THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue (4-3) faces its stiffest challenge of the season, hosting No. 5-ranked Virginia (7-0) in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge. The contest will tip at 7:16 p.m. ET, on ESPN2 with Jason Benetti and Dan Dakich on the call. On the radio, Rob Blackman, Larry Clisby and Ralph Taylor will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 6:30 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com.
- This will be the fourth meeting between the two teams, with this contest being the third meeting in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge. It will also mark the second straight season the two teams have played after last year's meeting in the NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight round.
- Purdue is looking for its first win ever in Mackey Arena against a nonconference team ranked in the Associated Press top five. The Boilermakers are 0-6 at home against top-five teams, with five of the losses coming by five or fewer points.
- Purdue owns the Big Ten's best record in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge (min. of 10 games) with a 10-8 mark. The Boilermakers are 6-1 at Mackey Arena under head coach Matt Painter in Challenge games (loss to Duke in 2008).
- Wednesday's game is also Mackey Arena's acclaimed T-Shirt game. Purdue Athletics will place a t-shirt on every seat to create a visually stunning background in America's greatest college basketball arena. The Boilermakers own a 6-1 record in their seven previous T-shirt games (started in the 2012-13 season), having won six straight games during the
- Purdue is looking for its second straight win over a ranked team after defeating No. 20 VCU last Friday, 59-56. Purdue is 7-3 against nationallyranked teams over its last 10 games (Michigan State, Maryland, Virginia).
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 13-3 at Mackey Arena against nationally-ranked teams (Maryland 2015, Villanova 2016, Ohio State 2018). Purdue has won four straight games against nationallyranked teams at Mackey Arena.
- SOMETHING TO WATCH: Wednesday's game figures to be a rock fight. The two teams rank in the top 20 in scoring defense and are among the five slowest-tempoed teams in America.
- Matt Painter won his 350th career game Friday vs. VCU.
- Purdue has won 15 straight games when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Its last loss came on Feb. 15, 2018, at Wisconsin (57-53).
- Purdue has had five different players lead the team in scoring this year, coming in just seven games. Last year's team had four different players lead the team in scoring in 36 games.
- · Jahaad Proctor has scored in double-figures in 23 straight games.
- Purdue has won 14 straight games when attempting more free throws than its opponent.
- Purdue is shooting 49.8 percent from the field in four wins this year, but just 36.3 percent in three losses. In wins, Purdue is averaging just 10.8 turnovers per game. In losses, it is averaging 16.0 turnovers per game.
- Purdue has won 99 straight games when scoring 90 or more points in a game. Its last loss came on Nov. 24, 1987, vs. Iowa State (104-96).

- In addition, they rank 4th, 12th and 25th in defensive turnover rate.
- For what it's worth, Purdue's defense is quite salty as well, ranking seventh in KenPom's adjusted defensive efficiency ratings.

LETS SLOW IT DOWN

- Wednesday's game might be the slowest game played in America this year. The Boilermakers rank 348th nationally in adjusted tempo, while Virginia is 353rd.
- KenPom's analytics suggest a mere 54 possessions for the game.
- Purdue is 348th in tempo and is followed by Loyola Marymount (where have you gone Paul Westhead?), Fairfield, Navy, North Texas and Virginia.

DEFENSE RETURNING TO FORM

- Purdue's defense is slowly starting to return to its form from the turn of the decade when it was one of the top defensive teams in America.
- Purdue has held five straight opponents to 65 or fewer points, the longest streak since the 2010-11 season (10 games).
- Purdue has held its first seven opponents of the season to 70 or fewer points for the first time since the 2010-11 season. That team did it in 19 straight games.
- Over the last four games, foes are just 75 of 209 (.359) from the field and 15 of 74 (.203) from long distance.
- Purdue now ranks 17th nationally in scoring defense (58.4), 28th in 3-point percentage defense (.270) and 63rd in field goal percentage defense (.385).

UNUSUAL START

 Purdue is off to an unusual start under Matt Painter, posting a 4-3 record through seven games. Here is a look at Painter era starts.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- Record at Purdue: 325-162 (.667) / 15th year | Career Record: 350-167 (.677) / 16th year
- · With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Eli Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young mini in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayet through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambe both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady 7; Bobby Knight 5; Bo Ryan 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- · Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.

Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four

- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
