FIRST VISITS

The American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry recommends that children be seen by a dentist six months after eruption of their first tooth or at least by one year of age. The first visit will introduce them to the office, the staff, and to become acclimated with the routine of visiting the dentist.

Your child's first visit to the dentist is a new and exciting adventure. Each child responds differently, some are excited, some are a little nervous. Rest assured our experienced staff is prepared to create a fun, exciting, learning experience for your child. We want to establish a positive experience for your child to help them develop a positive dental attitude.

Children under the age of three may be accompanied by their parent. At their dental development, oral hygiene instructions, and nutrition. Children ages 3 and older, we suggest you allow our staff to accompany your child through the dental experience without the parent at the chair side.
