# PURISSIMA HILLS WATER DISTRICT MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## July 10, 2024 Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL Vice President Glassman called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. at the District Office.

- **3. CONSENT CALENDAR** It was moved by Director Holtz, seconded by Director Jordan to approve the consent calendar. Motion approved unanimously voice vote.
- **4. SUPPLY COMMITTEE MEETING** General Manager, Phil Witt, reported on the meeting with the Town of Los Altos Hills. The sensors have been removed from Quarry Lake. The water is still overflowing. There was a meeting with SFPUC to discuss a potential water purchase from Valley Water.
- **5. TIER 2 COMMITTEE MEETING** Director Jordan reported on the presentation from BAWSCA. A Board discussion followed.
- 6. APPROVE SIX TASK ORDERS (24-25-01 THROUGH 24-25-06) WITH PAKPOUR CONSULTING GROUP, INC. IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$125,000 FOR ANNUAL ONGOING SERVICES It was moved by Director Jordan, seconded by Director Holtz to approve the six task orders with Pakpour Consulting Group, Inc. Motion approved unanimously voice vote.
- 7. APPROVE TASK ORDER 24-25-07 WITH PAKPOUR CONSULTING GROUP, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,952 FOR THE DUVAL WAY/ELENA ROAD/PADRE COURT/SETON/JOSEFA LANE WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT It was moved by Director Glassman, seconded by Director Jordan to approve task order 24-25-07 with Pakpour Consulting Group, Inc. Motion approved unanimously voice vote.
- 8. APPROVE TASK ORDER 24-25-08 WITH PAKPOUR CONSULTING GROUP, INC. FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR THE MCCANN OPERATION CENTER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT It was moved by Director Jordan, seconded by Director Holtz to approve task order 24-25-08 with Pakpour Consulting Group, Inc. Motion approved unanimously voice vote.
- 9. APPROVE RESOLUTION 2024-03 FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICE REQUEST NO.2 WITH TEN OVER STUDIOS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000 FOR ADDITIONAL ENTITLEMENT SERVICES FOR THE MCCANN OPERATION CENTER IMPROVEMENTS Staff advised that due to the Town's study session and turnover at the Town, the District has incurred about \$65,000 in additional costs. This item will be brought back for approval at the next Board meeting.

  <u>ROAD WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS</u> District Engineer, Joubin Pakpour, reported that the project is scheduled to start in August.
- **B.** MCCANN OPERATION CENTER DESIGN District Engineer, Joubin Pakpour, reported that the architects are progressing on revisions. Story poles will be installed once those revisions are complete.
- C. <u>WEST FREMONT, ST. FRANCIS WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS</u> District Engineer, Joubin Pakpour, reported that the design is at about 75-80%.
- **D.** ENGINEER'S REPORT CARD District Engineer, Joubin Pakpour, presented the report card and the new billing rates to the Board.

- On 6/25-6/27, Echologics (ePulse Project) tested the wall thickness on the pipes.
- On 6/29, the District had a main leak on Fremont Rd. in the pathway near Campo Vista Ln. It was a full circle crack on the 6" CI, repaired with a clamp.
- On 6/29, the District had a meter flange gasket at 26140 Rancho Manuella Rd blowout.
