#### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Purdue officially begins its 125th season of competition when it hosts Milwaukee at Mackey Arena on Tuesday, Nov. 8, in its season opener,
- The Boilermakers own an 1,884 1,054 all-time record (.641), ranking tied for 11th with Arizona on the all-time NCAA basketball wins list. The 64.1 winning percentage is tied for 14th all-time.
- · Purdue begins the season in search of its 25th Big Ten Championship, having won two of the last six regular-season titles (2017, 2019). The Boilermakers are the all-time leader in Big Ten regular-season championships, two ahead of rival Indiana (22).
- Purdue improved to 28-0 under Matt Painter in exhibition games with a 102-57 win over Truman State in front of a sold-out crowd of 14,876 at Mackey Arena last Wednesday. Purdue has won the 28 games by an average of 26.3 points per game.
- The 45-point victory was the largest margin in an exhibition game since Nov. 8, 2015, vs. Northwestern Ohio (92-43; 49 points).
- · Purdue's 102 points were the most in an exhibition game since Nov. 3, 2012, a 109-68 victory over Newberry, a span of 13 games. It marked just the second 100-point game in an exhibition game under Painter.
- The Boilermakers averaged 1.55 points per possession, including 1.58 in the second half.
- · Purdue recorded 28 assists against just four turnovers. The Boilermakers had 28 assists on 40 made field goals. Purdue had six players with at least three assists, led by **Fletcher Loyer's** six. The four turnovers were also the fewest in an exhibition game under Painter.
- Purdue's bench scored 62 of the team's 102 points. The group went 25-of-40 (.625) from the field and had just one turnover, coming on a defensive rebound that was lost out-of-bounds.
- The Boilermakers were 30-of-43 (.698) from inside the 3-point line.
- Five players were in double figures in the win over Truman State (Edey 23; Kaufman-Renn 15; Newman 13; Jenkins Jr. 12; Furst 11).
- Purdue had two "true" freshmen start the exhibition game for the first time since the 2007-08 season (Hummel, Moore, Johnson).
- Purdue returns just 38.4 percent of its scoring and 71 starts from the previous season. The last time Purdue returned under 40.0 percent of its scoring and that few starts from the previous season came in 2018-19 - a year Purdue won the Big Ten title and reached the Elite Eight.
- Matt Painter needs 16 overall victories to become the fifth coach in Big Ten history with 400 victories while at a conference school (Bob Knight, Tom Izzo, Gene Keady, Lou Henson).
- · Purdue has had an All-American in four of the last six seasons (Caleb Swanigan 2017; Carsen Edwards 2018, 2019; Jaden Ivey 2022). Zach Edey is a preseason All-American by almost every publication out there. Only Kansas (4), Gonzaga (3) and Duke (3) have had more firstteam All-America honors than Purdue's two in that span (Swanigan, Ivey).
- · Purdue's six first-team All-Big Ten selections since the 2015-16 season are the most in the Big Ten. Purdue's 10 total All-Big Ten honorees are tied for the third most behind Michigan State (13) and Wisconsin (12).
- · Purdue has made seven straight NCAA Tournament appearances, the sixth-longest streak in the country. Purdue has accounted for four of the Big Ten's 11 Sweet 16 apperances since the 2016-17 season.
- Purdue has 10 players this season standing at least 6-6, the most in school history. Purdue's average height of its scholarship players is 6-7 1/4.
- · Purdue enters the season with 41 consecutive sellouts, not including exhibition games. It has announced 15 (of 17) sellouts already this year.
- The new capacity number for Mackey Arena is 14,876 after 72 seats were added during an offseason renovation. The sellout number will become the second-largest crowd(s) in Mackey Arena history after 15,108 fans somehow snuck in on Feb. 4, 2012, against Indiana.

#### **SEASON-OPENER NOTES**

- The Boilermakers open their 125th season of competition Tuesday when Milwaukee visits Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers own a 103-21 (.831) record in season openers, including a 16-1 (.942) mark under Matt Painter.
- Purdue has won nine openers in a row by a combined 254 points (28.2 PPG). Purdue has allowed more than 60 points in a season opener just eight times under Painter.
- Purdue is 39-2 all-time against current members of the Horizon League. The Boilermakers have won 24 straight games against current members and Matt Painter is 17-0 against the league while at Purdue.

#### **MARGINS MATTER**

 Purdue has won by at least 25 points in 12 of Matt Painter's 16 season-opening victories. In each of those previous 12 seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to NCAAs.  Going even further back, in the last 17 occurrences dating to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

#### REACHING THESE LEVELS MEANS A VICTORY

Purdue has won 50 straight games when shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 70.0 percent from the free throw line, last losing to Illinois on March 3, 2004 (81-79; ot).

#### **INSIDE MORE NUMBERS**

- Purdue is 148-19 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 166-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 50-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 21 straight games.
- Purdue is 147-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 61-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season. Purdue has won 39 straight games when scoring 80 or more points (last loss vs. Notre Dame on Dec. 15, 2018).
- Purdue has won 111 straght games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987 – a span of 12,769 days.

#### **SUCCESS VS. THE WINLESS**

 Purdue's opponent in the season opener, Milwaukee, obviously enters the game with a 0-0 record. The Boilermakers are 28-1 against teams that are winless entering the game during the **Matt Painter** era. • Purdue has won 18 straight games against teams with zero victories on the season.

#### **OUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY**

- · Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 21 of the last 42 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Twenty of those 21, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 17 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 11 times (in 17 seasons) under head coach Matt Painter, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

- · With six Sweet 16 appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 18th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to seven straight NCAA Tournaments the sixth-longest active streak in COACHING EXPERIENCE America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in four of the last five tournaments.
