Precautions

Installation

 Insert one end of the line cord to the line jack on the base (marked as LINE) & connect the other end to the rosette/Wall jack.

Initial Settings

Dial Mode Setting

- Dial mode can be set by using the P/T (Pulse/Tone) switch mounted on the rear side of the base unit
- In on hook condition slide the P/T switch knob from T (Tone) to P (Pulse) as desired.
- The default dial mode setting is Tone. Ringer Volume setting
- Ringer volume can be adjusted by using the Ringer switch mounted on rear side of the base unit.
- Set the ringer volume switch knob from high to Low or Off position as desired.
- The default ringer setting is High

Handset Receive Volume setting

- Handset receive volume can be adjusted by using the handset receive volume switch mounted on rear side of the base unit.
- Set the handset receive volume switch knob from low to medium or high position as desire
- · The default handset receive volume setting is Low.

Operations

Making a call:

- Pick up the handset and hear the dial tone.
- · Press the desired number & speak to the other end.
- · After the conversation finished, place the handset on the base.

Receiving a call

- The unit will ring when you have an incoming call,
 When the unit rings, pick up the handset and speak to the caller.
- When conversation finished, place the handset to the base.

Last Number Redial

- Pick up the handset.
- After hearing the dial tone, Press Redial key.
- · The last dialed number will be dialed out.

Flash Function

- · Pick up the handset.
- Press FLASH key the telephone line will break for 300 m Sec. (This feature is
 provided in the telephone to access the facility offered by some EPBAX such
 as line transfer or network service by telephone companies such as Call
 Waiting, etc.)

Pause Function

 We recommend you to press the PAUSE key if a pause is required for dialing with a PABX or to access a Long Distance Code. On pressing the PAUSE key the unit will introduce a 3.6 seconds delay between the two digits dialed before and after the pause.

Mute Function

 When making a phone call, if you need a temporary talk with some one else and you don't want the phone receiver hear your speaking, keep press "MUTE" key to mute your voice sending, release "MUTE" key to return to conversation mode.

Dynamic change over from Pulse to Tone

- · When phone is set in Pulse Dialing Mode
- Pick up the handset
- Press * key to change the dialing mode from Pulse to Tone temporarily.
- Dial the desired number from key pad and talk to the other end.
- After finishing the conversation, place the handset on the base.

Note: - The phone will return to the original pulse dialing mode automatically after finishing the Conversation
