ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

Purdue and Texas A&M have played eachother four times in their histories, each taking one win apiece. In the first matchup, and in the latest, the Boilermakers took the win, both in neutral site matchups. When it comes to the Aggies playing in College Station, they took both home wins in 2013 on back-to-back days. The matchup in February will mark the fifth ever game, and the third in College Station as the Boilers look for their first away victory.

2025 GAMES RECAP

The Aggies struck first, coming in the bottom of the first inning, scoring three runs on three hits. In the bottom of the second inning, Klochack came to the mound to relieve the starter, Bailey, but not before the Aggies added on two more. Freshman Camper then made her debut on the mound and finished out the inning, earning a fly out and her first collegiate strikeout. In the bottom of the third, the Aggies increased the lead to a commanding 10-0, but the Boilers fought back in the top of the fourth. Polar began the offense with the first Purdue hit of the game, a triple to left field, before a sac-fly from Alivia Meeks scored her from third. Julia Gossett added another single before closing out the fourth. Delaney Reefe earned her first hit as a Boilermaker in the top of the fifth, with an infield single to third. A fielder's choice from Kylie Franks exchanged runners, before a double to right field from Jordyn Ramos added another run to the board. Yet, Texas A&M was able to earn the final out to close out the game 10-2. In the second game, the Aggies won 11-0.

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

Purdue and Villanova have met four times in program history, with the Boilermakers going 4-0. The first meeting was 21 years ago, back in 2004, while the most recent meeting was in 2008. The Wildcats and the Boilermakers have only ever played at neutral sites, which three of the locations being Clearwater, Fla. The largest margin of victory was 9 runs, when Purdue won 13-4 on March 10, 2006.

2025 GAME RECAP

After three scoreless innings of work for Gossett, including five strikeouts, the Boilermakers broke through in the bottom of the third, scoring three runs. Singles from Banks and an error from Villanova put two runners aboard. Alivia Meeks came up clutch for Purdue, with a timely three-run home run, the first of her career. Gossett and the Boilermakers cruised through two more scoreless innings, until Villanova added two singles in the sixth, which broke up the perfect game for Gossett. The Wildcats eventually plated four runs in the inning, due to a grand slam after a Purdue pitching change. Purdue answered back in a big way in the bottom of the inning. Back-to-backto-back singles from Jordyn Ramos, Banks, and Polar plated the tying run, before a double from Gossett scored two more. On a combination of a single from Ryen Ross and an error from Villanova, the Boilers plated the seventh run. Villanova scored one in the top of the seventh, but the Boilers hung on to earn their first victory of the year, with Kendall Klochack earning the win on the mound.

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

The Boilermakers and the Bears have met seven times in their histories, with Baylor taking the commanding 6-1 lead. Their first meeting was in 2000, which was merely months before the hiring of long-time Baylor head coach, Glen Moore in June 2000. The Boilers and Bears have never met in West Lafavette, with four games at home in Waco, and three neutral site matchups.

2025 GAME RECAP

After a scoreless first inning on both sides, the Boilermakers got on the board first, beginning with a triple from Ramos. Sage Scarmardo put Purdue on top with a sacrifice fly to deep left field.

In the bottom of the second inning, the Bears fought back, hitting a solo shot to even the game at one apiece, before adding on five runs to take the 6-1 lead. Camper came in the bottom of the second, to relieve the starter, Elish, and finished out the game scoreless, but the Boilers were unable to make up the early

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

The meeting of Abilene Christian and Purdue in February will mark the first-ever meeting between the two programs. Second-year head coach, Maggie Frezzotti, will face off against first-year head coach, Jo Koons.

2025 SERIES RECAP

Purdue stepped on the gas in the bottom of the first, and continued to steadily score throughout the game. Banks led off the game with a triple, followed by a walk from Polar. which put two in scoring position, for a single from Bailey that scored both. Ramos then added onto the lead with a double to right field, which brought in Bailey. Ramos helped her cause with a steal of third, before she was knocked in by Sage Scarmardo, which extended the lead to four after. the first. After three quick outs from Elish on the mound in the second, the Boilermakers got back to work, plating two runs in the inning. A walk from Banks and a single from Polar, once again had two runners in scoring position, before a sac-fly in foul territory from Bailey scored Banks on the tag. When Ramos reached on a fielding error by ACU, Polar came across to bring the lead out to 6-0 after two innings. In the third, Elish earned three straight groundouts to bring Purdue back to the plate. Kylie Franks led off the inning with a double to left field, before Ashlyn Campbell reached on an error, moving Franks to third. Polar added two RBI to her day with a single to score both runners. Bailey's second hit of the day was a single to right, which brought Polar around. Bailey made her way back home on another error from ACU, while Ramos added one more to the tally with a single down the third base line.

2025 SERIES RECAP

The Aggies got on the board first, scoring two in the first inning, after a double and a triple. Camper then worked a fly out before Kendall Klochack took the mound for the Boilers.

In the top of the third inning, Delaney Reefe reached on an error before back-to-back bunt singles from Kylie Franks and Ashlynn Campbell. The bases were then loaded for Khloe Banks, who knocked in a run on a fielder's choice. With some smart base running, Banks stole second while pinch runner Maura Condon scored to tie the game at two. Moriah Polar then singled to right field, scoring Banks from second. Klochack continued to shine for Purdue, tossing 4.2 scoreless innings, retiring all 13 batters she faced. In the bottom of the seventh. Julia Gossett came to the mound for the Boilers, but after a double and a triple, Utah State tied the game up at three apiece. In the top of the eighth, the Boilers went down in order. In the bottom of the inning, Utah State loaded the bases and walked it off with an eventual single.

2025 SERIES RECAP

In the first game of the series, the Boilermakers began scoring in the top of the first inning, and continued to score throughout the game. The offense was led by Khloe Banks who was 3-for-5 in the first game. The Boilermakers tacked on seven runs in the top of the seventh inning in order to seal the victory over Dartmouth.

In game two, the Boilermakers plated four runs in the bottom of the furst, and added another run in the bottom of the second. Purdue continued the scoring with three runs in the bottom of the fourth to make the lead 8-1, but Dartmouth came fighting back in the game, plating six runs over the fifth and sixth. The Boilermakers added one final insurance run in the seventh and secured the victory in the bottom of the inning.

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

Purdue and NC State have played one another in four games prior to 2025, with the series being tied at two apiece. The Wolfpack took the first meeting and the most recent meeting, while the Boilermakers took the two in between. This is the first time the teams will face off under two new head coaches.

2025 GAME RECAP

In game one of the two games against NC State, the Boilers fell to the Wowlfpack 7-3. The Wolfpack started the game hot, taking the lead in the top of the first and adding another two runs in the top of the second. Purdue fought back with a two-run triple from Moriah Polar followed by an RBI double from Kyndall Bailey. In the fifth. NC State added three more runs and Purdue could not overcome the deficit.

In the rematch against NC State, the Boilers struck first, with one run in the first inning before exploding for four runs in the bottom of the third. In the bottom of the fifth, Alivia Meeks blasted a two run homer to bring the runs up to seven, while Madi Elish shut down the Wolfpack on the mound to earn her second-career shutout.

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

The Boilermakers have faced Louisville ten times, taking only two victories. The most recent victory was back in 2009 in Louisville, Kentucky. The Boilermakers are looking for their first win in over 16 years.

2025 GAME RECAP

The Boilermakers started the game hot, scoring three runs in the first. Polar got aboard for the Boilers on a bunt single, and plated the first run on a double from Julia Gossett. Sage Scarmardo followed up Gossett's double with a single of her own, before Jordyn Ramos brought both around on a two-RBI single. Elish threw a scoreless frame in the bottom of the first, but Louisville scored one run in the bottom of the second, and one run in the third to make it 3-2. In the fourth, Purdue tacked on four runs beginning with back-toback singles from Delaney Reefe and Aslynn Campbell. A walk to Khloe Banks loaded the bases before Polar drove in two with a single to right center. Kyndall Bailey added one to the lead on a fielder's choice before Polar scored on a passed ball to increase the lead to 7-2. In the top of the seventh, the Boilers continued the run support after a walk from Ramos, who eventually came around to score on a passed ball. The Boilers scored their final run of the day on a bunt single from Polar. In the bottom of the inning, the Cardinals plated one more run and made some noise, but Purdue was able to close out the inning with the six-run win. Elish went the distance for the Boilers going seven full, and surrendering just one earned run.

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

Purdue and Belmont have played in two games, where the Boilermakers took both victories. In the first meeting, Purdue pitchers Sheryl Scheve and Jaime Martino combined for a non-traditional no hitter. The Boilermakers also had 18 hits inthe game, which was a school record.

2025 GAME RECAP

Purdue and Belmont battled out a pitcher's duel for six innings before the Boilermakers fell in the eighth inning. In the first inning, both teams earned a single, before both also hit into a double play. The second inning was quiet on both sides, with each team going down in order. Elish surrendered a double in the third inning, but quickly worked out of the jam. In the bottom of the inning, Ashlynn Campbell singled to centerfield, but the Boilers failed to bring her around. The fourth and fifth innings did not see action on either side, while Belmont earned a lone single in the sixth, but couldn't keep the momentum going. In the top of the seventh, a Belmont infield single, turned into a runner at second due to an error, which brought Kendall Klochack to relieve Elish on the mound. Klochack worked out of the inning with back-to-back fly outs. The eighth inning began with a runner placed on base due to the international tie breaker rule. Two hits from Belmont turned into two runs to plate the first in the game. In the last effort for the Boilers, they were unable to get the spark going and fell 2-0.

The meeting in Birmingham will represent the first time that these two teams will meet in their histories. UAB also boasts a second-year head coach beside the Boilermakers.

2025 GAME RECAP

Both Purdue and UAB had both gone down quickly in the first inning, with just one single between the two. In the top of the second, Purdue got on the board first after singles from Gossett, Reefe, and an RBI single from Kylie Franks to take the 1-0 lead. UAB quickly evened the gap in the bottom of the inning on a solo shot to left center. The Boilers took the lead back in the top of the third after back-to-back bunt singles from Polar and K. Bailey. Sage Scarmardo earned an RBI in the game on an infield single and Reefe picked up her first RBI in the game on a bases-loaded walk. The bottom of the third saw a pitching change for the Boilers, bringing Kadyn Camper to the mound. The Blazers made the adjustment, plating two runs in the inning. Purdue responded in the top of the fifth, as Jordyn Ramos sent out a solo shot, the first of the year and the second of her career. The back-and-forth battle continued in the fifth as UAB tied up the game again on three hits. The sixth and seventh saw zeroes for both teams as Elish made her second relief appearance of the day which allowed Purdue to continue on to extra innings. Purdue broke the game open in the top of the eighth, plating five runs on four hits. Banks was the first on base, with a bunt single before a double to center from Polar put runners on first and third. The Birmingham native, K. Bailey then came up clutch, with an RBI single to score Banks. A play later, Polar scored on a wild pitch to put Purdue ahead by two. A walk and a hit by pitch then loaded the bases for Reefe who cleared them with a double to the left field wall which sealed the deal.

2025 GAME RECAP

Khloe Banks started off the game with a bang for the Boilers with a triple to the left center gap. On the next play, Moriah Polar scored Banks from third on a bunt single. Later in the inning, Julia Gossett reached on a throwing error, which earned another run and put Purdue out to a 3-0 lead after the first. In the second and third innings, both teams worked scoreless frames. Gossett worked out of a jam in the second, before taking down UST in order in the third. In the fourth, the Boilers added on two more runs. Alivia Meeks led off the inning with a walk, before Ashlynn Campbell worked her way on base. reaching on an error from USI. Banks then singled up the middle to score Meeks. Banks came around to score on an RBI ground out from Kyndall Bailey to close out the top of the fourth with a five-run lead. As Gossett continued to work in the circle, the Boilers continued to work at the plate. In the top of the fifth, Jordyn Ramos walked, before a single from Gossett had two runners on base. Ramos stole third on USI, and scored on the next play. The Purdue pinch runner for Gossett, Maura Condon, attempted to . steal second which drew the throw to the bag, allowing for Ramos to score and put the Boilers up 6-0. 

ALL-TIME SERIES HISTORY

Purdue and Wisconsin have a long standing history with an overall record of 35-31 against each other. The Boilermakers lead the alltime record, although they fell to Wisconsin in a three game series back in 2023. The Boilermakers 35 wins over Wisconsin is tied for the most wins over a single team in program history.

2025 GAME RECAP

In the top of the first inning, the Boilermakers struck first in Devon Park, plating two runs on a single to centerfield. Magali (Maggie) Frezzotti (pronounced Frez-OH-tee) was named head coach of the Purdue softball team by vice president and director of athletics Mike Bobinski on June 16, 2023. With the announcement, Frezzotti became the fifth head coach in program history after serving as an assistant for the Boilermakers the last two years.

Under Frezzotti's guidance, the Boilermakers have posted two of their strongest defensive efforts to date, including Purdue's second-highest fielding % in program history at .971%.

The Purdue defense has accumulated 3,165 putouts, 1,242 assists and 40 double plays in her two seasons on the Boilermaker staff. The showing includes one of the best marks by a Big Ten defense in the 2023 season, with the team racking up 479 assists, second-most in the league.

Frezzotti's success in player development is seen in an NFCA All-American, two All-Region honorees and a Newcomer of the Year, all since 2019.

Frezzotti came to Purdue from Montana, where she was the assistant softball coach from September 2018 to August 2021. While with the Grizzlies, she was responsible for the development of hitters and catchers, while assisting with infielders. Defensively, Frezzotti oversaw the catcher's defensive skills, leading to improvements in footwork, glove positioning, hopreading and more.

While with Montana, Frezzotti helped the Grizzlies to a program-best 16-3 record at home, a third-place finish in the Big Sky Conference during her inaugural year in 2019 and helped the program to more than 55 wins under her tutelage.

Prior to her time at Montana, Frezzotti's previous coaching stops include Eastern Michigan as an assistant coach, Concordia as a graduate assistant and Michigan. While in Ann Arbor from 2016-2017, Frezzotti was a catchers development consultant, organized camp logistics, official visits and more.

An accomplished player on the world stage, the Argentina native played for the Argentina National Team for 13 years, where she not only served as team captain, but competed in the World Cup in 2015, the Pan American Championships (2005, '06, '13, '17), the Pan American Games (2007, '10) and the World Championships (2010, '12). Frezzotti's success culminated in being named to the All-Tournament team as a catcher at the 2017 Women's Softball Pan American Championship, held in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

Outside of coaching, the Boilermaker founded Lineup Latino, which aimed to help the softball community in Latin America. Frezzotti created a platform to connect the softball community in Latin America with resources in the U.S. and across the world. Its mission is to educate, empower and prepare softball players from Latin America and the Caribbean to become a better version of themselves, on and off the field, for the rest of their lives.

Frezzotti earned a bachelor's degree in physical education from Instituto Numero 1 Dr. Enrique Romero Brest in Buenos Aires, Argentina, in 2012, a master's degree in student personnel administration in higher education from Concordia in 2017 and a master's degree in public administration from Montana in 2020. Frezzotti is joined in West Lafayette by her wife, Haley Frezzotti-Hostetler, whose grandfather is a Purdue graduate.

Frezzotti's first year at the helm coincided with the 30th season of Purdue softball, which played its inaugural game in March of 1994.

ASSISTANT COACH - JORDAN RICHWOOD (2ND SEASON)



Richwood joins the Boilermakers from S2 Breakthrough Softball Facility in Romeoville, Illinois, where she served as pitching coach since 2020. Managing and creating 10-plus pitcher's training programs, she oversaw assessments covering mobility, movement and more while working to analyze and improve pitcher performance. Prior to her time at S2 Breakthrough, she was a member of the Bucknell's coaching staff, where she also oversaw pitching from 2019-2020. Richwood came to the Bison after previously serving as an assistant with the softball teams at Christian Brothers and at Memphis, following a standout playing career with the Tigers. Memphis won 59 games during the two seasons that Richwood was on the staff, including a 37-21 mark in 2018. Richwood primarily developed and coached the Tigers' outfielders, while also working with the pitching staff and managing the team's academic needs. From 2015-18, Richwood served as a graduate assistant coach at Christian Brothers, teaching and coaching the pitching staff. She also oversaw the team's travel plans, academic progress, and directed the program's social media efforts. Richwood also served as a pitching instructor at the Legends Baseball and Softball Facility in Atoka, Tenn. from 2016-18, where she worked with young athletes' mechanics and taught the basics of softball pitching. As an instructor, Richwood emphasized mental preparation and putting athletes in game situations through challenging mental and physical drills. As a player, Richwood appeared in 117 games as a pitcher for the Memphis Tigers from 2012-15, totaling 26 wins, four saves, and 430 strikeouts. In 2012 she was named to the Conference USA All-Freshman team after pitching nine complete games and recording 10-plus strikeouts three times. As a senior, Richwood captured a career-high 11 wins and pitched five shutouts.

ASSISTANT COACH - HEATHER GELBARD (2ND SEASON)



Heather Gelbard was hired by head coach Magali Frezzotti on August 8, 2023. In her role as assistant coach, Gelbard will oversee the Boilermakers' offensive efforts in addition to recruitment. Coming off two years at Georgia Southern where she held a similar role, Gelbard was primarily responsible for overseeing the team's hitting, culminating in the program's most triples since 2017, the most walks since 2019 and the most runs scored in a single conference game since 2015. Prior to her time at Georgia Southern, Gelbard was a volunteer coach at South Carolina for two seasons (2019-2021). During her stint, she worked to develop two All-SEC and NFCA All-Southeast Region selections, an NFCA All-American and two CoSIDA Academic All-Americans with a primary focus on team defense and hitting. A former All-ACC and Academic All-American student-athlete at NC State, Gelbard began her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Barry University (2007-09), where she guided her team to a DII World Series berth in 2008. She was an assistant coach at Florida Atlantic from 2010-16 before being named head coach at UMBC from 2016-18. Gelbard also served as the interim head coach at Florida International (FIU) for a season before joining the Gamecocks staff as a volunteer coach. Gelbard graduated from NC State with a bachelor's degree in psychology in 2007. Currently, she owns multiple Wolfpack records, including hits (261), games started (256), at-bats (834). She earned her master's degree in exercise science with a concentration in sports psychology from Barry in 2009.

ASSISTANT COACH - JORDYN RUDD-LEE (2ND SEASON)



Jordyn Rudd was hired by head coach Magali Frezzotti on August 8, 2023. A four-time All-Big Ten and three-time All-Defensive Team honoree, Rudd played in every game of her collegiate career at Northwestern (2019-2023). Other honors include 2022 Softball America National Defensive Player of the Year, 2022 Johnny Bench Award which is presented to the best female catcher in the nation, and Rawlings Gold Glove Award. As the first catcher in Big Ten history to be named First Team All-Big Ten in her first three seasons, Rudd closed her career with a .332 batting average, 247 hits, 50 doubles and 297 total bases. A catalyst for success, Rudd guided her team to two consecutive NCAA Regional titles, the Big Ten tournament title (2023) and two straight Big Ten regular-season crowns during her career at Northwestern.

DIRECTOR OF PLAYER DEVELOPMENT - KATE CLAYPOOL (1ST SEASON)



Purdue softball head coach Magali Frezzotti hired alumna Kate Claypool (Purdue Softball 2023-24) as the first-ever director of player development for the program in July 2024. In her role, Claypool will assist players in personal and athletic growth, working closely with both the coaching staff and student-athletes on individual development. Additionally, she will help the coaching staff assess, understand and predict performances both for current and future players and contribute to scouting reports and game plans. Claypool, who graduated from Purdue in May 2024 with a Master's degree in Business Analytics, played for the Boilermakers from 2023-24 after transferring from Iowa, where she earned an undergraduate degree in Mathematics and Statistics. Involved with student-athlete advisory committees throughout her collegiate career, Claypool joins the staff with a key understanding of what student-athletes are facing and has experience providing solutions for challenges they are facing. In addition, she worked for the compliance department at Purdue, focusing her efforts on analyzing NIL data to find the most successful avenues for student-athletes.

2025 GAME NOTES

On a six-game winning streak, the Boilers head to Columbus to take on the No. 22 Buckeyes of Ohio State. Game one of the three-game series is slated for 6:00 p.m. on Friday, Apr. 25. Purdue's Julia Gossett was also named the Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the week after her outstanding performance in the series against Illinois, as well as the midweek game against IU Indy, as announced by the conference on Monday. The Boilers are making some noise of their own, earning the No. 51 spot on the latest NCAA RPI rankings. Ohio State comes into the series ranked No. 22 nationally, with a 38-10-1 record so far in 2025. The Buckeyes have taken their last two series over Michigan and Penn State, as well as earning midweek wins over Dayton and Ohio. The Buckeyes are led by Jasmyn Burns who is batting .496 with 67 hits with a 1.104 SLG%. On the mound, Lorin Boutte has taken most of the innings with 113.1, followed by Kennedy Kay at 82.2 Ohio State and Purdue has faced one another in 51 games dating back to 1995. The Boilermakers first faced the Buckeyes on Apr. 15, 1995, where they took the 6-3 victory. Most recently in 2023, Ohio State also defeated Purdue, this time in shutout fashion.


