THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 6-ranked Boilermakers ramp up their competition this weekend in the Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-off Classic held at Mohegan Sun Arena. The Boilermakers will face No. 18-ranked North Carolina on Saturday, then either No. 17-ranked Tennessee or No. 5-ranked Villanova in Sunday's contest. Purdue will face back-to-back ranked opponents in non-conference play for the first time since Nov. 2017 (Arizona, Louisville).
- The Boilermakers are 3-0 for the first time since the 2018-19 season, while North Carolina also enters with a 3-0 mark.
- The contest will be televised on ESPNews with **Jon Sciambi** and **Fran Fraschilla** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue will face North Carolina for the first time in almost 22 years, the last meeting being Nov. 24, 1999, in the Maui Invitational. No. 4-ranked North Carolina won that game 90-75 and has won eight straight games in the series, spanning 44 years.
- 2) Purdue has scored 90 or more points in its first three games of the season for the first time in school history. It has also scored at least 50 points in the first half of all three games and shot over 50.0 percent from the field in the three games.
- 3) Purdue has had 14 runs of 7-0 or longer already this season, including 10 runs of 10-0 or longer. Opponents have one run of 10 points.
- 4) Purdue ranks No. 2 nationally in offensive efficiency and No. 18 in defensive efficiency being one of eight teams nationally to rank in the top 20 of both categories (Purdue, Michigan, Houston, Kansas, Duke, Baylor, Gonzaga, UCLA).
- 5) Purdue is looking for its first tournament title since winning the Cancun Challenge in Nov. 2016, placing second in its last three events.
- 6) **Zach Edey** ranks third in the early KenPom Player of the Year standings behind Ohio State's **E.J. Liddell** and Iowa's **Keegan Murray**. Per 40 minutes this season, Edey is averaging 38.4 points and 21.2 rebounds.
- 7) **Trevion Williams** became the 16th player in school history with 1,000 career points and 650 career rebounds, surpassing both milestones against Wright State.
- 8) **Matt Painter** (358) needs six wins to tie **Branch McCracken** for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (364). Since 1980, just two Purdue coaches have won 870 games (**Gene Keady** - 512; **Matt Painter** - 358).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES THREE

• In the win over Wright State, Purdue had three players (**Zach Edey**, **Caleb Furst**, **Trevion Williams**) record double-doubles. It marked the first time since Nov. 21, 1977, that three players recorded double-doubles in the same game (**Walter Jordan**, **Wayne Walls**, **Joe Barry Carroll**). It has now happened 19 times in school history, mostly from an era when they handed out rebounds like candy.

PERFORMING WELL DURING IN-SEASON EVENTS

• Purdue has had a lot of success in regular-season tournaments over the last seven years, but is looking for its first tournament title since the 2016 Cancun Challenge.

• The Boilermakers have finished runner-up in each of the last three regular-season tournaments (Charleston Classic; Emerald Coast Classic; Space Coast Challenge).

• Purdue is 20-6 in regular-season tournaments since the 2014 Maui Invitational (seven events).

• Purdue won the 2015 Hall of Fame Tipoff Tournament with wins over Old Dominion (61-39) and Florida (85-70) in its lone appearance in the tournament.

• Current Director of Player Development **P.J. Thompson** came off the bench to score 15 points with five rebounds, four assists and two steals in the title game against Florida.

• **Eric Hunter Jr.** - 4 assists for 200 in career.

• **Zach Edey** - 1 point for 300 in career.

THE CENTER OF EFFICIENCY

• Purdue's two-headed center monster of **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** is averaging 30.3 points, 19.7 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 3.7 blocked shots per game, in just 37.6 minutes per game.

RIGHT WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

• The talented sophomore class picked up right where they left off last year, averaging 49.7 points per game so far this season after accounting for 46 in the opener against Bellarmine, 59 vs. Indiana State and 44 against Wright State.

• As freshmen last year, the group accounted for 44.5 percent of Purdue's scoring, the fourth-highest percentage in America. In the two victories so far, the group has accounted for 55.9 percent of Purdue's points.

• The class will receive a boost when **Mason Gillis** returns this weekend.

FURST WITH STRONG FURST IMPRESSION

• Freshman **Caleb Furst**, Indiana's Mr. Basketball in 2021, has made a quite a strong FURST impression this season. The Fort Wayne native has had at least eight rebounds in all three games this year and over the last two games, has 26 points and 19 rebounds (9-of-16 FGs) in 47 minutes.

• He ranks third among Big Ten freshmen in scoring (9.3) and first in rebounding (9.3).

• Furst and Milwaukee's Patrick Baldwin Jr., are the only freshmen in America averaging at least 9.0 points and 9.0 rebounds.

INSIDE MORE NUMBERS

• Purdue is 125-15 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.

• Purdue is 161-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.

• Purdue is 131-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 45-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Purdue is 251-50 under Painter when scoring at least 70 points.

• Purdue is 41-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 11 straight games.

• Purdue is 133-14 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.

• Purdue has won 13 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.

• Purdue has won 19 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.

• Purdue has won 10 straight non-conference home games.

QUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY

• Including this season, Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 21 of the last 42 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.

• The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 11 times (in 17 seasons) under head coach **Matt Painter**, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

► **Record at Purdue:** 358-184 (.661) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 383-189 (.670) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
