Dear Ms. Santiago:

Relative to your queries on the documentation of the shoes, gowns, and other personal effects of Former First Lady, Imelda R. Marcos, left in Malacañang, our records show that, on 08 March 1998, with the submission of the letter from then Cong. Imelda R. Marcos (IRM) the shoe collection were placed in the Marikina Shoe Museum as requested by the Local Government of Marikina. Malacañang interposed no objection, since it is the caretaker of the said shoe collections at that time.

On the other hand, on 14 October 2002, due to PCGG space constraints, part of the Marcos Family's personal effects including gowns were transferred to Malacañang Palace. However, some of the personal effects are stored in BSP vault for safekeeping.
