5 RPG.
- Purdue trailed 54-43 with just over nine minutes to play, but outscored Villanova 37-20 over the last nine minutes for the win. Purdue made its last 11 shots from the field and over that span, averaged 2.03 points / possession.

PERFORMING WELL DURING IN-SEASON EVENTS

- Purdue has had a lot of success in regular-season tournaments over the last eight years, winning its first tournament title since 2016 with a win in the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic. Purdue is the first two-time winner in the history of the event, also winning in 2015.
- The win over Villanova was its first win over a top-10 ranked team in a tournament since Nov. 23, 2009, vs. No. 9-ranked Tennessee.
- The tournament win snapped a streak of three straight runner-up finishes in regular-season tournaments (Charleston Classic; Emerald Coast Classic; Space Coast Challenge).
- Purdue improved to 20-6 in regular-season tournaments since the 2014 Maui Invitational (eight events).

- Purdue has only had two streaks of scoring 90 or more points in four straight games, the other time being in 1969, when it did so in five straight games. The Boilermakers made the Final Four that season.

QUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY

- Including this season, Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 21 of the last 42 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- Purdue's 5-0 start is the best start since the 2015-16 season (11-0) and marks the sixth 5-0 start of the Painter era.

BALANCING ACT

• Purdue's big three of **Trevion Williams, Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** are well known across the country, but it's been Purdue's other players that have risen up and served notice.

• The other seven players in the rotation are averaging 45.0 points, 15.6 rebounds and 11.0 assists per game, while shooting 72-of-154 (.468) from the field and 47-of-104 (.452) from 3-point range.

• Purdue sophomores **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** have taken a massive leap this season after good freshman campaigns.

IVEY SHOWS PLAYMAKING ABILITIES

• One area that many people wanted to see **Jaden Ivey** expand his role was his playmaking abilities.

• Ivey averaged 16.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 6.5 assists per game in Connecticut, while only accounting for two turnovers. And don't look now, but he is 4-of-10 from long distance in his last two games after starting the year 3-of-12.

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
