

THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball team returns home for the final time in the 2020 calendar year, hosting Maryland on Christmas Day. The Boilermakers have won all four of their home games this season and look to end 2020 on a high note.
- The contest with the Terrapins is in the middle of a grueling stretch for the Boilermakers. Purdue is in the midst of a six-game stretch that featured No. 20-ranked Ohio State, Notre Dame, No. 4-ranked Iowa, Maryland, No. 11-ranked Rutgers and No. 18-ranked Illinois. Of Purdue's first eight league games, five are against nationally-ranked teams (four on the road) and another road game against arch-rival Indiana.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue is looking for its fifth straight home win and 50th win over Big Ten teams since start of the 2014-15 season (league-best 49-9 record). 2) Head coach Matt Painter won his 50th game against a nationally-ranked team last Wednesday against Ohio State. He is 50-83 against ranked teams, including a 20-20 record since the start of the 2016-17 season. Of his 50 wins against ranked teams, 20 have come in the last 4+ seasons.
- 3) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 308th in experience (1.09 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.29). 4) In its six wins, Purdue is shooting 50.1 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.51 (118 / 78). In its three losses, Purdue is shooting just 39.8 percent from the field, has attempted 24 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.78 (39 / 50).
- 5) Purdue's junior class is averaging 37.9 points per game, accounting for 52.3 percent of the team's scoring. Over the last four games, the class has accounted for 66.9 percent of Purdue's scoring (190 points / 290 team points).
- 6) Trevion Williams is averaging 18.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game over the last four games, shooting 33-of-56 (.589) from the field.
- 7) Mason Gillis was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week (9.0 PPG, 4.5 RPG, 7-7 FGs, 2-2 3Ps, 2-2 FTs) for his role vs. Ohio State and Notre Dame.
- 8) In the first four weeks of the season, Purdue has had two different players earn Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors (Nov. 30 Zach Edey). It marks just the second time ever that Purdue has had two different players earn FOW honors (2012-13; Rapheal Davis, A.J. Hammons).
- 9) Purdue has shot 11 or fewer free throws in five of its nine games this season.
- 10) Purdue is 33-8 (.805) in the month of December since the 2015-16 season.
- 11) Purdue is 44-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- 12) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).

- Five of the nine games between the two teams have been decided by 7 or fewer points, and just two games have been decided by double-digits.
- -The Christmas Day game marks the first time that Purdue has ever played on Christmas Day. The Boilermaker players were asked in October if they would be interested in playing on Christmas Day and the answer was overwhelmingly in favor of the idea.
- There are just two calendar dates in the blueprint of the college basketball schedule that Purdue has not played on – Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

- With the win over Notre Dame, Purdue is now 16-2 (losses to Notre Dame 6 Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Purdue has shot at least 55.0 percent from the field in three games already this year; last season, it shot 55.0 percent just twice all season
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has had 22 games of 14 or more 3-pointers, second among all power-6 schools (Villanova - 34).
 Among Big Ten teams, Michigan is next with 14.
- Purdue's three free throw attempts against Iowa tied for the second fewest in a game in school history (2 vs. Indiana Jan. 27, 2004).

- Sasha Stefanovic is one of two players in America to have at least 28 assists and 28 made 3-pointers so far this year

- The "4" position was a question mark entering the season, but Aaron Wheeler and Mason Gillis have combined to average 11.1 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while splitting time there (48.8 field goal pct.). In the last two games, the duo has averaged 13.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.
- Brandon Newman is one of two Big Ten freshmen (Illinois' Andre Curbelo) to average 9.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game.
- Purdue has 25 dunks this season in just nine games (2.89 per game). Last year, in 31 games, it finished with 45 dunks (1.45 per game).
- Purdue is 114-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 156-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
 One of the losses came to Miami last Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. Conversely, the Boilermakers are 12-55 when scoring 59 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 36-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game. Under Painter, Purdue is 81-17 overall, having won six straight games.
- Purdue has won 102 straight games and is 40-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 12.086 days.

 Purdue is 125-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 39-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season. Purdue has won 17 straight games when scoring 80 or more points.

► Purdue is unranked in a preseason poll for the first time since 2014-15.

➤ The 5 straight years being ranked in preseason was longest in Purdue history.

- Purdue is 130-13 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game, having won nine straight games.
- Purdue is 160-16 under Painter when shooting at least 48 percent from the field. Since the start of the 2017-18 season, Purdue is 45-1 when doing so, losing to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight. Purdue has won 11 straight games when shooting at least 48 percent from the field.
- Purdue has won 11 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.
- Among Power-6 (Big Ten, ACC, SEC, PAC-12, Big East, Big 12) programs, Purdue has the fifth-best home winning percentage since the start of the 2014-15 season.

- Purdue is among the cream of the crop in the Big Ten, posting the Big Ten's second-best record over the last six-plus years (Michigan State 81-32; Purdue 79-35; Wisconsin 76-37; Maryland 72-41).
- The Boilermakers will have 10 underclassmen (sophomore or younger), will have the fewest amount of upperclassmen (5) in the Big Ten and will be the only league team to have fewer than two seniors on its roster, sporting a grand total of ZERO seniors on its roster. The only high-major programs with zero seniors on its rosters are Auburn and Florida.
- Purdue is the only Big Ten school and one of four schools nationally (Kansas, Duke, Gonzaga) to rank in KenPom.com's final top 25 in each of the last five years.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 28 of Purdue's 130 wins have come by 30 or more points, the third-highest total nationally (Gonzaga -52; Duke - 30; Purdue - 28).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 45 of Purdue's 130 wins have come by 20 or more points, the fifth-most nationally (Gonzaga - 86; Duke - 55; Villanova - 53; Purdue 6 Michigan State - 52).
- With the addition of freshman Zach Edey to the roster, Purdue has had a 7-footer on the roster for nine straight years. If Edey stays all four years, that streak will extend to 12 years.
- Florida State is the only program in America to have a longer 7-footer streak, as this will mark the 14th straight year with a 7-footer for the Seminoles.
- Purdue has had a player that stands 7-foot, 2-inches or taller on its roster for a nation's-best seven straight years, including this season.
