



## Surgical Operations and Procedures Done on PGH Patients

In 2019, the total number of surgical operations and procedures done on PGH patients was 29,590; 68.5% of these operations and procedures were done in the OR Complex, 18.0% in the Sentro Oftalmologico Jose Rizal (SOJR)-OR and 13.5% in the Department of Outpatient Services-OR. This number indicated a slight increase of 1.5% from 29,153 surgical operations and procedures in 2018.

### Surgical Operations and Procedures Done 2015 to 2019




● Improvements and renovations made in the Operating Room (OR) Complex may have contributed to the increase in the OR census.


## Surgical Operations and Procedures Done on PGH Patients

In 2018, the total number of surgical operations and procedures done on PGH patients was 29,153; 68.5% of these operations and procedures were done in the OR Complex, 18.7% in the SOJR-OR and 12.8% in the OPD-OR. This number indicated an increase of 3.7% from 28,115 surgical operations and procedures in 2017.




## PGH Personnel Complement


### PGH Personnel by Status of Appointment, 2019




## PGH Personnel Complement


### PGH Personnel by Status of Appointment, 2018
