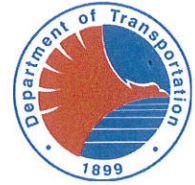


RE: INTERNATIONAL INBOUND PASSENGER CAPACITY AT THE NINOY AQUINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (NAIA)

Please be advised that the international inbound arrivals at the Manila's Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) shall be increased to a maximum of 4,000 passengers per day beginning 1 November 2021. This increase in NAIA's arrival capacity rests on the premise that such increase will not result in congestion and delay in the processing of arriving passengers at the NAIA.

Airlines operating in NAIA that will exceed the allowed capacity will be meted with the appropriate penalty pursuant to Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-01 dated 08 January 2021, issued by the Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA), Clark International Airport Corporation (CIAC), Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP), and the Civil Aeronautics Board (CAB).

Please be guided accordingly.
