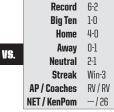

THE OPENING TIP

- The Purdue men's basketball enters Big Ten play on a high note and looks to keep momentum going as it travels to No. 4-ranked Iowa to kick off a grueling stretch for the Boilermakers. Tip is scheduled Tuesday at 9 p.m. ET, on the Big Ten Network from Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Purdue enters one of the most-difficult stretches for any team in college basketball on Tuesday night. Five of Purdue's next seven games are
 on the road against teams ranked Nos. 4, 11, 18 and No. 12 and a team that is receiving votes that is considered a fierce rival. The matchup
 with Iowa on Tuesday marks the highest-ranked opponent for Purdue in a road game since Feb. 10, 2018, at No. 4-ranked Michigan State.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- 1) A win over Iowa would give Purdue its longest winning streak (4) since Feb. 16 to March 2, 2019 (5 games).
- 2) Head coach **Matt Painter** won his 50th game against a nationally-ranked team last Wednesday against Ohio State. He is 50-83 against ranked teams, including a 20-19 record since the start of the 2016-17 season. Of his 50 wins against ranked teams, 20 have come in the last 4+ seasons.
- 3) According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 306th in experience (1.09 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.29).
 4) In its six wins, Purdue is shooting 50.1 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.51 (118 / 78). In its two losses, Purdue is shooting just 39.8 percent from the field, has attempted 21 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.61 (22 / 36).
- 5) Purdue's junior class is averaging 54.3 points per game over the last three contests, accounting for 69.4 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- 6) Trevion Williams is averaging 20.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game over the last three games, shooting 26-of-42 (.619) from the field.
- oj **rrevior winiams** is averaging 20.0 points, 3.0 repounds and 4.0 assists per game over the last three games, snooting 200142 (0.13) from the ne
- 7) Mason Gillis was named the Big Ten's freshman of the week (9.0 PPG, 4.5 RPG, 7-7 FGs, 2-2 3Ps, 2-2 FTs).
- 8) In the first four weeks of the season, Purdue has had two different players earn Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors (Nov. 30 Zach Edey).

 It marks just the second time ever that Purdue has had two different players earn FOW honors (2012-13; Rapheal Davis, A.J. Hammons).

 9) Purdue is 33-7 (.825) in the month of December since the 2015-16 season.
- 10) Purdue is 44-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- 11) Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss; Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).
- 12) Sasha Stefanovic has made at least four 3-pointers 10 times during his career. Purdue is 8-2 when he reaches that mark.
- 13) When Eric Hunter Jr. leads the team in assists during his career, Purdue is 12-3; when Aaron Wheeler scores 10+ points, Purdue is 9-1.

THE IOWA MATCHUP

- Tuesday's contest will be the 169th all-time meeting with the Hawkeyes, with Purdue owning a 92-76 series advantage.
- Purdue has won four straight games against the Hawkeyes and own two straight victories in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, where Iowa holds an 18-14 series lead
- This marks the 11th straight game that either Purdue or Iowa has been nationally-ranked, the longest active streak in a series among any opponent that Purdue has ever played (North Carolina 10).

ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Purdue wrapped up its non-conference play with a victory in the Crossroads Classic on Saturday, an 88-78 decision over Notre Dame.
 The Boilermakers led virtually the entire game and used an efficient offensive attack (14-of-28 from 3; 18-of-37 from 2; 6 turnovers) to turn back the Irish.
- The win was Purdue's third in a row (Indiana State, Ohio State and Notre Dame) and sends the Boilermakers into the teeth of their schedule with some momentum.
- The Boilermakers boast a balanced attack as five players average between 9.1 and 14.3 points per game and already this year, five different players have led the team in scoring through eight games.
- Purdue's junior class has flipped the switch, averaging 54.3 points per game and shooting 52.2 percent over the last three games.

WINNING ON THE ROAD VS. TOP-10 FOES

- Purdue is looking for its first win on the road against a top-5 team since March 6, 1994, a 95-94 win at No. 3-ranked Michigan.
- As an unranked team, Purdue is looking for its first road win against a top-5 team since Jan. 20, 1979, at No. 4-ranked Illinois (69-57).

VANQUISHING RANKED FOES

- With the win over Ohio State last Wednesday, head coach Matt Painter has now won 50 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 50-83 (.376) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 20-19 in such games.
- Purdue is ninth nationally with 20 ranked wins over the last five years.

CONTROLLING THE GLASS

- Purdue has outrebounded every opponent this year and ranks third in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+9.6).
- Purdue has allowed just 57 offensive rebounds (7.1 per game) to turn into 40 second-chance points (5.0 per game).

FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

- Head coach Matt Painter has had a lot of great freshmen come through the ranks, but the performance by this group of freshmen in their first career games may be unmatched.
- The group scored 44 points in the season opener against Liberty, producing the most points for a freshman class at Purdue since March 20, 2013, vs. Western Illinois (46), and the eighth-most points scored by a freshman class under Painter.
- It then followed it up with 44 more points against Oakland, just two games later.

MORE ABOUT THE ROOKIES

- Through seven games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 239 (29.9 PPG) of the team's 597 points (40.0 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in three of Purdue's eight games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami).
- The group has played 627 minutes (39.2 percent).
- The group has shot a combined 91-of-178 (.511) from the field. The remainder of the team is 126-of-279 (.452) from the field.
- The quartet of **Zach Edey** (2nd), **Brandon Newman** (6th), **Jaden Ivey** (11th) and **Mason Gillis** (12th) all rank in the top 12 among Big Ten freshmen in scoring. The duo of Newman (2nd) and Gillis (4th) are among the top four in 3-pointers made. Newman (2nd) and **Ethan Morton** (3rd) are among the top three in assists per game.

THE TREVION WILLIAMS FILE

- Trevion Williams has had a slow start to the season, but if the last three games are any indication, the junior big man is ready to break out again.
- In the win over Indiana State last Saturday, Williams came off the bench to score 30 points, grab 11 rebounds and dish out two assists on 13-of-18 shooting from the field. He is just one of three players nationally to reach those marks this season.

- Williams' 30 points off the bench were the most off the bench in school history. He became the eighth player in school history with a pair of 30-10 games in Purdue history (Terry Dischinger - 24; Dave Schellhase - 19; Glenn Robinson - 12; Joe Barry Carroll - 5; Bob Ford - 3; Russell Cross - 2; Wilson Eison - 2).
- Among current players, Williams' two career 30-point, 10-rebound,
 2-assist games are tied for the most nationally.
- •Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since **Brad Miller** (23, 10 & 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game. So far this year, he is one of seven players nationally to reach those marks.

HUNTER JR., SHOWS HIS WORTH

- After missing the first four games of the season with a knee injury, Eric Hunter Jr., has played very well in his return.
- In Saturday's win over Notre Dame, Hunter Jr., scored 18 points with eight assists, five rebounds and no turnovers and held Notre Dame's leading scorer **Prentiss Hubb** (19.0 PPG) scoreless on seven shots in 38 minutes. Hunter Jr., is one of three players nationally to have 18, 5 and 8 with no turnovers and is the only player to add three steals

Over the last three games (games he started), Purdue is shooting 50.6 percent from the field, 40.6 percent from 3-point range, averaging 19.3 assists per game with an assist / turnover ratio of 1.41 (58 / 41) and putting up 78.3 points per game.

EDEY MAKES INSTANT IMPACT

- · Zach Edey has had a strong start to the season, which is somewhat surprising given his story.
- He's played basketball for about three years after playing hockey and baseball in Canada and spending last year at powerhouse IMG Academy in Florida, averaging about five points per game.
- He was ranked No. 429 among high school seniors a year ago and the 94th-ranked center in America.
- Edey's 19 points in the season opener was the third most for a true freshman in the season opener in school history.

BOILER NOTES

- · Purdue will take a seven-game non-conference home winning streak into next season after posting a 3-0 record this season.
- With the win over Notre Dame, Purdue is now 16-2 (losses to Notre Dame & Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Purdue has shot at least 55.0 percent from the field in three games already this year; last season, it shot 55.0 percent just twice all
- Four of Purdue's five freshmen are shooting at least 44 percent from the field.
- Purdue has trailed for just 16 minutes, 31 seconds out of 160 minutes during the last four games.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has had 22 games of 14 or more 3-pointers, second among all power-6 schools (Villanova - 34). Among Big Ten teams, Michigan is next with 14.
- Purdue has shot 15 or fewer free throws in six of eight games this season (Oakland - 37; Indiana State - 24). Opponents have shot 15 or more free throws in six of eight games this season.
- Sasha Stefanovic is one of three players in America to have at least 25 assists and 25 made 3-pointers so far this year.

- The "4" position was a question mark entering the season, but Aaron Wheeler and Mason Gillis have combined to average 11.0 points, 9.6 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while splitting time there (47.3 field goal pct.). In the win over Notre Dame, the duo combined for 14 points, 16 rebounds and 3 assists.
- Brandon Newman is one of four freshmen nationally to make at shoot at least 43.0 percent from long distance, make 12 3-pointers and average at least 2.0 assists per game.
- Purdue has 24 dunks this season in just eight games (3.00 per game). Last year, in 31 games, it finished with 45 dunks (1.45 per game).

- Purdue is 114-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
