#### THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 6-ranked Boilermakers conclude their season-opening, three-game homestand, facing its toughest challenge of the young season as Wright State visits Mackey Arena for a 7 p.m. ET, tipoff. The Raiders were last year's Horizon League regular-season champions and return several prominent players from last year's squad, being picked second behind Cleveland State this season.
- The Boilermakers are 2-0 following wins over Bellarmine and Indiana State, while Wright has defeated Lake Erie and lost to Marshall.
- The contest will be televised by the Big Ten Network with **Matt Schumacker** and **Stephanie White** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

#### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- This will be the first meeting against Wright State. Purdue is looking for its 11th 3-0 stat under **Matt Painter** and first since 2018-19.
- Tuesday's contest marks the 27th straight sellout, dating to Jan. 15, 2019, vs. Rutgers.
- Purdue has scored 90 or more points in consecutive games for the first time since Dec. 21 to 30, 2017 (Tennessee State, Lipscomb). Purdue hasn't scored 90 or more points in three straight games during the Painter era, last doing so Dec. 18 to 27, 2000.
- Purdue has shot over 50.0 percent in both of its games this season. The last time Purdue had three straight games shooting over 50.0 percent came on Feb. 22 to March 3, 2018 (4 games in a row).
- Purdue is 52-3 at home during the month of November during the **Matt Painter** era, with losses coming to Bucknell (2012), Villanova (2016) and Texas (2019).
- Trevion Williams** needs 18 points for 1,000 in his career, and five rebounds for 650 in his career. He'd become the 16th player in school history with 1,000 points and 650 rebounds.
- It's early, but **Zach Edey** ranks No. 4 in the KenPom Player of the Year standings, behind Ohio State's **E.J. Liddell**, Houston's **Marcus Sasser** and Gonzaga's **Drew Timme**. Edey has 38 points, 19 rebounds, four blocks and three assists in 40 minutes this season. Edey is eighth in the country in field goal percentage (.857) and 18th in offensive rebounds per game (4.5).
- Matt Painter** (180) needs two wins in Big Ten play to tie **Jud Heathcote** for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (182).

- Purdue hasn't lost to a current Horizon League member since Dec. 7, 1991, a 69-53 loss to **Tony Bennett** and Green Bay.

### RECAPPING THE INDIANA STATE WIN

- The Boilermakers are now 31-4 all-time against Indiana State, having won five straight games. The 25-point margin was the largest over the Sycamores since a 92-63 win in Dec. 1992.
- Purdue scored 90 points in back-to-back games for the first time since Dec. 21 - 30, 2017.
- **Jaden Ivey** recorded career highs in points (27) and rebounds (8), while going 10-of-13 from the field. He added four assists and two steals.
- **Zach Edey** recorded his second career double-double with a career-high 22 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and three blocked shots, while going 8-of-9 from the field.
- Ivey and Edey combined for 49 points, 18 rebounds and seven assists while going 18-of-22 from the field and 11-of-14 from the free throw line.
- Through two games, Edey is 12-of-14 from the field and 14-of-17 from the free throw line for 38 points and 19 rebounds in 40 minutes of action.
- **Caleb Furst** recorded his first career double-figure scoring game with 12 points and eight rebounds.
- **Trevion Williams** contributed 11 points, eight rebounds, four blocks and three assists in 20 minutes.

### THE CENTER OF EFFICIENCY

- Purdue's two-headed center monster of **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** is averaging 26.5 points, 17.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 4.5 blocked shots per game, in just 37.3 minutes per game.

### RIGHT WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

- The talented sophomore class picked up right where they left off last year, scoring 46 points in the season opener and then 59 points in the win over Indiana State - the most they have scored collectively as a group.
- As freshmen last year, the group accounted for 44.5 percent of Purdue's scoring, the fourth-highest percentage in America. In the two victories so far, the group has accounted for 55.9 percent of Purdue's points.
- The class will receive a boost when **Mason Gillis** returns this weekend.

### INSIDE MORE NUMBERS

- Purdue is 124-15 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 160-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 130-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 44-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.

- Purdue has been ranked in the preseason poll in 6 of last 7 years.

- Purdue has been ranked in five straight weeks, dating to last year.

- **Last time unranked:** Feb. 22, 2021.

- Purdue is 40-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 11 straight games.
- Purdue is 133-14 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue has won 13 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.
- Purdue has won 18 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.

### QUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY

- Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 20 of the last 41 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 10 times (in 16 seasons) under head coach **Matt Painter**, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

### NEW LINEUP

- Purdue may have returned all five starters from last year, but technically only one of the players (**Sasha Stefanovic**) is starting this year.
- The five players with the most-returning starts from last year are **Trevion Williams**, **Mason Gillis**, **Brandon Newman**, **Stefanovic** and **Eric Hunter Jr.** Stefanovic is the only one starting so far this season.

## POLL POSITION

- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 76 of 116 of the Associated Press Top 25 polls. The total is the 11th most in the country.
- Purdue has been ranked in one poll in every season for seven consecutive years, the second-longest streak in school history (eight; 1968-75).

## RETURNING STARTS EQUALS SUCCESS

- Purdue will return 135 starts (of a possible 140), the fewest starts the program is losing from the previous season in the Painter era.
- In four previous years that Purdue returned at least 130 starts, Purdue has posted a 112-32 record with four NCAA Tournament appearances, three Sweet 16 trips and a school-record 30 wins in 2017-18.

## IT STAYS THE SAME

- Purdue will return all five starters from last season and over 90.0 percent of minutes played. It marks the first time since the 2009-10 season that all five starters return. That team went 29-6 and reached as high as No. 3 in the national polls in February.
- Purdue returns 90.9 minutes played, the second most of any power-conference team in America. Purdue returns the most minutes of any power-conference team that made the NCAA Tournament a year ago.

## FRESHMAN CLASS RETURNS AFTER BIG YEAR

- This year's seven-member sophomore class had an outstanding campaign a year ago, ranking fifth among all Purdue freshman classes in points scored (885) and fourth in points per game (31.6).
- The class was even more impressive in league play, averaging 31.2 points and accounting for 45.2 percent of Purdue's scoring in Big Ten action.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- **Record at Purdue:** 357-184 (.660) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 382-189 (.669) / 18th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
  - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
  - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
  - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
  - Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
  - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
  - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
  - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
  - Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
  - Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
  - Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
  - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
  - Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
  - Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
