Marcos, Sr.**, and **Imelda Romualdez Marcos** since 1986:

With respect to your inquiry on the assets related to **Ferdinand “Bongbong” Marcos, Jr.** (Ferdinand Jr.), please be advised that based on our record there is **no asset** in his name under sequestration and/or litigation, however, upon the death of Ferdinand E. Marcos, Sr., in 1989, Ferdinand Jr. substituted the deceased in a representative capacity.
