

THE OPENING TIP

- · Purdue heads down the homestretch looking to solidify its NCAA Tournament resume and surge to a Big Ten Tournament double-bye as the Boilermakers head to the frigid tundra to face Minnesota on Thursday. Jason Benetti and former Russian Basketball Super League 1 star Robbie Hummel will call the game, likely spending most of the time discussing who has the better Major League Baseball team in Chicago.
- The Boilermakers are coming off a 75-70 decision over Northwestern on Saturday and are looking for their fourth Big Ten road win of the season, Through Tuesday's games, only Ohio State has won at least four Big Ten road games so far this season.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue leads the series with Minnesota by a 106-85 advantage, having won consecutive meetings with the Gophers. The Boilermakers are 5-6 at "The Barn" under Coach Painter, having won two of their last three trips to Minneapolis.
- 2) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 331st (out of 347 teams) in experience (1.05 years). The total is 14th in the Big Ten. Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the league at 1.35 years (288th nationally).
- 3) Purdue has had its full arsenal of rotation players for just 11 of its 20 games this year, missing key personnel for nine games this year. Purdue has gone 8-3 in those 11 games with a full roster, all coming against power-conference teams (losses to Iowa, Rutgers & Illinois).
- 4) Matt Painter won his 350th overall game and 175th in Big Ten play on Saturday night against Northwestern.
- 5) Four freshmen have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors, the most in league history. Michigan (2012-13) and Ohio St. (2010-11) had 3.
- 6) A Purdue freshman has been named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week in four straight weeks and in six of a possible 11 weeks this season.
- 7) With Purdue entering the AP Top 25 last week, the Boilermakers have been nationally-ranked in six straight seasons, the longest streak in school history. Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 72-of-110 Associated Press top-25 polls.
- 8) Over the last five years since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue has the most wins in the Big Ten (62). Michigan State is next at 60. 9) Purdue owns a 53-9 home record in Big Ten play since the 2014-15 season. Since that year, just one team, Michigan has beaten the Boiler-
- makers twice at Mackey Arena, Michigan State, Indiana, Wisconsin, Nebraska and Northwestern are the five teams to not win in Mackey. 10) Purdue is on a quest for its fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance as a top-five seed. Just six teams (Purdue, North Carolina, Kansas, Virginia, Duke, Kentucky) have had four straight years of top-five seeds, and several of those streaks are in jeopardy this season.

THE MINNESOTA MATCHUP

- Thursday's matchup will be the 192nd meeting all-time between the Golden Gophers and Boilermakers. Purdue owns a 106-85 advantage against Minnesota, but the two teams have split the last four meetings after Minnesota won a pair of games during the 2018-19 season.
- The 192nd meeting makes this the sixth-most, frequently-played rivalry in the Big Ten Conference.
- The series is one of the most competitive in the Big Ten as nine of the last 13 contests have been decided by four or fewer points or in overtime. The last 13 meetings have been decided by 3, 3 (3 overtimes), 4, 4, 4, 9 (overtime), 34, 24, 10, 4, 2, 5 (overtime) and 19 points.
- Purdue's 11 overtime games (8-3) against Minnesota are the most against a single opponent.

ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Beginning its stretch run, Purdue owns an 8-5 league record and a 13-7 overall record. The Boilermakers opened Big Ten play with a 2-3 record, but have won six of their last eight contests to put themselves in position for a double-bye in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Never satisfied with the defense, Coach Painter's squad has held nine straight opponents to 72 or fewer points.
- In Big Ten play, Purdue has made all the right halftime adjustments, outscoring opponents by 47 points, while being outscored by 36 points in the opening 20 minutes.
- Purdue has six players averaging between 7.7 and 15.4 points per game.
 Eight different players have scored at least 10 points in a game three times this season and four players have reached the 20-point plateau.

POLL POSITION

- With its No. 24 ranking this week, Purdue has appeared in the Associated Press Top-25 poll for the sixth straight season, the secondlongest streak in school history behind eight straight years from 1968 to 1975.
- Since the first poll of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 72-of-110 top-25 polls.

A DEEPER DIVE INTO ANALYTICS

- Purdue has positioned itself nicely to make a run to another high seed in the NCAA Tournament with some nice wins under its belt.
- Purdue's four wins over nationally-ranked teams are tied for the second-most nationally behind Ohio State's and Kansas' five victories (Purdue, Baylor, Gonzaga, Iowa, Maryland, Minnesota, Missouri, Oklahoma, Virginia Tech).

- · Purdue's nine Quad-1 and Quad-2 wins rank tied for fourth nationally behind Alabama (12), Gonzaga (10) and Illinois (10).
- Purdue's 15 Quad-1 and Quad-2 games played rank second nationally (Alahama - 161).
- Purdue's seven top-50 wins against the top 50 on the Sagarin ratings are fourth nationally (Illinois, Ohio State - 9; Wisconsin - 8). Purdue's 13 games are third nationally (Illinois, Maryland - 14).
- Purdue's 6-0 Quad-2 record is the best Quad-2 record in the country.
- Purdue's strength of schedule ranks 7th in KenPom, 9th in the NCAA
 Net rankings, 9th in the Sagarin ratings and 9th in ESPN BPI rankings.

CARDIAC KIDS

- Jaden Ivey becomes the first Purdue freshman to score the gamewinning points in the final five seconds of a game since Carsen Edwards hit two free throws with 2.4 seconds left against Maryland on Feb. 4, 2017, to give Purdue a 73-72 win.

SIZZLING AT THE LINE

- When the calendar flipped to February, Purdue started to heat up from the free throw line. The Boilermakers are 35-of-39 (.897) from the free throw line, including a 23-of-24 (.958) effort against Northwestern.
- In the month of February, Purdue's 89.7 free throw percentage ranks fourth among all teams that have played at least two games.

- ▶ Record at Purdue: 350-181 (.659) / 16th year | Career Record: 375-186 (.668) / 17th year
- · With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
