MARKET OVERVIEW

Gallup, NM is the county seat for McKinley
County and one of the most populous cities
between Flagstaff, AZ and Albuquerque, NM.
McKinley County is home to nearly 72,230
people, but Gallup serves a trade area of
more than 120,000 people, traveling to the
city on the weekends for shopping, dining and
entertainment. Gallup has the only enclosed
shopping mall (Rio West Mall) in the region,
located just south of American Heritage Plaza.
This is a destination shopping mall that draws
more than 3.6 million customers per year.

Gallup is also situated in proximity to many reservations including the Navajo Nation, Hopi, and Zuni. Collectively the reservations are home to more than 370,000 residents.
