

#### THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball team looks for its fourth Big Ten road win in a row on Tuesday when it visits Maryland for a 6:30 p.m. ET, tip on the Big Ten Network. Dave Revsine, who called the Purdue game on Saturday from a secluded island location, has begrudingly returned to the snowy Midwest and will call the game with former Iowa standout Jess Settles.
- The Boilermakers are coming off perhaps their best half of the year in the win over No. 21-ranked Minnesota on Saturday. The Boilermakers outscored Minnesota 51-27 in the second half to cruise to the 19-point win, and look to continue that momentum at Maryland.

#### THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue leads the series with Maryland by a 6-4 advantage, but has lost two straight games at the XFinity Center. Including Tuesday's tilt, one of the teams has been ranked in nine of the 11 meetings between the two squads.
- 2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 329th (out of 347 teams) in experience (1.06 years). The total is 14th in the Big Ten. Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the league at 1.36 years (285th nationally).
- 3) Purdue has had its full arsenal of rotation players for just 10 of its 18 games this year, missing key personnel for seven games this year. Purdue went 7-3 in those 10 games, all coming against power-conference teams. Purdue will be without Sasha Stefanovic vs. Maryland.
- 4) Tuesday's contest will be the 300th conference game that Matt Painter will coach in (18 at Southern Illinois: 281 at Purdue). He owns a 191-108 (.639) record in league games. He has finished in the top 3 of the league standings in 10 of his 16 completed seasons.
- 5) With the win over Minnesota, Matt Painter has tied Illinois' Harry Combes for eighth on the all-time Big Ten wins list with 174 league wins.
- 6) Four freshmen have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors, the most in league history. Michigan (2012-13) and Ohio St. (2010-11) had 3.
- 7) Brandon Newman was named the Big Ten's Freshman of the Week for the second time this season, now 1-of-2 freshmen with multiple awards.
- 8) With Purdue entering the AP Top 25 this week, the Boilermakers have been nationally-ranked in six straight seasons, the longest streak in school history. Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 71-of-110 Associated Press top-25 polls.
- 9) Purdue owns two wins over teams ranked in this week's AP Top 10 one of four schools with multiple top-10 victories (Minn, Texas Tech, Oklahoma). 10) Over the last five years since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue has the most wins in the Big Ten (61). Michigan State is next at 58. 11) With the win over Minnesota, Purdue has won 20 straight games when scoring at least 80 points; 42-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season.

- Beginning its stretch run, Purdue owns a 7-4 league record and a 12-6 overall record. The Boilermakers opened Big Ten play with a 2-3 record, but have won five of their last six contests to put themselves in position for a double-bye in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Never satisfied with the defense, Coach Painter's squad has held seven straight opponents to 72 or fewer points.
- The Boilermakers have also surged in the second half, outscoring its opponents by 61 combined points in the final 20 minutes.
- Purdue has six players averaging between 7.5 and 15.4 points per game.
   Nine different players have scored at least 10 points in a game twice this season.

#### **VANQUISHING RANKED FOES**

- With the win over Minnesota on Saturday, head coach Matt Painter has now won 53 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 53-87 (.379) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 23-23 in such games.
- Purdue is eighth nationally with 23 ranked wins over the last five years.

#### A DEEPER DIVE INTO ANALYTICS

- Purdue has positioned itself nicely to make a run to another strong seed in the NCAA Tournament with some nice wins under its belt.
- Purdue's four wins over nationally-ranked teams are tied for the most in America (Purdue, Gonzaga, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Virginia Tech, Ohio State, Oklahoma).
- · Purdue's four Quad-1 wins rank as the seventh-most nationally (Illinois, Ohio State, Missouri, Alabama, Baylor, Gonzaga all with five).
- Purdue's nine Quad-1 and Quad-2 wins rank second nationally behind Alabama (10).
- Purdue's 14 Quad-1 and Quad-2 games played lead the country.
- Purdue's seven top-50 wins against the top 50 on the Sagarin ratings are tied for the most nationally (Illinois, Wisconsin).
- Purdue's strength of schedule ranks 8th in the Sagarin ratings, 8th in KenPom, 9th in the NCAA Net rankings and 11th in the ESPN BPI rankings.

#### CARDIAC KIDS

 Purdue has won four games this year when trailing by 11 or more points, tied for the most 11-point comebacks in school history (1982-83 season – 4). Three of the comebacks came against ranked teams.

#### STREAKING ON THE ROAD

- Purdue has won three straight road games for the first time since Jan. 11 to 31, 2019 a run that lifted Purdue to a Big Ten Championship.
- A win over Maryland would give Purdue a four-game road winning streak for the first time since winning six straight in 2017-18.

#### FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC

- Over the last two seasons, Purdue has essentially had four buzzerbeating shots to give the Boilermakers the victory.
- ... Sasha Stefanovic vs. Minnesota (Jan. 2, 2020)
- ... Sasha Stefanovic vs. Northwestern (Feb. 1, 2020)
- ... Trevion Williams vs. [23] Michigan State (Jan. 8, 2021)
- ... Jaden Ivey vs. [15] Ohio State (Jan. 19, 2021)
- Jaden Ivey becomes the first Purdue freshman to score the gamewinning points in the final five seconds of a game since Carsen Edwards hit two free throws with 2.4 seconds left against Maryland on Feb. 4, 2017, to give Purdue a 73-72 win.

#### A LOOK AT THE PERIMETER

- Purdue has found a way to win five of its last six games, despite struggling from the perimeter.
- Over the last six games, Purdue is shooting just 35-of-120 (.292) from long distance. That includes an 11-of-17 performance against Indiana.
- Foes are scoring just 44.5 percent of its points from 2-point field goals against Purdue, ranking 318th nationally. However, from 3-point range, 37.0 percent of opponents' points are coming from long range, good for 24th nationally.

#### FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

 Through 18 games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 523 (29.1 PPG) of the team's 1,276 points (41.0 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in five of Purdue's 18 games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami, Maryland, Minnesota).

#### THE TREVION WILLIAMS FILE

- Trevion Williams has become one of the Big Ten's best players.
- Williams' 30 points against Indiana State off the bench were the most off the bench in school history. He became the eighth player in school history with a pair of 30-10 games in Purdue history (Terry Dischinger
- 24; Dave Schellhase 19; Glenn Robinson 12; Joe Barry Carroll 5; Bob Ford 3; Russell Cross 2; Wilson Eison 2).
- Williams is one of eight players nationally to average 15.0 PPG, 9.0 RPG and 2.0 APG this season, and the only Power-6 player to reach those marks.
