BOILER NOTES

TEAM

- Purdue captains - Aidan O'Connell and Jalen Graham.
- The Boilermakers had their second straight sell-out and the second of the season.
- Iowa won the toss and elected to take the ball in the second half.
- LB/DL Tristan Cox took his first career snaps at fullback in the absence of Ben Furtney.
- The Boilermakers controlled time of possession for the ninth straight game, finishing with a 31:58-28:02 advantage in this one.

OFFENSE

- QB Aidan O'Connell went 20-43 for 168 yards.
- In this game, O'Connell eclipsed 8,000 career passing yards to reach 8,167. He is the sixth quarterback in Purdue history to accomplish the feat.
- WR Charlie Jones racked up 11 catches for 104 yards against Iowa. It is his sixth game this season with over 100 yards receiving and his fifth with at least 10 catches.
- He is the sixth Boilermaker to record six 100-yard receiving games in a single season.
- Jones is just the second Purdue receiver to have five or more 10+ catch games in a season since 2000. Rondale Moore had six such games in 2018.
- TE Payne Durham hauled in two receptions for 35 yards to move to 1,096 career receiving yards to be just 151 yards shy of the sixth most receiving yards by a tight end.
- This is the first time Purdue was held out of the end zone since Oct. 14, 2017 against Wisconsin.
- RB Devin Mockobee continues to impress in his freshman campaign. He contributed 75 yards on 14 carries.

DEFENSE

- The Boilermaker defense has prevented opponents from scoring on their opening possession in seven of nine games, five of which have been three and outs.
- S Sanoussi Kane led the team in tackles with six after having the second most tackles last game against Wisconsin.
- Purdue logged three sacks and seven tackles for loss on the day. It is the fifth game this season the Boilermakers have put up five or more tackles for loss.
- It is also the fourth game with at least three sacks this season.
- DE Jack Sullivan put up a sack and two tackles for loss to make it three straight games with a sack for the redshirt senior.
- Lawrence Johnson (1.5) and Khordae Sydnor (0.5) both added to their sack totals.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- P Jack Ansell punted six times for a total of 217 yards, putting three inside the 20 with a long of 59.
- K Mitchell Fineran made his only field goal attempt, a 34 yarder against the wind.
