KEY STORYLINES

LAST GAME

- ALL ABOUT OLIVER:** Sophomore forward Grace Oliver led the Demon Deacons with 17 points and went 8-for-10 from the field. Across 11 games, the Norwell, Mass.-native leads the ACC with a .622 field goal percentage.
- SHARPSHOOTING:** The Demon Deacons (9-2) outshot the Hoyas (6-3) in both field goal (42.9 percent) and three-point (38.5 percent) scoring. Additionally, the Deacs tallied nine steals on the afternoon, over the Hoyas' seven.
- PERFECT AT THE STRIPE:** Shooting 100 percent from the stripe, freshman guard Caitlyn Jones tallied 12 points alongside her perfect free-throw mark. Through 11 games, the Rolesville, N.C.-native is averaging 8.0 points per game, the highest of the Wake Forest freshman class.

WELCOME TO WINSTON

- ADDED TALENT:** Heading into the fourth season of the Megan Gebbia era, the Demon Deacons restocked the roster with an infusion of exciting young talent as well as veteran transfers, adding eight new players in total ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- THE FRESHMEN FIVE:** Coach Gebbia signed an exciting class of five freshmen that include Opal Bird, Milan Brown, Grace Galbavy, Caitlyn Jones and Savannah Metcalfe.
- IMPACT TRANSFERS:** The roster also has key transfer additions who will look to make an immediate impact this season including all-conference selections in Raven Preston from Elon and Mary Carter from Cal Poly. Additionally, the Deacs also signed Colorado transfer forward Grace Oliver.

SERIES HISTORY

- ALL-TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH:** Wake Forest trails the series 29-52 with a 19-18 mark at home.
- LAST TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH:** The Wake Forest women's basketball team stormed back from 15 points down to take the lead in the fourth quarter before eventually falling to No. 19 Georgia Tech, 73-62. Sophomore guard Rylie Theuerkauf reached double figures with 20 points, while senior guard Raegyn Conley and redshirt senior forward Demeara Hinds chipped in 12 points apiece.
- A WIN WOULD:** Marks the first conference win for the Demon Deacons and hand the Yellowjackets first conference loss of the season.

FAST BREAK

WEINMAN NAMED GENERAL MANAGER

- Wake Forest Athletics announced that Steve Weinman, a seasoned NBA front office executive with over a decade of experience in data strategy, scouting and performance analysis, has been appointed as Senior Associate Athletics Director for Analytics. In this role, Weinman will also serve as General Manager for both the men's and women's basketball programs, providing direct strategic and operational support for Coach Steve Forbes and Coach Megan Gebbia.
- Weinman comes to Wake Forest's staff following a distinguished 13-year tenure with the Chicago Bulls, most recently serving as Vice President of Basketball Strategy and Analytics and Assistant General Manager.
- In his role as GM of Wake Forest's basketball programs, Weinman will collaborate closely with the head coaches of each program on roster construction including recruiting strategy, transfer portal evaluation, resource allocation and planning. He will also work directly with basketball student-athlete agent representatives.

HAMBY AND STOCKTON TO HALL OF FAME

- Wake Forest Athletics and the Winston-Salem community proudly unveiled the Wake Forest Sports Hall of Fame 2026 induction class including the program's all-time leading scorer and rebounder Dearica Hamby and 1986 All-American Lisa Stockton.
- Hamby is the all-time leader in points (1,801) and rebounds (1,021) for Wake Forest women's basketball. She averaged 14.0 points, 7.9 rebounds and 1.7 steals during her four-year career with the Deacs. She twice earned an Associated Press All-America honorable mention nod (2014 & 2015). Professionally, She went on to be drafted sixth overall in 2015 WNBA Draft by the San Antonio Stars. She won the 2022 WNBA Championship with the Las Vegas Aces while being selected as a three-time WNBA All-Star selection (2021, 2022, 2024) and a two-time WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year (2019, 2020). At the 2024 Paris Olympics, she became the first Wake Forest women's athlete to win a medal at the Olympic Games, winning Olympic bronze medalist with the 2024 USA 3x3 Basketball Team.
- Stockton averaged 12.2 points, 3.0 assists and 1.9 steals for her Wake career, earning Fast Break All-American as a senior in 1985-86. Stockton was drafted by the National Women's Basketball Association following her senior season but chose instead to begin her coaching career as a volunteer assistant at the University of North Carolina for the 1986-87 season. She went on to lead the Tulane women's basketball program for 30 years from 1994-2024, finishing as the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in the state of Louisiana. She was tabbed one of the '100 Most Impactful People' nationally across the sport of women's college basketball by Silver Waves Media in 2020 and named one of the '25 Most Influential Women' in Louisiana sports history by The Advocate in 2022. Additionally, she was inducted into the Conference USA Hall of Fame as a member of the class of 2023.

ADDITIONS

- The Demon Deacons have eight new players to the team for the 2025-26 season in transfers Raven Preston from Elon, Mary Carter from Cal Poly and Grace Oliver from Colorado. The Deacs also bring in a promising group of five freshmen in Opal Bird, Milan Brown, Grace Galbavy, Caitlyn Jones and Savannah Metcalfe.

FRESHMEN

- Bird was the captain of the U17 Australian National team, winning the gold medal at both FIBA Oceania (2023) and FIBA Asia (2024) and most recently represented Australia at the U19 World Championships. Over five games at the 2024 U18 FIBA Asia Championship, averaged 9.3 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game. Averaged better than 8.0 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the 2023 U17 FIBA Oceania Championship. She also spent last season playing for the Bendigo Spirit of the WNBL.
- Brown was named 695 Hoops 2023-24 and 2024-25 Player of the Year while also earning First Team All-Metro and First Team All-Defense. She was also named the Baltimore Sun All-Metro Girls Basketball Player of the Year as a senior. Over the course of her career, Brown totaled over 2,000 career points while also pulling down over 1,000 career rebounds, becoming the first player in her

school's history to reach 2,000 career points. As a senior at Mercy High School, she averaged 30.8 points per game and 13.1 rebounds per game. She is also a multi-time published author.

- Galbavy was a three-time All-State selection in Pennsylvania including being named the 6A Pennsylvania Ms. Basketball during her senior season. She finished her spectacular high school career with 1,869 points and an overall record of 87-7, leading Perkiomen Valley to the 6A Pennsylvania State Championship in 2025.
- Jones was a three-time North Carolina All-State selection, helping lead her team to its first state championship in program history as a junior, winning the 4A state title at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum and being named the MVP with 27 points and having seven assists in the title game. The 2025 McDonald's All-American Game nominee finished her career with 1,900 points while also having 356 rebounds, 372 assists and 339 steals.
- Metcalfe is a multi-sport athlete that played at the national team level for Australia throughout her career including representing Australia at the U17 World Cup in 2022. Over the course of her four years in high school, she was the top scorer for her team, leading the team to four IGSSA Champions and was a four-time MVP of the league.

TRANSFERS

- During her sophomore season at Cal Poly, Carter averaged 12.9 points per game and 5.9 rebounds per game, starting in 31 of her 32 games that she played during the 2024-25 season. Over the course of the year, Carter knocked down 42.4 percent of her shots while also shooting better than 80 percent from the free throw line.
- She finished in double figures scoring 23 times during her sophomore campaign including a career-best 27 points on 11-of-20 FG including going 5-of-12 from behind the arc against Long Beach State. Carter also recorded four double-double performances which included an impressive 23-point, 11-rebound performance in a victory at Cal State-Bakersfield.
- Carter was named as an All-Big West selection this season and was placed on the Big West All-Freshman team a season ago when she averaged 7.0 points per game to go along with 3.9 rebounds per game.
- Oliver averaged 3.8 points and 3.3 rebounds per game during her freshman season at Colorado, seeing action in all 32 games while also making starts against Baylor and Houston. Over the course of the year, Oliver knocked down 52.2 percent of her shots and shot 39.5 percent from behind the arc.
- In high school, Oliver was named the Massachusetts 2023 Gatorade Player of the Year. She graded out as a four-star recruit by ESPNW (92 grade prospect) and was the No. 84 ranked player in the country and garnered multiple Adidas All-American selections at the AAU level.
- During her time at Elon, Preston has averaged 11.8 points per game in her first two seasons on the floor, scoring 530 total points. Additionally, she has averaged a near double-double over the course of her career, pulling down an average of 8.7 rebounds per game in her 45 career games.
- Preston, who was the 2023 CAA Rookie of the Year and All-CAA in 2025, was also named the CAA Scholar-Athlete of the Year this season, maintaining a 3.85 GPA as an exercise science major while leading the Phoenix to the CAA Championship game.

JOHNS BACK

- After a preseason injury, Wake Forest senior forward Emily Johns missed the 2024-25 season with the ability to maintain her last year of eligibility with a medical redshirt.
- During her time at American, Johns reached the 1,000-point milestone while averaging better than 10 points per game in 102 games played including 60 starts over the last two seasons for the Eagles.
- Johns, who was also a Patriot League All-League selection during her time in Washington D.C., is a career 47.9 percent shooter while also knocking down 76.4 percent of her free throw attempts.

MAY WE ASSIST YOU

- Wake Forest tallied 15 total assists on the night on 21 made baskets (71.4 percent). In 11 games this season, the Demon

MORE NOTES

Deacons have totaled 191 assists on 282 field goals (67.7 percent) which would mark the highest percentage in the Megan Gebbia era.

- The Deacs did an excellent job of moving the ball last season, as they assisted on 394 of 667 made baskets this season (59.1 pct.). This was the highest assist percentage in the Gebbia era and the assist percentage ranks in the top 70 percent in the nation according to HerHoopStats.

In 2023-24, the Deacs assisted 404 of 694 made field goals (58.2 percent).

FORCING TURNOVERS

- The Deacs forced the Hoyas into 17 turnovers on Sunday, and have forced 10 or more takeaways 78 times in the last 82 games, a stretch dating back to January of 2022.
- Through 11 games, the Demon Deacons have forced 15.6 turnovers per game.

OWNING THE PAINT

- The Demon Deacons had another excellent game in the paint, with 32 points posted inside, while allowing Georgetown to score 18 points in the paint, a 14-point differential.
- Across 11 games, the Deacs have totaled 420 points in the paint (38.2 per game).

SHARPSHOOTERS

- Wake Forest knocked back five threes, with four Demon Deacons contributing to the total.
- The Deacs finished the 2024-25 season knocking down 159 threes (5.5 3FGM per game). This included seven games with eight or more threes made.
- Through the first three seasons under head coach Megan Gebbia, the Demon Deacons have hit 590 threes in 95 games under her direction (6.2 3FGM per game).
- This includes her first two seasons, which both rank in the top five in program history:

WAKE FOREST INVESTMENT IN BASKETBALL

- Over the last six years, Wake Forest has invested over \$27 million in basketball facilities. The latest investment was the \$7.2 million project for the Dr. Carol Guth and Chris Paul Family women's and men's clubhouses that were completed in

September of 2022.

- Both clubhouses feature over 6,000 square feet of space, 18 expansive player lockers with built-in ventilation, wireless charging station for electronics, RGB LED lighting and 43" digital screens above each locker.
 - The players lounge in each clubhouse has three separate TV/multimedia areas with comfortable seating for rest, relaxation and a space for the student-athletes. Additionally, there is a nutrition area in this space with a community table for team meals.
 - Each Clubhouse features state-of-the-art sports medicine and performance elements, including recovery pods and hydrotherapy, as well as showers and bathrooms.
 - Wake Forest basketball student-athletes can enjoy an outdoor heated covered patio with a view of the beautiful Reynolda Campus and Kentner Stadium.

YEAR FOUR IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia enters her third season as the head coach of the Wake Forest women's basketball program in 2024-25 after an impressive debut season at the helm.

In just her first season, Gebbia had a host of accomplishments:

- Winningest first-year head coach in program history
- 17 wins tied the most since the 2011-12 season
- Tallied the most wins against ACC opponents by a first-year head coach
- Wins over four NCAA Tournament teams including wins over two Elite Eight teams
- Grabbed 12 wins at home, the fourth-highest total in program history
- Finished second in program history with 227 threes made
- Ended the season ranked fourth in program history with 123 blocks
- Held ACC opponents at home to just 19.2 percent shooting from three
- Limited five of nine ACC teams at home to one or less three-pointer made
- Increased the team's assist percentage by nearly 20 percent
- Signed a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW
- This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

Gebbia made an impact in her first season as the Deacs grabbed their most wins since the 2011-12 season and led the Demon Deacons to a memorable three-day run at the ACC Tournament. During their three days in Greensboro, Wake Forest had the second-largest halftime comeback in ACC Tournament history, erasing an 18-point halftime deficit to defeat Florida State. It was one of a number of big wins during the first season of the Gebbia era. The Deacs claimed a key road win in the final year of the ACC/Big Ten, defeating Minnesota in the final year of the ACC/Big Ten, defeating Minnesota in the final year of the ACC/Big Ten.

In the final week of January, the Demon Deacons recorded a pair of wins over eventual Elite Eight teams, taking down Louisville, the first win over the Cardinals in program history, and Miami. Both victories highlighted 12 total wins at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum, the fourth-highest total in program history.

In the first season of the Gebbia era, Jewel Spear had one of the best scoring seasons by any player in program history, finishing the 2022-23 season with 546 points, the sixth-highest total by a Demon Deacon. En route to garnering All-ACC honors for the second-consecutive season, Spear had 11 20-plus point games including 30-plus points in wins over Coastal Carolina and Louisville.

Spear finished the season with the second-highest three-point total in program history, racking up 93 threes during the season. As a team, Wake Forest had their second-highest total of threes in program history as the motion-style offense of Gebbia produced 227 threes on the season.

The Deacs also got the job done on the defensive side of the ball, blocking 123 shots during the season which ranked fourth in program history and finished the season ranked in the top 100 nationally. Wake Forest also ranked in the top 70 nationally in points per game allowed and in the top 60 nationally in three-point defense.

On the recruiting side, Gebbia signed top talent for her first class, inking a top-25 recruiting class according to ESPNW. It also was the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era.

Welcome to the Gebbia Era

Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Ea-

gles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wente and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball."

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by
