

#### THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball team wraps up a grueling road stretch on Saturday with a trip west on 1-74 to face the 15th-ranked Fighting Illini in Champaign. It marks the third straight road game against a top-15 opponent.
- The Boilermakers are coming off a disappointing 81-76 loss to No. 14-ranked Rutgers on Tuesday night. Purdue rallied to take a five-point, second-half lead after trailing by 15 in the first half, but couldn't hold off the Scarlet Knights' hot shooting late in the game. Now the attention turns to the Illini, whose three losses have come by 13 points to No. 2-ranked Baylor, three at No. 12 Missouri and by three to Rutgers,

#### THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue and Illinois have played 191 previous times. The margin in points scored is just 27 points (Purdue 11,045; Illinois 11,018).
- 2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 315th in experience (1.07 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.32). Among Power-6 schools, only North Carolina, Kansas State, LSU, Duke, Kentucky and Auburn are less experienced.
- 3) In its seven wins, Purdue is shooting 49.5 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.52 (134 / 88). In its four losses, Purdue is shooting just 42.1 percent from the field, has attempted 38 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.91 (53 / 58).
- 4) Over the last four games, opponents have made 49-of-124 (.395) of its 3-point attempts, but just 52-of-107 (.486) of its 2-point tries.
- 5) Two different freshmen (Zach Edev. Mason Gillis) have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week in the season's first four weeks.
- 7) In two Big Ten road games, Trevion Williams is averaging 17.5 points and 10.5 rebounds while shooting 17-of-26 (.654) from the field.
- 8) Purdue has four of the top 13 freshmen scorers in the Big Ten this season (Newman 3rd; Edey 4th; Ivey 9th; Gillis 13th).
- 9) Purdue scored 1.19 points / possession in Tuesday's loss to Rutgers. When Purdue scores 1.19 PPP, the Boilermakers are 275-15 all-time.
- 10) Matt Painter is coaching in his 523rd game at Purdue, tying Ward "Piggy" Lambert for second place on the Purdue games coached
- list. Purdue has had two head coaches in the last 41 years. Only Duke and Syracuse (1) have had fewer head coaches in the last 40 years. 11) Purdue is 14-5 in his career when Sasha Stefanovic scores at least 10 points. Purdue is 12-4 when Eric Hunter Jr., leads in assists.
- 12) Purdue is 130-13 under Matt Painter when winning both the turnover and rebound battle, having won nine straight games.
- 13) Purdue averaged 15.4 turnovers per game during the first seven games. In the last four games, Purdue has averaged just 9.5 turnovers.
- 14) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Illinois by a 102-89 advantage, and despite Illinois winning the last two meetings, Purdue has won 14 of the last 19 contests with the Illini.
- Through the 191 previous meetings, Purdue has outscored the Illini by a mere 27 points (11,045 to 11,018 points; an average of 0.14 points per game), making it one of the most-competitive series in the Big Ten.
- ·The 191 meetings make it the seventh-most frequently played Big Ten rivalry.

#### **ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS**

- Purdue is 2-2 in the Big Ten and 7-4 overall after falling to Rutgers 81-76 on Tuesday night in New Jersey. The Boilermakers four losses this year have come to Clemson (now ranked 18 in KenPom), Miami, then No. 4-ranked Iowa and No. 14-ranked Rutgers, all away from Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers were missing key players in the losses to Clemson and Miami
- Purdue has a balanced attack as seven players average between 6.2 and 14.1 points per game.
- The Boilermakers are looking for their first "true" road win of the season Tuesday against Rutgers. Illinois will be the third of four straight nationally-ranked foes that Purdue will play on the road (Iowa, Rutgers, Illinois, Michigan State).

#### WINNING ON THE ROAD VS. TOP-15 FOES

- Purdue is looking for its first win on the road against a top-15 team since a Feb. 25, 2012, victory at Michigan (75-61). It also marks the last time an unranked Purdue team won over a top-15 team on the road.
- Purdue has won four games under Painter against top-15 teams on the road

#### **CHALLENGING STRETCH**

- Purdue is playing its third straight game on the road against a top-15
  opponent for only the second time in school history. The other came
  in Feb. 1989, when Purdue played Ohio State (#15), Indiana (#13) and
  Michigan (#13) in back-to-back-to-back road games.
- Should Michigan State be ranked next week, Purdue will face four straight ranked teams on the road for the first time since that same season (add #5 Illinois to the above list).

#### **VANOUISHING RANKED FOES**

- With the win over Ohio State on Dec. 16, head coach Matt Painter has now won 50 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 50-85 (.370) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 20-21 in such games.
- Purdue is ninth nationally with 20 ranked wins over the last five years.

#### CONTROLLING THE GLASS

- Purdue has outrebounded 10 of 11 opponents this year and ranks third in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+9.6).
- Purdue has allowed just 79 offensive rebounds (7.2 per game) to turn into 69 second-chance points (6.3 per game).
- Purdue ranks 20th nationally in defensive rebound percentage (.786), ranking second in the Big Ten behind Illinois.
- The Boilermakers face a big challenge on the glass Saturday. The Illini are fourth nationally in rebound margin (+14.1).

#### GETTING THE BEST OUT OF THE WAY

- Purdue will have played just five Big Ten games through Saturday's contest, but you could make the point it will have already played the league's best teams and players. We know things change and teams come and go, but according to preseason selections, Purdue's opening stretch is filled with opportunity.
- Purdue will not see preseason favorites Iowa, Rutgers and Illinois after Saturday and will only have Wisconsin left out of that preseason group.
- In terms of top players, Purdue will be "done" with five of nine players on the preseason All-Big Ten team (Kofi Cockburn, Ayo Dosunmu, Luka Garza, Joe Weiskamp, Geo Baker).

#### FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

Through 11 games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 314 (28.5 PPG) of the team's 801 points (39.2 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in four of Purdue's 11 games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami, Maryland).

#### THE TREVION WILLIAMS FILE

- Trevion Williams has had a slow start to the season, but if the mostrecent games are any indication, the junior big man is ready to break out again.
- In the win over Indiana State on Dec. 12, Williams came off the bench to score 30 points, grab 11 rebounds and dish out two assists on 13-of- $18\ \mbox{shooting}$  from the field. He is just one of four players nationally to reach those marks this season.

- · Williams' 30 points off the bench were the most off the bench in school history. He became the eighth player in school history with a pair of 30-10 games in Purdue history (Terry Dischinger - 24; Dave Schellhase
- 19; Glenn Robinson 12; Joe Barry Carroll 5; Bob Ford 3; Russell Cross - 2: Wilson Eison - 2).
- Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since Brad Miller (23, 10 & 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game.
- Williams is one of five players nationally to average 14.0 PPG, 9.0 RPG and 2.5 APG this season, and the only Power-6 player to reach those

• Purdue lost for the just the second time since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48.0 percent from the field. The Boilermakers are now 45-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting over 48 percent from the field. The two losses are to Rutgers (Dec. 29, 2020) and against Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight game.

- · With the win over Notre Dame, Purdue is now 16-2 (losses to Notre Dame & Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.
