### BOILER NOTES

#### TEAM

- Captains: Gus Hartwig, Devin Mockobee, Kydran Jenkins, Dillon Thieneman
- Oregon won the toss and elected to receive. Purdue kicked to the north end zone.
- Smiley Bradford made his first career start and posted six stops.
- Purdue edged Oregon in time of possession, 30:44 to 29:16.
- The Boilermakers amassed over 200 yards on the ground for the third time in 2024, their most instances in a season since 2018.

#### OFFENSE

- Ryan Browne finished 9-of-19 for 93 yards on the night. He also rushed a game-high 14 times for 48 yards.
- The Boilermakers rushed a season-high 40 times for 208 yards (5.2 average). Purdue tallied 10 plays of 10 yards or more on the ground.
- Reggie Love led the attack on the ground with carries for xx yards, his high at Purdue, and a career-best 8.5 yards per carry (minimum five attempts).
- The Boilermakers' 202 yards rushing were the second-most surrendered by Oregon this season.
- Max Klare led the team in receiving for the fifth time in 2024, catching three passes for 32 yards.
- Devin Mockobee logged 10 carries for 46 yards, good for a 4.6 average.

#### DEFENSE

- Kyndrich Breedlove posted a career-high eight tackles (four solos), tying for the team lead with Yanni Karlaftis (eight tackles, seven solos).
- Karlaftis picked up his first tackle-for-loss of the season.
- Kyndrich Breedlove intercepted Dillon Gabriel's pass late in the second quarter for his team-high third pick of the year. He is the 13th Boilermaker in the last 10 years to pick off three or more passes in a season.
- Will Heldt recorded a sack in the second quarter for his fifth quarterback stop of the year. He now has 6.5 tackles-for-loss on the year.
- Mo Omonode notched his first sack of the season in the second quarter.
- Hudson Miller posted a career-high five tackles (four solos) on the night.

#### SPECIAL TEAMS

- Keelan Crimmins dropped his second quarter punt at the 1-yard line, his deepest punt as a Boilermaker, with a punt from the Oregon 40-yard line.
- Crimmins finished the day with two more punts inside the 20-yard line.
