





PRINT RESOURCES

15,496 books, DVDs, and other resources distributed across the globe!

RTB Press was excited to release two print books: *Revealing God in Science* and *Noah's Flood Revisited*; four ebooks: *Rescuing Inerrancy*, *Clear Thinking in a Messy World*, *Revealing God in Science*, and *Noah's Flood Revisited*; three audiobooks: *Clear Thinking in a Messy World*, *Revealing God in Science*, and *Noah's Flood Revisited*.

Revealing God in Science: 12 STEMM Scholars Share Their Journey, is a collection of personal journeys where faith and science meet in honest, often tender ways. Written by twelve STEMM scholars, each chapter shares moments of wrestling, discovery, and conviction that resonate with both Christians and skeptics.

This year marked one of our busiest editorial seasons—over 700 projects edited and four titles published across print and digital formats (nine editions total).

One reader shared:

"It's nice to get these personal looks at the authors' lives, and how they encountered and wrestled through science/faith issues. In chapter after chapter, another name of a family/friend/coworker would pop up—Christians and skeptics—as someone who the person's story would speak to. I'm going to need to get several copies of the book to give away. And in a happy twist for a science book, I did shed a few tears in some spots."

YOU EMPOWERED

OUTREACH EVENTS


Throughout the year, God drew people seeking answers to Reasons to Believe outreach events, opening the door to meaningful, gospel-centered conversations. Through **35 events at churches, universities, conferences, and partner ministries**, the RTB team reached new audiences and distributed **1,300 resources**, equipping individuals with biblically grounded tools to engage questions of science and faith—all made possible by your support.

We saw a notable increase in university engagements this year, many in partnership with Ratio Christi chapters. Highlights included events at University of Utah and Utah Valley University, where **Fuz Rana** addressed students on “A Scientific Case for God in the Age of AI.”

“At University of Utah, Dr. Rana gave a talk titled ‘Who Are We? A Scientific Case for God in the Age of AI,’ which drew about 40 attendees, mostly STEMM students. The smaller crowd allowed for meaningful connections, and several Christian students left encouraged by the experience.

The next day, Dr. Rana joined us at Utah Valley University, where Snow College students and chapter directors also traveled to attend. We are deeply thankful to Dr. Rana for sharing his insights and helping us connect with the university community. This marked the first event by Reasons to Believe in Utah, and we hope it paves the way for more opportunities to engage students in the future.”

YOU ENGAGED

Because of you, RTB has a thriving community across the country and around the globe engaged in discipleship, apologetics training, and gospel outreach to the STEMM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and medicine) community. 2025 was a very exciting year for our Scholar Community and Reasons Institute!

SCHOLAR COMMUNITY

This year, **46 new scholars** joined our community, expanding our expertise into disciplines such as neuroscience, biomedical engineering, and philosophy. Among them are mathematician **William Dembski**, biochemical geneticist **Richard Gunasekera**, and cellular physiologist **Latasha Smith**.

We take the mission of equipping our community seriously—and **because of your support**, it came to life in tangible ways this year. In 2025, we hosted **28 scholar-focused events** designed to strengthen fellowship, sharpen research, and expand gospel-centered outreach.

These gatherings included monthly academic lectures, small groups and book clubs, biannual evangelism training, and a full-day conference on thinking clearly in today's messy world. We also prioritized face-to-face connection, gathering with scholars and community members at both academic and lay-level conferences whenever possible.

Your partnership made space for scholars to grow, connect, and carry truth into classrooms, conversations, and culture.

The Scholar Community team created and shared resources that extended far beyond our walls:

- **3 published white papers** addressing critical topics, including arguments for God's existence, God's sustaining power, and difficult questions around disorders of sexual development
- **51 guest appearances** across RTB podcasts and videos, expanding both depth and expertise
- **35 scholars featured** on external podcasts and interviews discussing science and faith
- **27 scholars creating original digital content**, including videos, graphics, and teaching tools

But the impact doesn't stop with content—it continues through relationships:

- **46 scholars disciplined** a new or recommitted Christian
- **72 gospel conversations** with nonseeking non-Christians
- **86 gospel conversations** with skeptics and seekers
- **81 one-on-one relationships** through mentoring, discipleship, or spiritual coaching
- **49 scholars engaged in online evangelism**
- **89 scholars shared RTB resources** within their own networks

Each scholar represents a growing circle of influence—classrooms, labs, churches, online spaces, and personal relationships. **God is using this community to extend RTB's mission farther than we could ever reach alone.**

"My main area of focus is teaching the RTB curriculum at Regent University to existing/upcoming pastors and theologians. It has been very educational and transformational for the students. I've had several students who enjoyed the courses at Regent but felt they would never use it. A year or so later, they emailed me in excitement that they were able to talk/engage with people struggling to understand science and faith issues. They also suggested some RTB resources. Another student told me that after she explained some science/creation details, a person came to faith."

REASONS INSTITUTE

Because of your partnership, enrollment in Reasons Institute online courses grew dramatically in 2025, with **391 students enrolling**, up from **75 the previous year**. This growth reflects a rising demand for biblically grounded training at the intersection of science, faith, and culture.

Your support also helped launch and expand the **Ministry Leaders Certificate Program**, which welcomed **50 students** in its first year. In addition, two new 8-week courses—**Examining Christianity** and **Clear Thinking in a Messy World**—equipped students to thoughtfully engage today's toughest questions with clarity, relevance, and confidence. More training opportunities lie ahead.

"A friend recommended I join him and take the RTB course 'Creation and the Bible.' This was a deep plunge into reading, thinking, interacting, and writing that was as challenging as any course I had taken as a PhD candidate. 


MONTHLY PARTNER COMMUNITY


