This refers to your email dated 24 September 2020 through our FOI portal, requesting for information on the following for your architectural thesis:


- a. Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) of 1500 Hectare Reclamation for Sangley Point International Airport (SPIA) in Cavite City
- b. What would be the process, laws and other regulation to Reclamation for SPIA
- c. What are the agencies covered in the project related to land reclamation

In this regard, please be informed of the following:

1. EIS reports are officially submitted to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Environmental Management Bureau (DENR-EMB) for the purpose of securing an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the Project. If the SPIA proponent already filed an application for an ECC with DENR-EMB, the EIS report may be secured from said agency.
2. All reclamation projects are covered by Executive Order (E.O.) No. 74 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (PRA-AO 2019-05). The procedure and requirements are defined in the said IRR which can be downloaded from our Agency's website www.pea.gov.ph.
3. The rule of thumb is that all agencies and local government units (LGUs) with regulatory, development or supervisory mandate in the area where the proposed reclamation will be located are among the agencies that will issue the required permits, clearances and endorsements for the project.
