THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue wraps a brief two-game homestand with a Friday night battle against Valparaiso at Mackey Arena. Tip time is scheduled for 7:03 p.m. ET, on the Big Ten Network with **Wayne Randazzo** and **Ben Brust** on the call remotely.
- Purdue is coming off a dominating 93-50 win over Oakland on Tuesday afternoon after the Boilermakers shot 55.0 percent from the field, made 17 3-pointers, outrebounded Oakland by 19 rebounds and had 27 assists on 33 made field goals. Purdue is aiming for its sixth straight non-conference home win, spanning over a full calendar year.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- Purdue has started at least 2-1 in 14 of the 16 seasons that Matt Painter has been in charge of the Boilermakers (2012-13, 2019-20).
- Purdue ranks eighth nationally in 3-point percentage (.493) and 14th in 3-pointers per game (11.7). According to KenPom.com, Purdue is 12th nationally in offensive efficiency (110.3).
- The Boilermakers have dominant rebounders on the both ends of the floor. **Trevion Williams** ranks second nationally in defensive rebounding percentage (.464), while **Zach Edey** is fourth nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (.271).
- Purdue has won 11 straight games against Valparaiso, tied for the longest active winning streak against a single opponent. Valpo's last win over Purdue came on Dec. 22, 1965.
- Purdue has had nine players make at least one 3-pointer this year. The school record for most players to make a 3-pointer in a season is 11 set three times (2013-14, 2009-10, 1997-98).
- Opponents have made more free throws (35) than Purdue has attempted (33). Purdue has had 11 free throw attempts in each of the first three games of the season, making 19-of-22 (.864) from the stripe over the last two games.
- Purdue is outscoring its opponents 35-13 in second-chance points and 83-50 off the bench.
- Zach Edey** (16.3 PPG) and **Brandon Newman** (15.3 PPG) rank first and second among Big Ten freshmen in scoring average. **Jaden Ivey** is 6th.
- Purdue is 43-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- Purdue is looking for its 300th non-conference win all-time at Mackey Arena (299-38; .887 winning percentage).
- In its two wins this year, Purdue is shooting 56.6 percent from the field and 52.0 percent from long distance.
- Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

• Friday's contest marks the 17th meeting between Purdue and Valparaiso with the Boilermakers owning a 16-1 advantage. Purdue hasn't lost to the Crusaders in over 50 years (Dec. 22, 1965) and the .941 winning percentage is Purdue's best against a single opponent with a minimum of 10 games played. • Purdue has won 11 straight games against Valparaiso with nine of the wins coming by at least 14 points. The 11-game winning streak is Purdue's longest active win streak against an opponent (tied with Detroit). • Friday's game will be the 400th all-time for Purdue against schools from the state of Indiana (255-144).

- Zach Edey's story is pretty impressive and when you consider what he did in the first week of the season, the story gets even better.
- He's played basketball for about three years after playing hockey and baseball in Canada and spending last year at powerhouse IMG Academy in Florida, averaging about five points per game.
- He was ranked No. 429 among high school seniors a year ago and the 94th-ranked center in America.
- Edey's 19 points in the season opener was the third most for a true freshman in the season opener in school history.

- **Record at Purdue:** 339-175 (.660) / 16th year | **Career Record:** 364-180 (.669) / 17th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
 - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
 - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
 - Painter enters the 2020-21 season third on the school's all-time wins list (337) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
 - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 15 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 14 seasons.
 - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 16 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
 - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
 - Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
 - Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
 - Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
 - Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 12 years are the ninth most nationally.
 - Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2021 - Painter is 50 years old).
 - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 13 years.
