#### THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball team wraps up a grueling road stretch on Saturday with a trip west on I-74 to face the 15th-ranked Fighting Illini in Champaign. It marks the third straight road game against a top-15 opponent.
- The Boilermakers are coming off a disappointing 81-76 loss to No. 14-ranked Rutgers on Tuesday night. Purdue rallied to take a five-point, second-half lead after trailing by 15 in the first half, but couldn't hold off the Scarlet Knights' hot shooting late in the game. Now the attention turns to the Illini, whose three losses have come by 13 points to No. 2-ranked Baylor, three at No. 12 Missouri and by three to Rutgers.

#### THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue and Illinois have played 191 previous times. The margin in points scored is just 27 points (Purdue - 11,045; Illinois - 11,018).
- 2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 315th in experience (1.07 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.32). Among Power-6 schools, only North Carolina, Kansas State, LSU, Duke, Kentucky and Auburn are less experienced.
- 3) In its seven wins, Purdue is shooting 49.5 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.52 (134 / 88). In its four losses, Purdue is shooting just 42.1 percent from the field, has attempted 38 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.91 (53 / 58).
- 4) Over the last four games, opponents have made 49-of-124 (.395) of its 3-point attempts, but just 52-of-107 (.486) of its 2-point tries.
- 5) Two different freshmen (**Zach Edey**, **Mason Gillis**) have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week in the season's first four weeks.
- 7) In two Big Ten road games, **Trevion Williams** is averaging 17.5 points and 10.5 rebounds while shooting 17-of-26 (.654) from the field.
- 8) Purdue has four of the top 13 freshmen scorers in the Big Ten this season (Newman - 3rd; Edey - 4th; Ivey - 9th; Gillis - 13th).
- 9) Purdue scored 1.19 points / possession in Tuesday's loss to Rutgers. When Purdue scores 1.19 PPP, the Boilermakers are 275-15 all-time.
- 10) **Matt Painter** is coaching in his 523rd game at Purdue, tying **Ward "Piggy" Lambert** for second place on the Purdue games coached list. Purdue has had two head coaches in the last 41 years. Only Duke and Syracuse (1) have had fewer head coaches in the last 40 years.
- 11) Purdue is 14-5 in his career when **Sasha Stefanovic** scores at least 10 points. Purdue is 12-4 when **Eric Hunter Jr.**, leads in assists.
- 12) Purdue is 130-13 under **Matt Painter** when winning both the turnover and rebound battle, having won nine straight games.
- 13) Purdue averaged 15.4 turnovers per game during the first seven games. In the last four games, Purdue has averaged just 9.5 turnovers.
- 14) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

## THE TREVION WILLIAMS FILE

• Trevion Williams has had a slow start to the season, but if the most-recent games are any indication, the junior big man is ready to break out again.

• In the win over Indiana State on Dec. 12, Williams came off the bench to score 30 points, grab 11 rebounds and dish out two assists on 13-of-18 shooting from the field. He is just one of four players nationally to reach those marks this season.

• Williams' 30 points off the bench were the most off the bench in school history. He became the eighth player in school history with a pair of 30-10 games in Purdue history (Terry Dischinger - 24; Dave Schellhase - 19; Glenn Robinson - 12; Joe Barry Carroll - 5; Bob Ford - 3; Russell Cross - 2; Wilson Eison - 2).

• Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since Brad Miller (23, 10 & 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game.

• Williams is one of five players nationally to average 14.0 PPG, 9.0 RPG and 2.5 APG this season, and the only Power-6 player to reach those marks.

• Sasha Stefanovic has had a terrific start to his junior season, averaging 11.5 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.

• Stefanovic is the only player in America to have at least 30 assists and 30 made 3-pointers so far this year.

• Stefanovic ranks 19th nationally in 3-point percentage (.500).

## HELLO, NEWMAN

• Brandon Newman has benefited greatly from redshirting last year, starting all 11 games and ranking fourth on the team in scoring (9.5), second in 3-pointers (19), first in steals (10), third in assists (24) and second in assist/turnover ratio (2.00).

### COULD BECOME AN EXCLUSIVE GROUP

• The Purdue freshmen are on pace to have four players score at least 150 points this season, marking the second time in school history that four rookies would reach that mark, joining the "Baby Boilers" Class of 2008.

### DON'T HAPPEN OFTEN

• Purdue lost for the just the second time since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48.0 percent from the field. The Boilermakers are now 45-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting over 48 percent from the field. The two losses are to Rutgers (Dec. 29, 2020) and against Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight game.

## BOILER NOTES

• With the win over Notre Dame, Purdue is now 16-2 (losses to Notre Dame & Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.

• Purdue has shot at least 55.0 percent from the field in three games already this year; last season, it shot 55.0 percent just twice all season.

• Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has had 22 games of 14 or more 3-pointers, second among all power-6 schools (Villanova - 34). Among Big Ten teams, Michigan is next with 14.

• Purdue is 114-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.

• Purdue is 156-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season. One of the losses came to Miami last Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. Conversely, the Boilermakers are 12-55 when scoring 59 or fewer points.

• Purdue is 37-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game. Under Painter, Purdue is 81-17 overall, having won six straight games.

• Purdue has won 102 straight games and is 40-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.

• Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 12,095 days.

• Purdue is 125-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 39-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season. Purdue has won 17 straight games when scoring 80 or more points.

• Purdue is 130-13 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game, having won nine straight games.

• Purdue has won 12 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017. Purdue is 1-0 this year when wearing gold after defeating Maryland on Christmas Day.

• Among Power-6 (Big Ten, ACC, SEC, PAC-12, Big East, Big 12) programs, Purdue has the fifth-best home winning percentage since the start of the 2014-15 season.

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
  - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
  - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
  - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season.
