

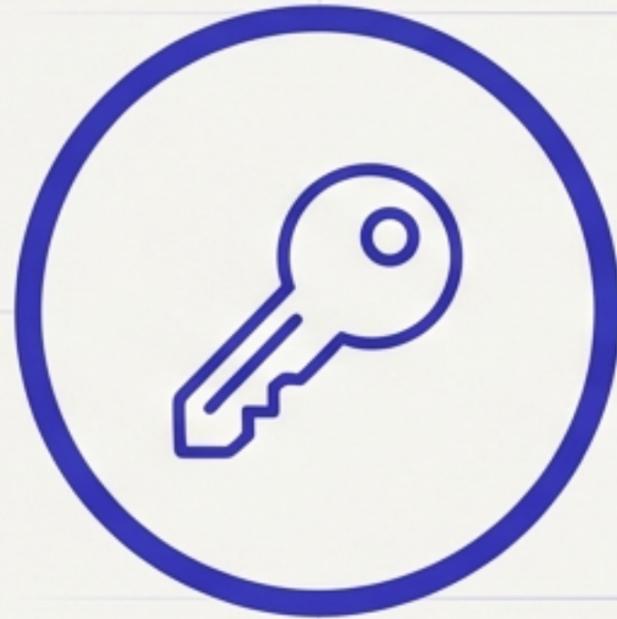

Your First 5 Minutes on the RAD Platform



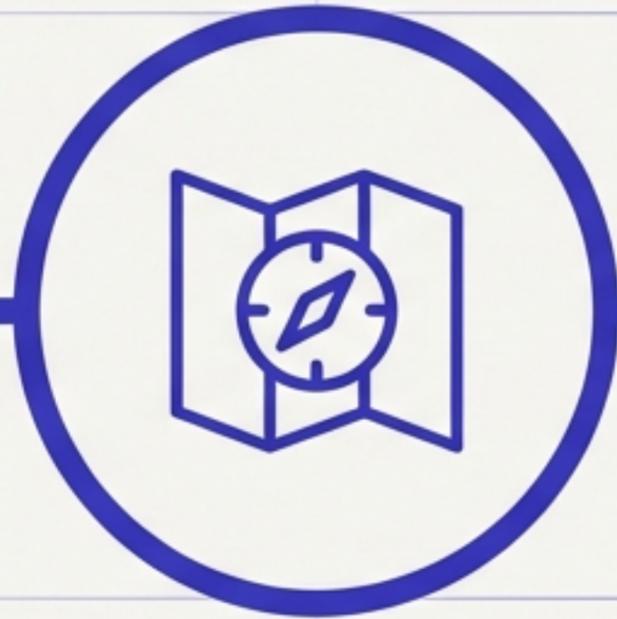
Welcome. This guide will walk you through launching your first live application. Let's begin.

DEPLOY

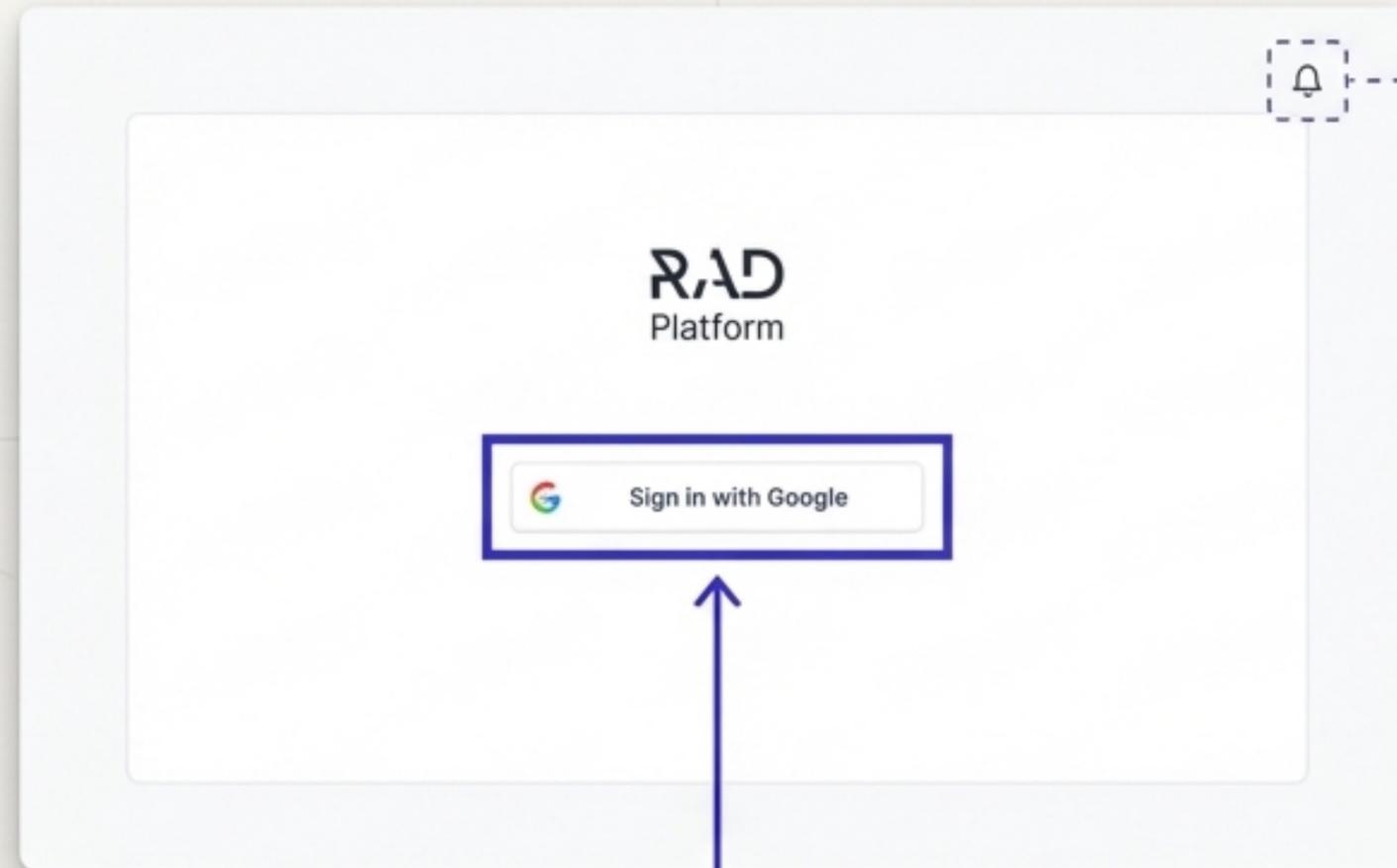
Launch your first application.

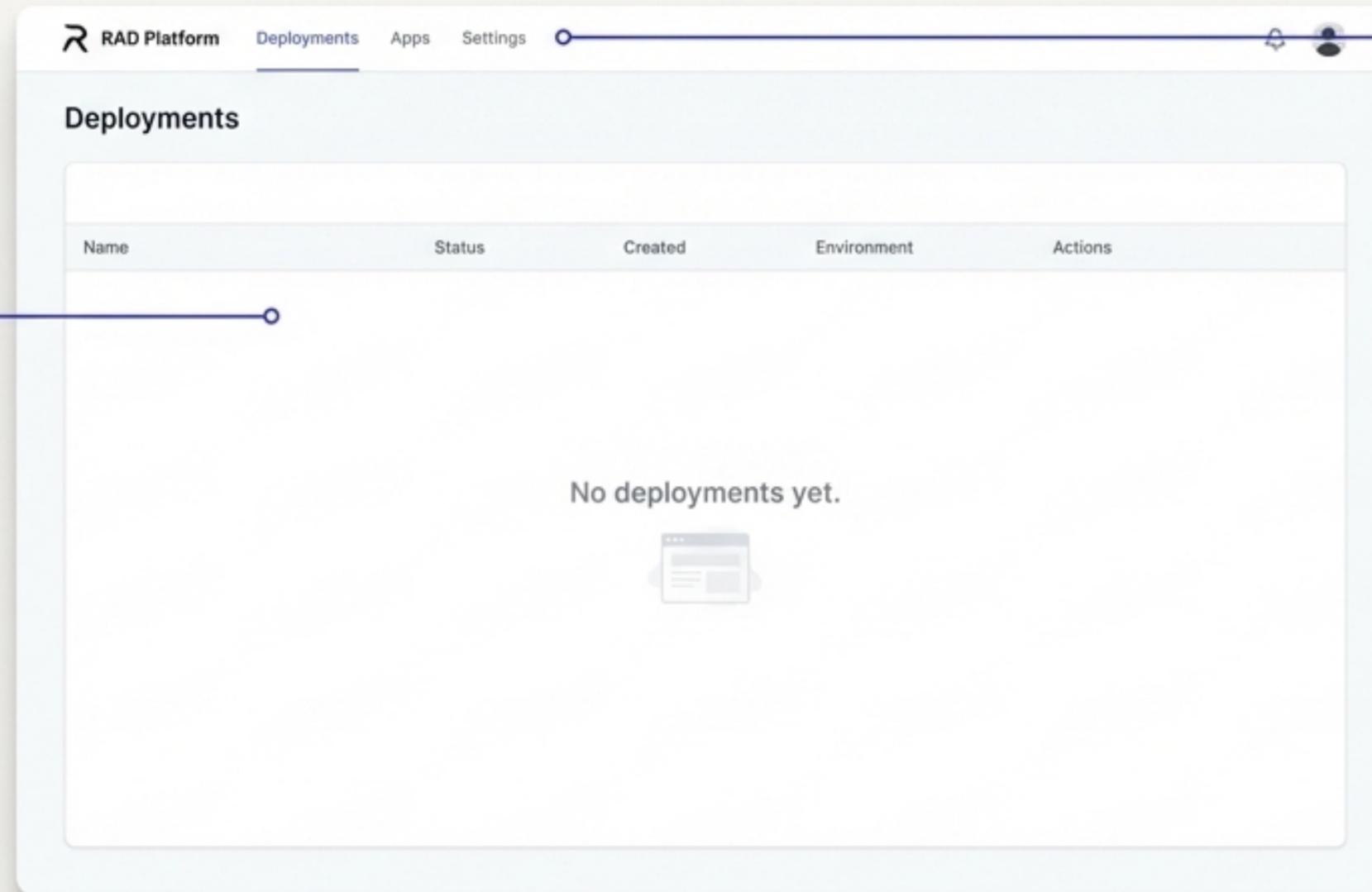

My Deployments

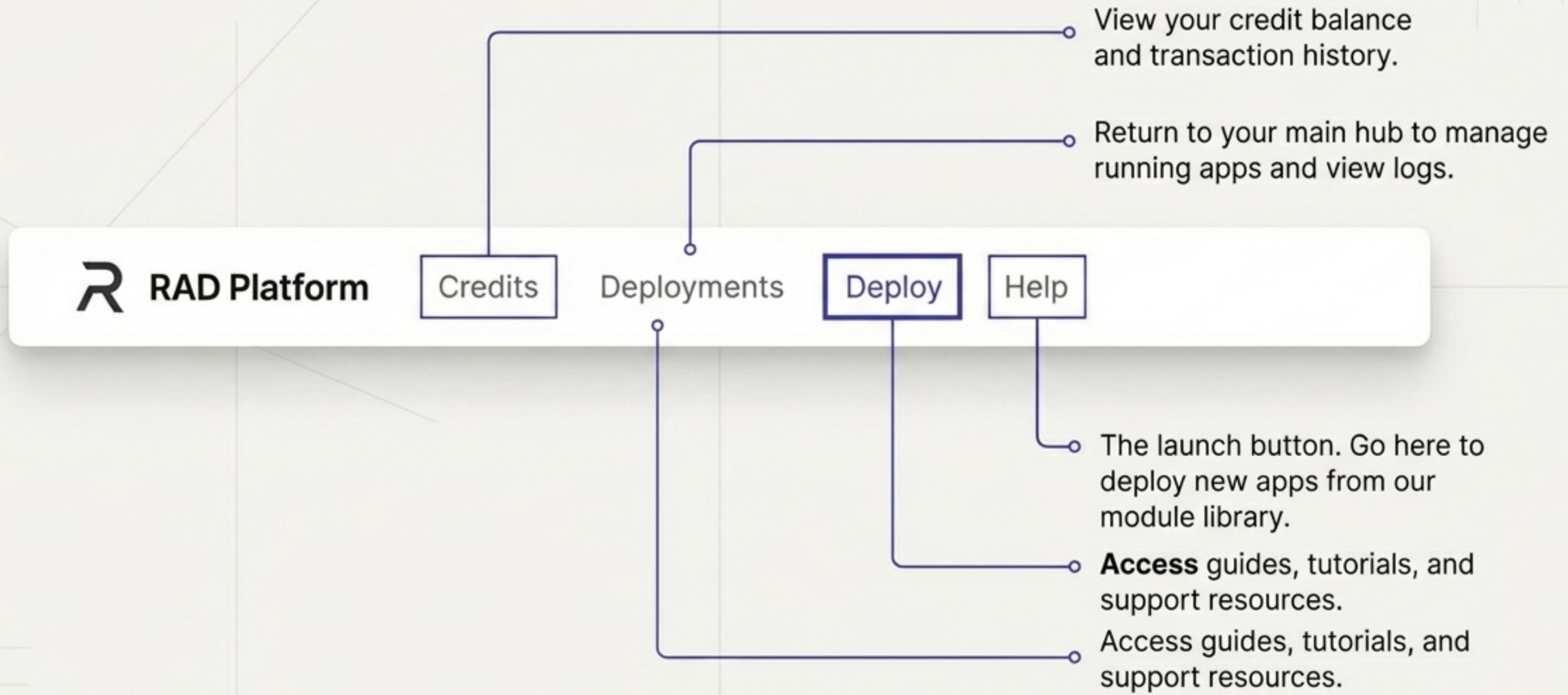
This is where your running applications will appear. It's currently empty, but not for long.



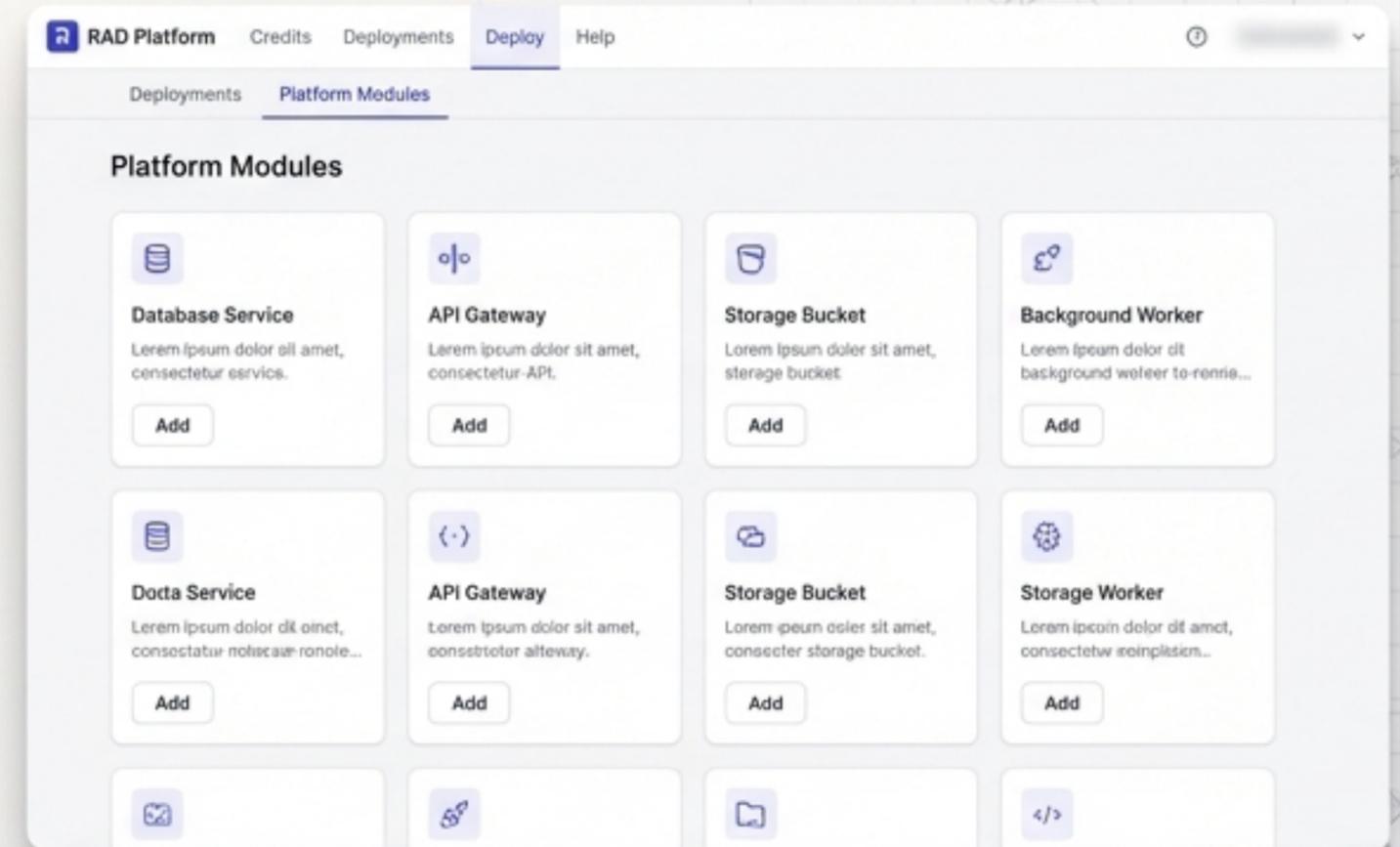
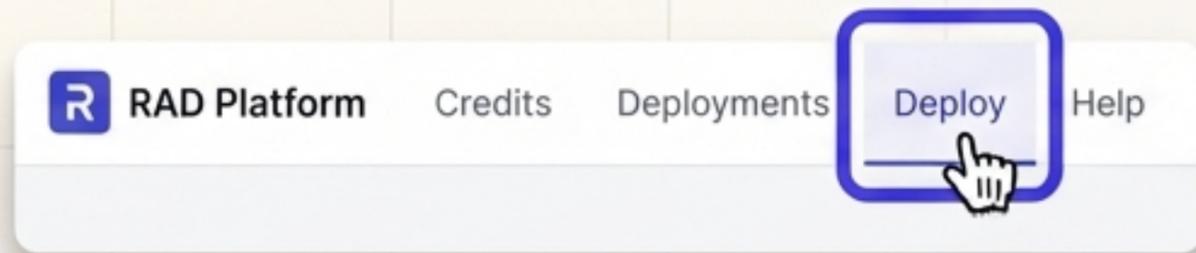
Navigation Bar

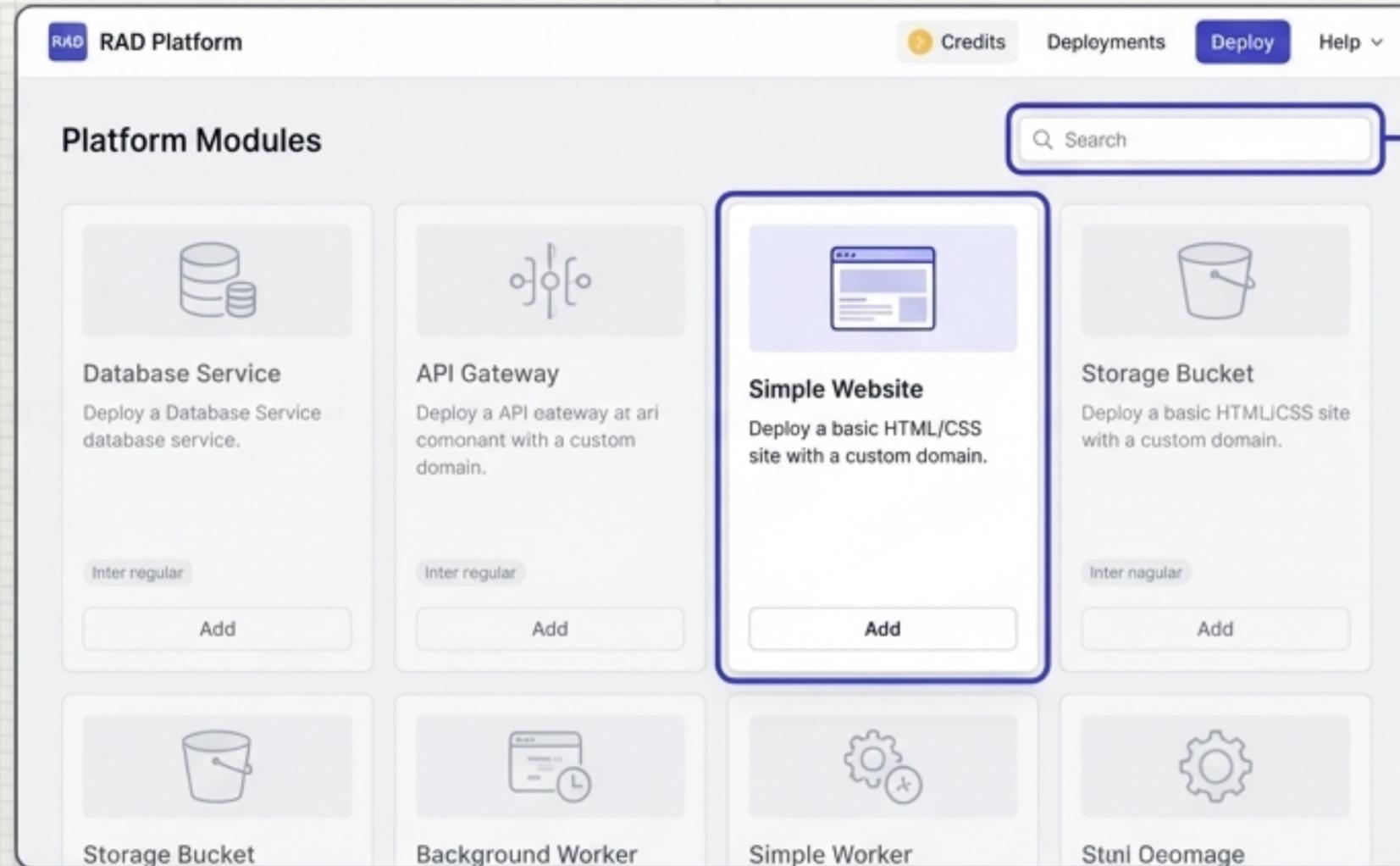


Initiate the Launch Sequence



Click **Deploy** in the top navigation to open the library of available Platform Modules.

Choose Your Application Module

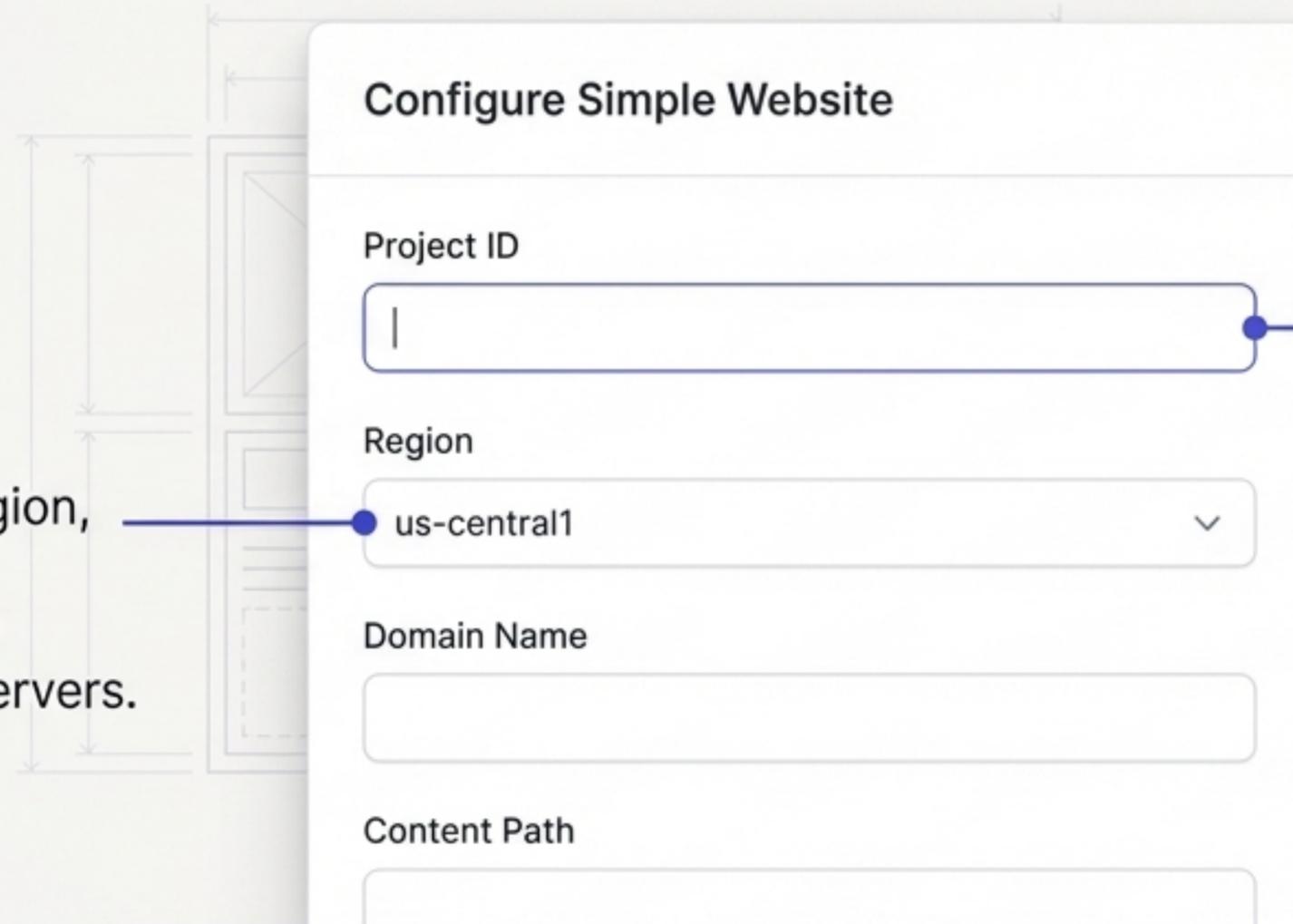


Quickly find what you need.

You can browse the available applications or use the Search bar to find a specific one. For this tutorial, let's deploy a 'Simple Website'. Click its card to begin configuration.

Set Your Coordinates: Configuration

Select a deployment region, like **`us-central1`**. This determines the physical location of your app's servers.

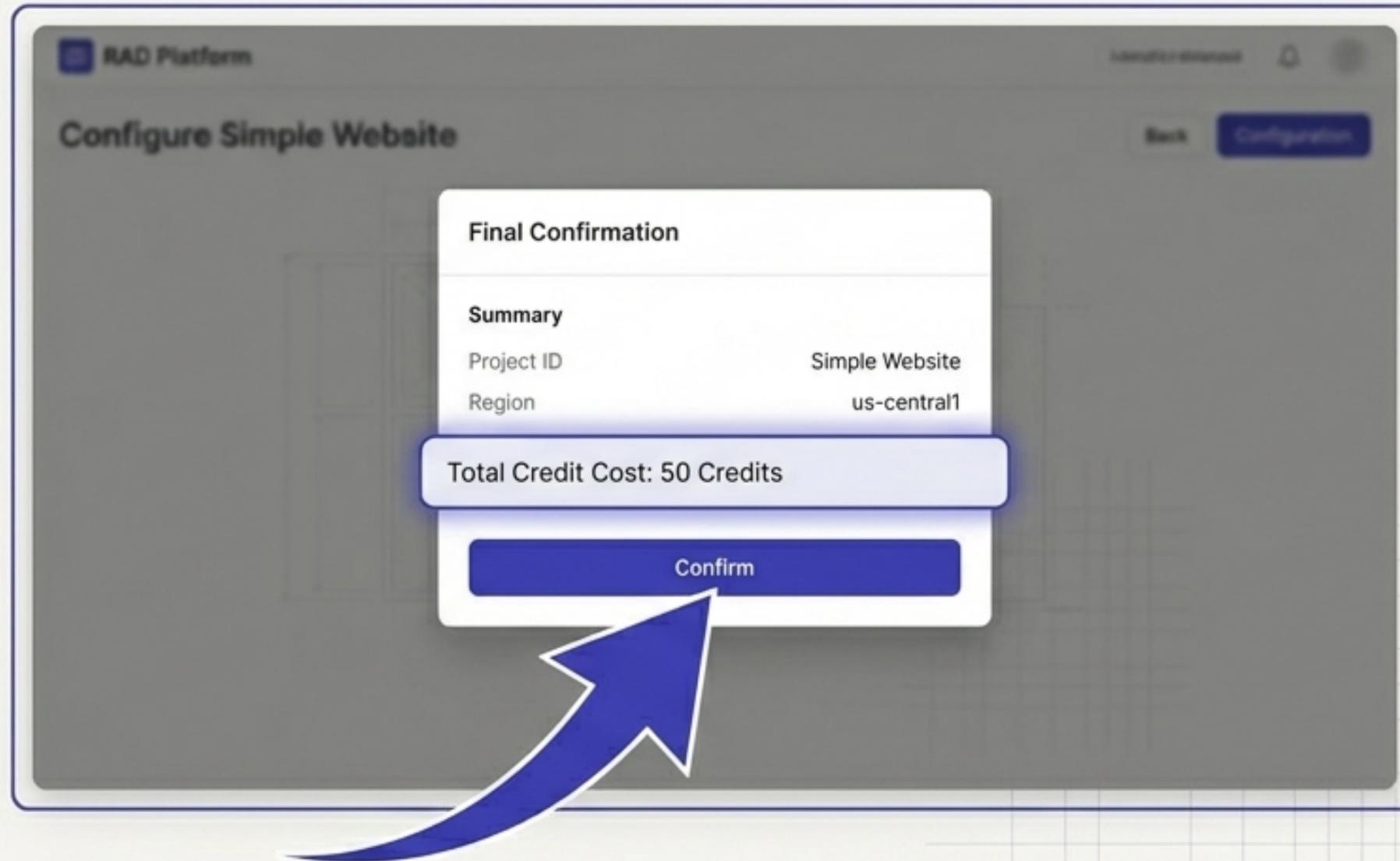

Enter a unique identifier for your project. This helps you organize your deployments.

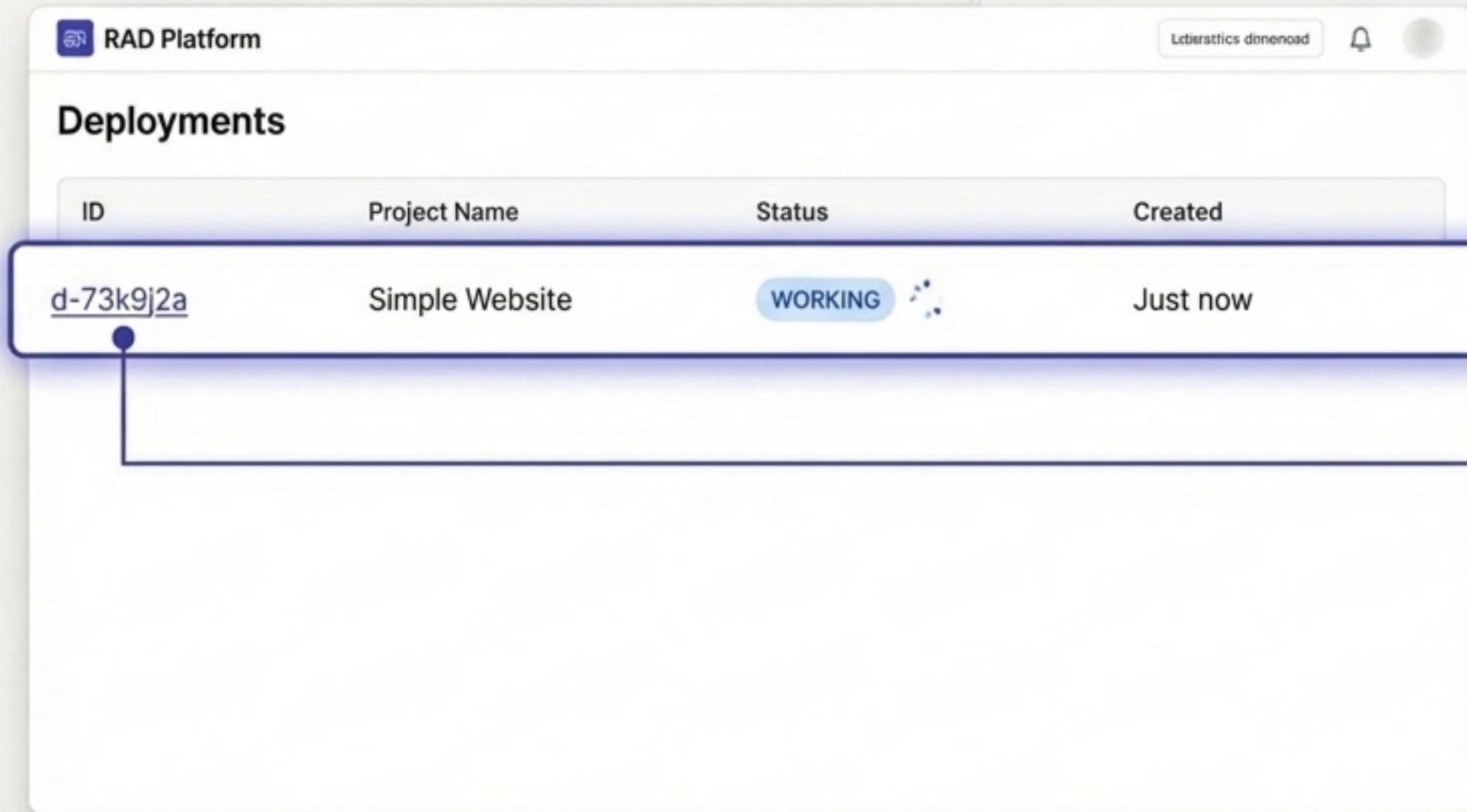
Note: Some forms have multiple steps. Simply click **`Next`** to proceed through them.
