BOILER NOTES

TEAM

- Captains: Devin Mockobee, Gus Hartwig, Kydran Jenkins, Dillon Thieneman.
- Purdue won the toss and deferred. Penn State received the first-half kick. Purdue kicked to the north end zone.
- Purdue finished its home schedule with an average attendance of 59,887. That marked the highest average home attendance for a season since 2005 (62,996).

OFFENSE

- Devin Mockobee moved up to 10th in career program history in rushing yards (2,431), 11th in rushing attempts (471) and 17th in all-purpose yards (3,046). He finished Saturday with 11 rushes for 40 yards.
- Max Klare finished with a season-high seven catches for 91 yards and a touchdown. He has led the Boilermakers in receiving seven times this season.
- In his career, Klare has two games of at least seven catches and two games with at least 90 yards. This is his first time with at least seven catches and 90 yards in the same game.
- Klare is the fifth Boilermaker tight end with multiple games over 90 yards receiving since 2000. He is the 12th Purdue tight end with three or more touchdowns in a season since 1969.
- Jahmal Edrine had a 30-yard reception - the second of at least 30 yards in his career.
- Purdue had two scoring drives of at least 70 yards and now has 14 of at least 70 yards this season. A 12-play, 71-yard drive (22-yard field goal) is tied for the second-most plays on a scoring drive this season.
- On Senior Day, senior quarterback Christian Gelov appeared in his first game as a Boilermaker. Coming in for the final drive, Gelov marched Purdue 43 yards down the field in six plays before the game ended.
- Gelov completed a 26-yard pass to Shamar Rigby for his first career completion, while adding a 12-yard run on his first career carry.

DEFENSE

- Hudson Miller set a new career high with six tackles. His previous career high was five, and he recorded all six tackles in the first half on Saturday.
- Dillon Thieneman led Purdue in tackles (eight) for the sixth time this season thir including the third consecutive game. He has led the Boilermakers in tackles in 14 of his 22 career games.
- Kydran Jenkins recorded 1.5 tackles-for-loss and improved his 12th-ranked career program mark to 41.5. He is 0.5 shy of tying Ken Loushin (1976-79) for 11th.
- Joseph Jefferson's fourth-quarter tackle-for-loss was the second of his career.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Keelan Crimmins pinned Penn State at the seven-yard line on a punt in the first quarter. It was his 12th punt inside the 20 this season.
- Crimmins matched his second-longest punt of the season with a 58-yarder in the first quarter.
- Ben Freehill converted a 22-yard field goal in the second quarter for his first of the season. It was the seventh conversion of his career (six made in 2023).
